HONG KONG MERCHANT SHIPPING INFORMATION NOTE

United Nations Sanctions (Democratic Republic of the Congo) Regulation 2008

To : Shipowners, Ship Managers and Masters

Summary

The Government of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region gazetted the United Nations Sanctions (Democratic Republic of the Congo) Regulation 2008 (L.N. 17 of 2008) on 25 January 2008 to give effect to certain decisions of the Security Council of the United Nations in Resolution 1771(2007) adopted on 10 August 2007. This Regulation will expire at midnight on 15 February 2008.

1. The United Nations Sanctions (Democratic Republic of the Congo) Regulation 2008 is made under section 3 of the United Nations Sanctions Ordinance (Cap. 537). The purpose of this Regulation is to give effect to certain decisions of the Security Council of the United Nations (UN) in Resolution 1771(2007) adopted on 10 August 2007 to further impose the following sanctions:

- (a) prohibition against the direct or indirect supply, sale or transfer of arms and related materials to persons in the territory of the Democratic Republic of the Congo;
- (b) prohibition against the provision to such persons of assistance, advice or training related to military activities;
- (c) prohibition against making available to or for the benefit of certain persons or entities any funds or other financial assets or economics resources; and
- (d) prohibition against entry into or transit through the HKSAR of certain persons.

2. The Regulation will expire at midnight on 15 February 2008.

4. Owners, managers and masters of Hong Kong registered ships should abide by the Regulation mentioned above.
