

## **MARINE DEPARTMENT NOTICE NO. 57 OF 2008**

(Marine Works)

### **Marine Site Investigation to the North of Hong Kong International Airport**

With effect from 28 April 2008 and for a period of approximately 5 months, marine site investigation works involving drilling of boreholes will be carried out within the area bounded by straight lines joining the following co-ordinates (WGS 84 Datum): -

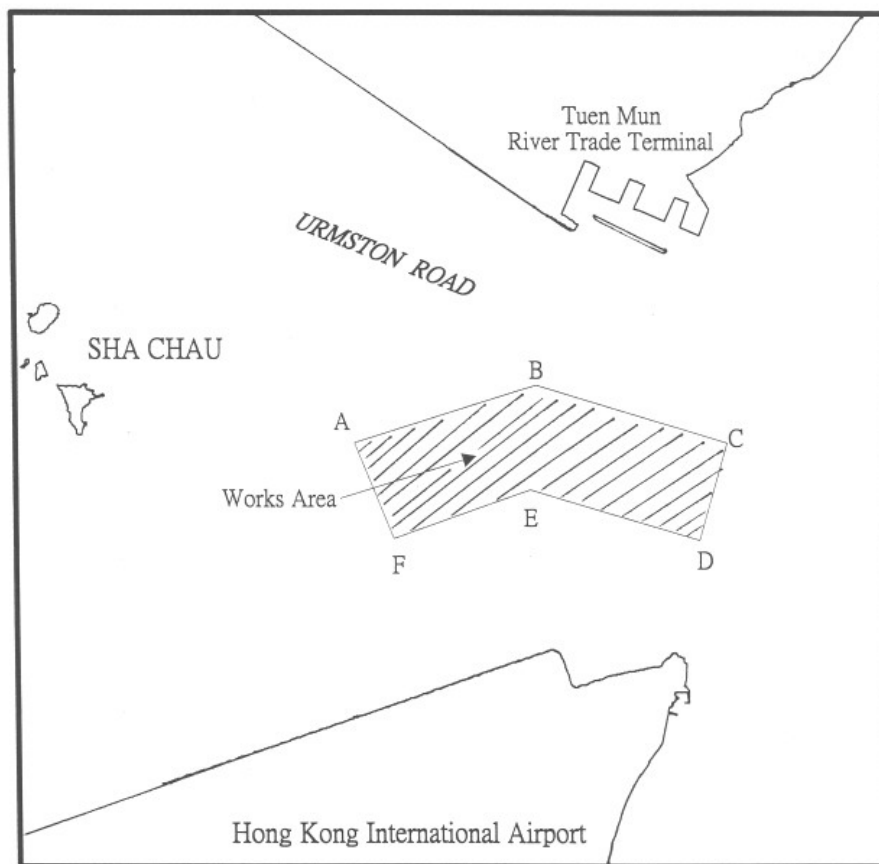
(A)	22° 20.502' N	113° 54.927' E
(B)	22° 20.802' N	113° 55.945' E
(C)	22° 20.505' N	113° 56.980' E
(D)	22° 20.000' N	113° 56.826' E
(E)	22° 20.259' N	113° 55.909' E
(F)	22° 20.006' N	113° 55.142' E

- Two drilling barges and two jack-up platforms will carry out the drilling works. One workboat will assist in the works from time to time.
- A working area of approximately 50 metres around the drilling barges will be established. Yellow marker buoys fitted with yellow flashing lights will be laid to mark the positions of the anchors extending from the barges.
- Yellow flashing lights, one at each corner of the platforms, will be established to indicate the position of the platforms.
- The hours of works will normally be from 0700 to 1900 hours. No works will be carried out on Sundays and public holidays. The working craft will stay in the works area outside the hours of works.
- Craft engaged in the operations will display signals as prescribed in international and local regulations.
- Vessels navigating in the vicinity should proceed with caution.
- A drawing showing the works area is attached to this Notice.
