HONG KONG MERCHANT SHIPPING INFORMATION NOTE

United Nations Sanctions (Côte d'Ivoire) (No.2) Regulation 2011

To : Shipowners, Ship Managers and Masters

Summary

The Government of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region (HKSAR) gazetted the United Nations Sanctions (Côte d'Ivoire) (No.2) Regulation 2011 (L.N. 113 of 2011) (the 'Regulation 2011') on 30 June 2011 which came into effect on the same date. The 'Regulation 2011' gives effect to the decisions of the Security Council of the United Nations in Resolutions 1975 and 1980 adopted on 30 March 2011 and 28 April 2011 respectively.

1. The 'Regulation 2011', made under section 3 of the United Nations Sanctions Ordinance (Cap. 537), gives effect to sanctions against Côte d'Ivoire imposed by the Security Council of the United Nations in Resolutions 1975 and 1980 for the :

- (a) prohibition against the supply, sale, transfer or carriage of arms or related materiel to Côte d'Ivoire or certain persons;
- (b) prohibition against the supply, sale, transfer or carriage of vehicles to the Ivorian security forces;
- (c) prohibition against the provision of advice, assistance or training related to military activities to certain persons;
- (d) prohibition against making available to certain persons or entities funds or other financial assets or economic resources, or dealing with funds or other financial assets or economic resources of certain persons or entities;
- (e) prohibition against entry into or transit through the HKSAR by certain persons; and
- (f) prohibition against importation of rough diamonds from Côte d'Ivoire.

2. The 'Regulation 2011' expires at midnight on 30 April 2012.

4. Owners, managers and masters of Hong Kong registered ships should abide by the regulation mentioned above.
