

MARINE DEPARTMENT NOTICE NO. 48 OF 2008

(Navigational Warnings and Related Information)

Salvage of a Sunken Wreck near CP1 Light Buoy off Siu Mo To

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that with immediate effect and for a period of approximately 3 weeks, salvage operations to remove a sunken wreck are being carried out in the water area near CP1 light buoy bounded by straight lines joining the following co-ordinates (WGS 84 Datum) :-

(A)	22 ° 20.830' N	113 ° 59.600' E
(B)	22 ° 20.756' N	114 ° 00.196' E
(C)	22 ° 19.975' N	114 ° 00.110' E
(D)	22 ° 20.480' N	113 ° 59.146' E

2. The operations will continue round-the-clock and involve salvage barges, tug boats and work boats. Diving operations will be carried out from time to time. Craft engaged in the operations will display signals as prescribed in international and local regulations. Marker buoys will be laid to mark the positions of the anchors extending from the salvage barges.

3. To ensure safe operations, no vessel, except vessels directly involved in the salvage work and other authorized vessels, will be allowed to enter into or remain within the above area. Vessels navigating in the vicinity should keep well clear of the area and proceed with extreme caution at slow speed bearing in mind that there are divers working under the water.

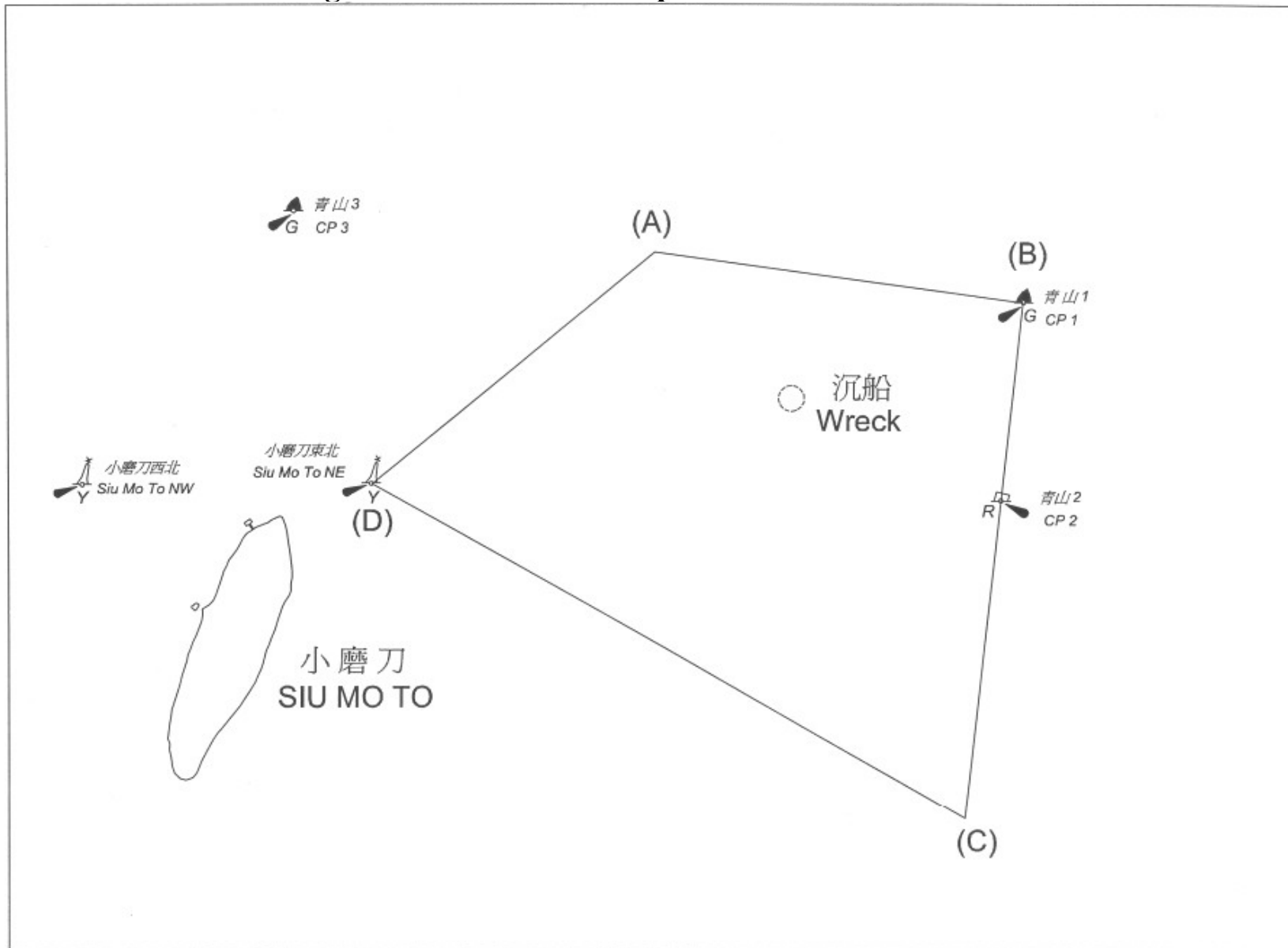
4. The Vessel Traffic Centre (VTC), Callsign "MARDEP", may implement special traffic control measures to guide the traffic from time to time. Such information will be broadcast by the VTC on V.H.F. channel 14 and 67 and all vessels navigating in the vicinity shall maintain a listening watch on these channels.

5. A drawing showing the salvage works area is attached to this Notice.
