(Miscellaneous Information)

Liquefied Natural Gas Tankers Transiting the waters of Hong Kong at Mirs Bay

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Liquefied Natural Gas (LNG) tankers will transit the waters of Hong Kong at Mirs Bay starting from 24th May 2006 onwards for delivery of LNG cargoes to the Dapeng LNG Receiving Terminal on the mainland at regular intervals.

2. The north-bound and south-bound trips of the LNG tankers will follow the intended route of passing east of Shek Ngau Chau and west of Ping Chau as shown in the attached drawing. Commercial tugs employed by the owner will provide escort service to maintain a safety zone around the LNG tanker and their movements will be regulated.

3. Masters, coxswains and persons-in-charge of vessels navigating in the vicinity should proceed with caution giving a wide berth to the passage of the LNG tankers. Compliance with the provisions of the International Regulations for Preventing Collision at Sea, 1972 is mandatory.

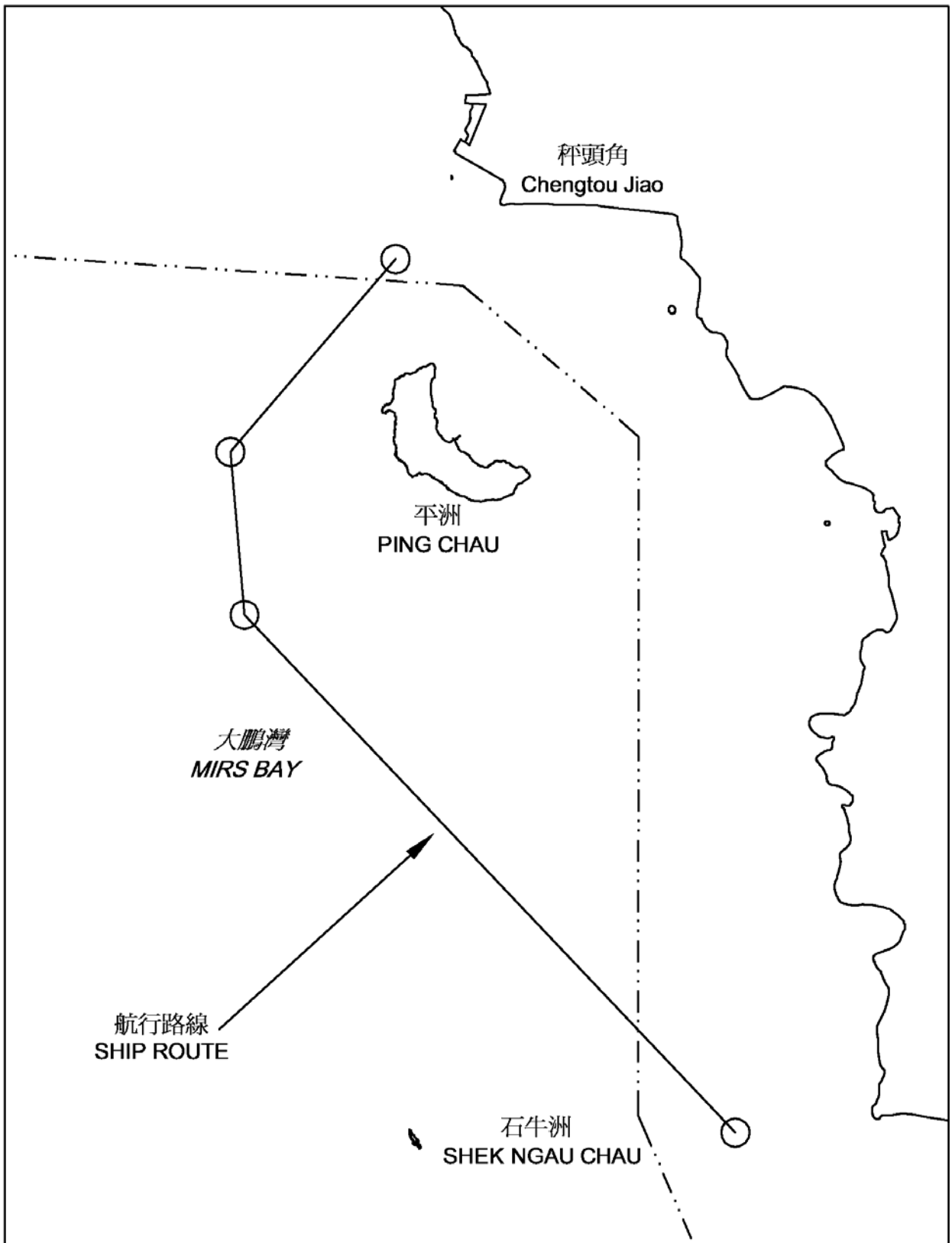
