HONG KONG MERCHANT SHIPPING INFORMATION NOTE

Unified Interpretations of Chapters 5, 6 and 9 of the FSS Code

To: Shipowners, Ship Managers, Ship Operators, Masters, Classification Societies and Shipbuilders

Summary

The purpose of this Note is to promulgate the unified interpretations of chapters 5, 6 and 9 of the FSS Code, with a view to providing more specific guidance on the fixed gas fire-extinguishing systems and fixed fire detection and fire alarm systems, foam-generating capacity of fixed foam fire-extinguishing systems and an additional indicating unit in the cargo control rooms.

- 1. The Maritime Safety Committee (MSC) of the International Maritime Organization (IMO), at its 96th session in May 2016, approved the unified interpretations of chapters 5, 6 and 9 of the FSS Code, with a view to providing more specific guidance on the requirements of the FSS Code, incorporating paragraph 2.2.1.7 of chapter 5 relating to the number of setting points of control for fixed gas fire-extinguishing systems; paragraphs 3.2.1.2 and 3.3.1.2 of chapter 6, as amended by resolution MSC.327(90), for the foam-generating capacity of fixed foam fire-extinguishing systems; and paragraph 2.5.1.3 of chapter 9, as amended by resolution MSC.339(91), regarding the need for fitting an additional indicating unit in a space in which a cargo control console is installed (e.g. ship's office, machinery control room).
- 2. The details of the unified interpretations as annexed to IMO circular MSC.1/Circ.1528 can be found in the attachment to this Note on the website of Marine Department (http://www.mardep.gov.hk/en/msnote/msin.html).
- 3. Shipowners, ship managers, ship operators, masters, classification societies and shipbuilders of Hong Kong registered ships should apply the unified interpretations.
