HONG KONG MERCHANT SHIPPING INFORMATION NOTE

United Nations Sanctions (Lebanon) Regulation

To : Shipowners, Ship Managers and Masters

Summary

The Government of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region gazetted the United Nations Sanctions (Lebanon) Regulation (L.N. 8 of 2007) on 19 January 2007 to give effect to a decision of the Security Council of the United Nations in Resolution 1701(2006).

1. The United Nations Sanctions (Lebanon) Regulation is made under section 3 of the United Nations Sanctions Ordinance (Cap. 537). The Regulation gives effect to a decision of the Security Council of the United Nations in Resolution 1701(2006), which imposes the following sanctions:
 - (a) prohibition against the sale or supply of arms and related material (“prohibited goods”) to any entity or individual in Lebanon; and
 - (b) prohibition against the provision to any such entity or individual of technical training or assistance related to the provision, manufacture, maintenance or use of any prohibited goods.

3. Owners, managers and masters of Hong Kong registered ships should abide by the Regulation mentioned above.
