

## **MARINE DEPARTMENT NOTICE NO. 5 OF 2009**

(Marine Works)

### **Marine Site Investigation off Black Point, Urmston Road**

With effect from 12 January 2009 and for a period of approximately 2 weeks, marine site investigation works involving drilling of boreholes will be carried out within the area bounded by straight lines joining the following co-ordinates (WGS 84 Datum) and the adjacent shoreline:

(A)	22° 24.246'N	113° 54.595'E
(B)	22° 23.866'N	113° 54.177'E
(C)	22° 23.839'N	113° 54.207'E
(D)	22° 24.184'N	113° 54.659'E

2. One jack-up platform will carry out the works. One tug and two launches will assist in the works from time to time.
3. A working area of approximately 25 metres will be established around the platform. Yellow flashing lights, one at each corner of the platform, will be established to indicate the position of the platform.
4. The hours of work will be from 0700 to 1900 hours. No works will be carried out on Sundays and public holidays. The platform will stay in the works area outside the hours of work.
5. Vessels engaged in the works will display signals as prescribed in international and local regulations.
6. Vessels navigating in the vicinity should proceed with caution and keep a wide berth.
7. A drawing showing the works area is attached to this Notice.

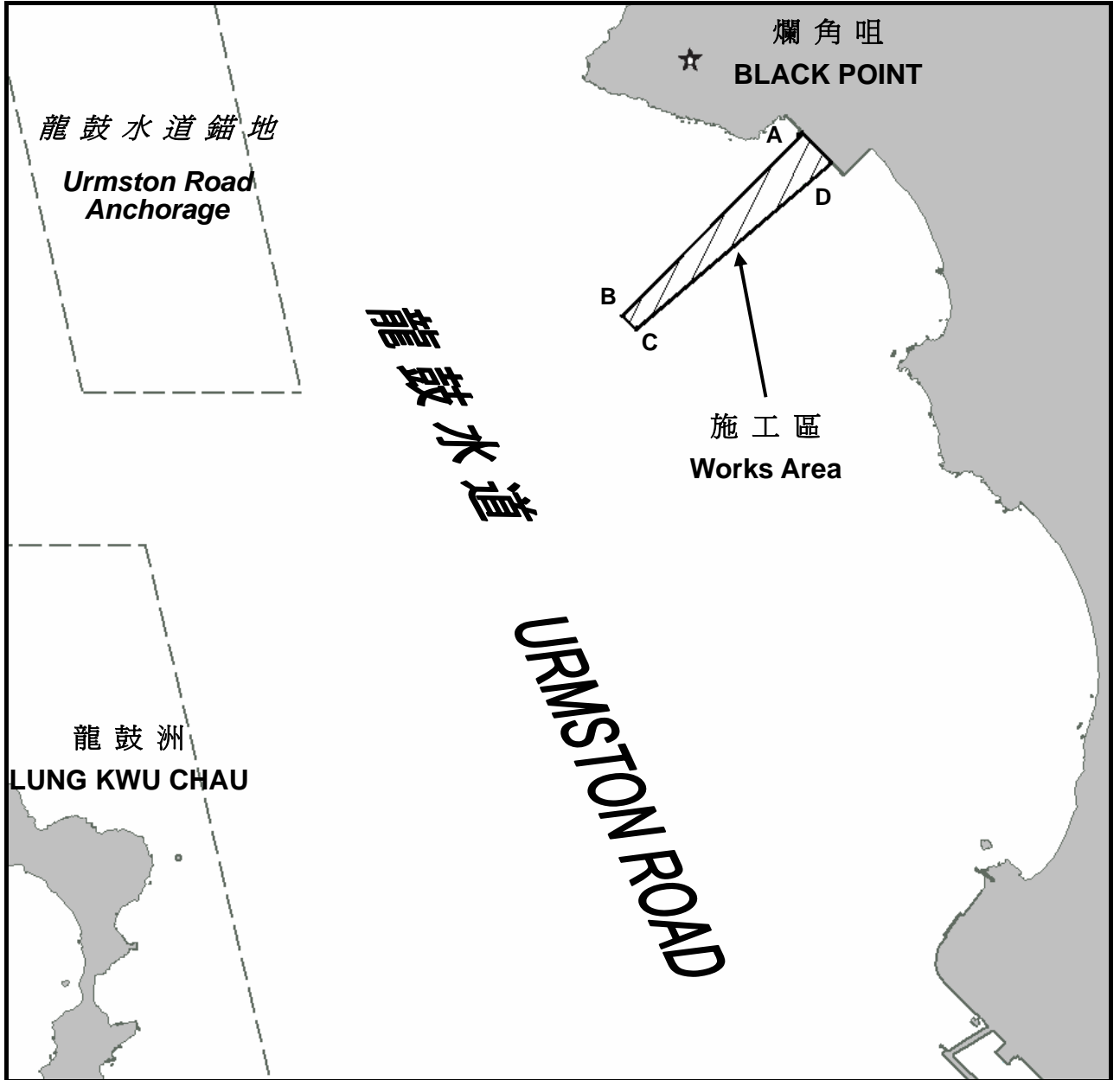
