

MARINE DEPARTMENT NOTICE NO. 85 OF 2008

(Marine Works)

Submarine Cable Inspection Works in Deep Water Bay and South Bay

With effect from 16 June 2008 and for a period of approximately five weeks, submarine cable inspection works will be carried out within the following two areas :-

Area 1: Deep Water Bay. This area is formed by straight lines joining the following co-ordinates (WGS 84 Datum) :-

(A)	22° 14.375'N	114° 11.207'E
(B)	22° 14.349'N	114° 11.228'E
(C)	22° 14.306'N	114° 11.167'E
(D)	22° 14.267'N	114° 11.047'E
(E)	22° 14.308'N	114° 11.034'E
(F)	22° 14.338'N	114° 11.153'E

Area 2: South Bay. This area is formed by straight lines joining the following co-ordinates (WGS 84 Datum) :-

(G)	22° 13.703'N	114° 11.767'E
(H)	22° 13.676'N	114° 11.794'E
(I)	22° 13.659'N	114° 11.792'E
(J)	22° 13.668'N	114° 11.705'E
(K)	22° 13.709'N	114° 11.712'E

2. One motor boat will carry out the works. One guard boat will provide assistance. The motor boat will work in one area at a time, but from time to time will alternate between the two works areas to suit operational requirements

3. A working area of approximately 50 metres around the motor boat will be established. The hours of works will normally be from 0800 to 1900 hours. No

works will be carried out on Sundays and public holidays. The motor boat and the guard boat will not stay in the works areas outside the hours of works.

4. Diving operations will be carried out from time to time during the hours of works.

5. Vessels engaged in the operations will display signals as prescribed in international and local regulations.

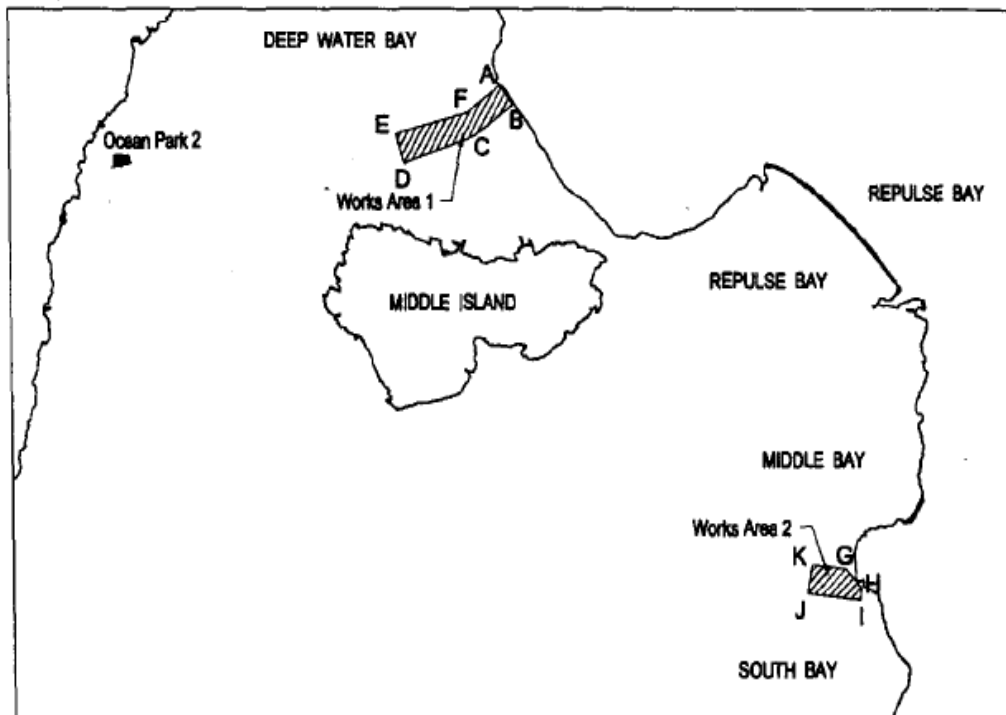
6. Vessels navigating in the vicinity should proceed with caution and keep well clear at slow speed, bearing in mind there are divers working in the area.
