## HONG KONG MERCHANT SHIPPING INFORMATION NOTE

**United Nations Sanctions (Arms Embargoes) Regulation (Repeal) Regulation and United Nations Sanctions (Sierra Leone) (Immigration Control) Regulation (Repeal) Regulation**

*To : Shipowners, Ship Managers and Masters*

**Summary**

The Government of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region (HKSAR) gazetted the United Nations Sanctions (Arms Embargoes) Regulation (Repeal) Regulation (L.N. 10 of 2011) and United Nations Sanctions (Sierra Leone) (Immigration Control) Regulation (Repeal) Regulation (L.N. 11 of 2011) on 14 January 2011 to give effect to Resolution 1940 adopted by the Security Council of the United Nations (UNSC).

1. The United Nations Sanctions (Arms Embargoes) Regulation (Repeal) Regulation repeals Cap.537E to give effect to terminate arms-related sanctions against Sierra Leone as decided under UNSC's Resolution 1940.
2. The United Nations Sanctions (Sierra Leone) (Immigration Control) Regulation (Repeal) Regulation repeals Cap.537G to give effect to terminate travel-related sanctions against Sierra Leone as decided under UNSC's Resolution 1940.
