## HONG KONG MERCHANT SHIPPING INFORMATION NOTE

**United Nations Sanctions (IRAN) Regulation**

*To : Shipowners, Ship Managers and Masters*

***Summary***

The Government of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region gazetted the United Nations Sanctions (Iran) Regulation (L.N. 179 of 2007) on 28 September 2007 to give effect to the decisions of the Security Council of the United Nations in Resolutions 1737(2006) and 1747(2007).

1. The United Nations Sanctions (Iran) Regulation is made under section 3 of the United Nations Sanctions Ordinance (Cap. 537). The Regulation gives effect to the decisions of the Security Council of the United Nations in Resolutions 1737(2006) and 1747(2007), which impose the following sanctions:

- (a) prohibition against the direct or indirect sale, supply or transfer of certain items or technologies to Iran;
- (b) prohibition against the procurement of certain arms or related materials, items or equipment from Iran;
- (c) prohibition against the provision or transfer of certain assistance, training, services or resources to Iran; and
- (d) prohibition against making available to or for the benefit of certain persons or entities any funds or other financial assets or economic resources.

3. Owners, managers and masters of Hong Kong registered ships should abide by the Regulation mentioned above.
