

MARINE DEPARTMENT NOTICE NO. 145 OF 2007

(Marine Works)

Backfilling Operations **North of the Hong Kong International Airport**

With immediate effect and for a period of approximately 43 months, backfilling operations will be carried out to the mud pits located within the area bounded by straight lines joining the following co-ordinates (WGS 84 Datum) :

- (A) 22°19.404'N 113°53.606'E
- (B) 22°19.561'N 113°54.110'E
- (C) 22°20.128'N 113°54.219'E
- (D) 22°20.782'N 113°56.417'E
- (E) 22°19.940'N 113°56.724'E
- (F) 22°19.003'N 113°53.750'E

2. One derrick barge, one hopper barge and one flat top barge will carry out the works. Two tugs will stay in the vicinity to provide assistance. The number of craft engaged in the works will change from time to time to suit operational requirements.

3. A working area of approximately 50 metres around each of the barges will be established. Yellow marker buoys fitted with yellow flashing lights will be laid to mark the positions of the anchors extending from the barges. The hours of works will normally be round-the-clock.

4. Craft engaged in the operations will display signals as prescribed in international and local regulations.

5. Vessels navigating in the vicinity should proceed with caution.

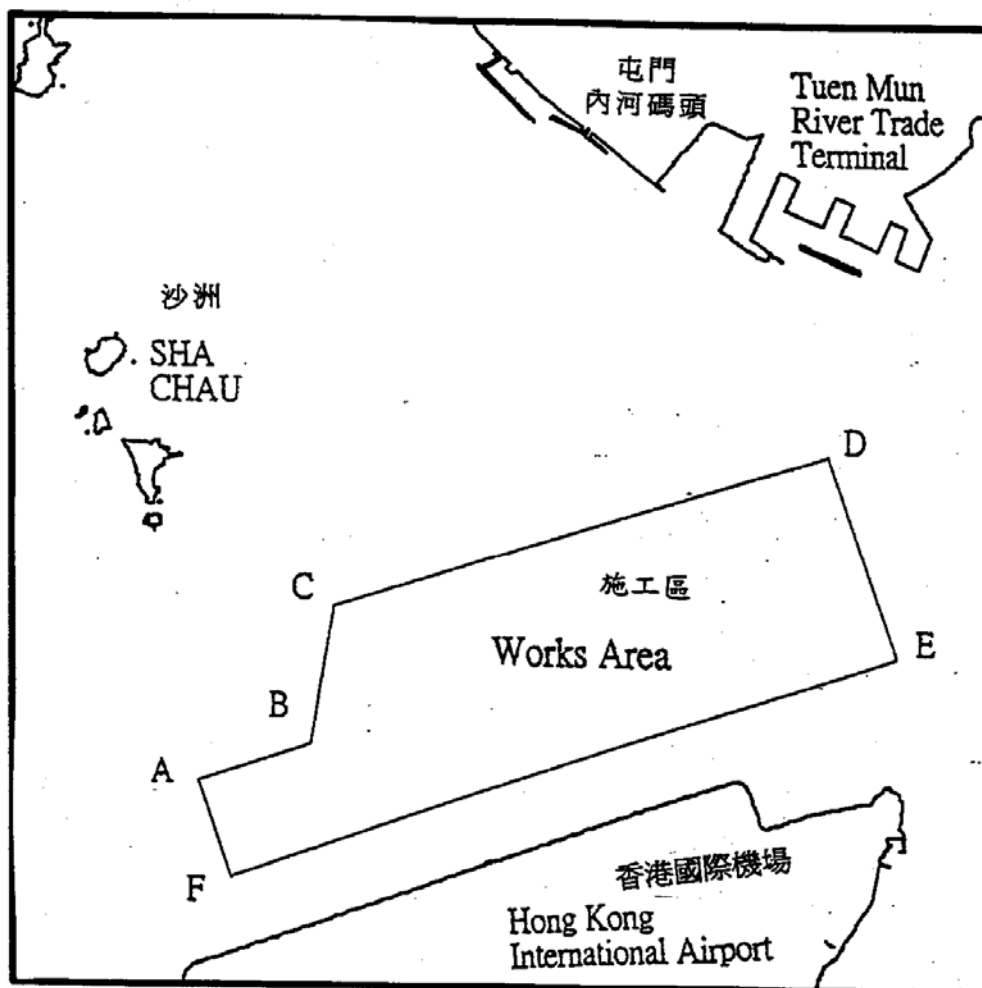
6. A drawing showing the works area is attached to this Notice.
