

MARINE DEPARTMENT NOTICE NO. 91 OF 2008

(Marine Works)

Extension Works to a Pier at Tap Shek Kok, Urmston Road

With effect from 1 July 2008 and for a period of approximately 15 months, extension works to an existing pier will be carried out within the area bounded by straight lines joining the following co-ordinates (WGS 84 Datum) and the adjacent shoreline: -

(A) 22° 22.473'N 113° 54.953'E

(B) 22° 22.454'N 113° 54.933'E

(C) 22° 22.548'N 113° 54.808'E

(D) 22° 22.682'N 113° 54.922'E

(E) 22° 22.656'N 113° 54.961'E

2. The works will be carried out from three derricks barges and one flat top barge. One tug will provide assistance from time to time. The number of vessels engaged in the works will change from time to time to suit operational requirements.

3. A working area of approximately 50 metres around each of the barge will be established. Yellow marker buoys fitted with yellow flashing lights will be laid to mark the positions of the anchors extending from the barges.

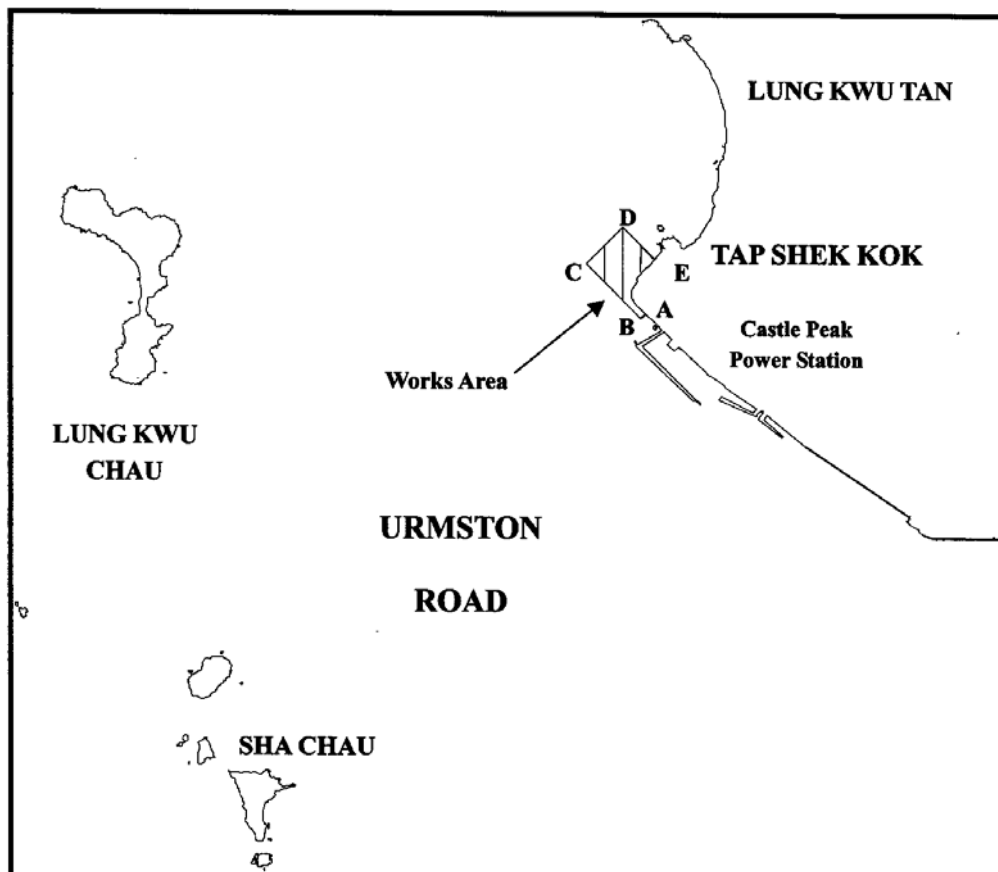
4. Several silt curtains will be established within the works area. The curtains will extend vertically from the sea surface to the seabed to enclose the pier during the works period. Yellow marker buoys fitted with yellow flashing lights will be laid to mark the extent of the silt curtains.

5. The hours of works will normally be from 0700 to 1900 hours. No works will be carried out on Sundays and public holidays. Vessels engaged in the works will stay in the works area outside the hours of works.
6. Diving operations will be carried out from time to time during the hours of works.
7. Vessels engaged in the operations will display signals as prescribed in international and local regulations.
8. Vessels navigating in the vicinity should proceed with caution and keep well clear at slow speed, bearing in mind there are divers working in the area.
9. A drawing showing the works area is attached to this Notice.
