REGULATION**

(Made by the Chief Executive under section 3 of the United Nations Sanctions Ordinance (Cap. 537) on the instruction of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the People's Republic of China and after consultation with the Executive Council)

1. Commencement

This Regulation comes into operation on 7 May 2010.

2. Repeal

The United Nations Sanctions (Liberia) Regulation 2009 (Cap. 537 sub. leg. AM) is repealed.

Explanatory Note

This Regulation repeals the United Nations Sanctions (Liberia) Regulation 2009 (Cap. 537 sub. leg. AM), on the making of the United Nations Sanctions (Liberia) Regulation 2010 (“the new Regulation”).

2. The new Regulation is a consolidated instrument which gives effect to certain decisions of the Security Council of the United Nations (“Security Council”) in Resolution 1903 (2009) and continues to give effect to a decision of the Security Council in Resolution 1532 (2004).
