

MARINE DEPARTMENT NOTICE NO. 9 OF 2009

(Marine Works)

Laying of Sewage Culverts to the North of Fenwick Pier, Wan Chai

With effect from 15 January 2009 and for a period of approximately ten days, laying operations of sewage culverts will be carried out within the area bounded by straight lines joining the following co-ordinates (WGS84 Datum) from (A) to (D):-

(A)	22° 17.016'N	114° 10.146'E
(B)	22° 17.007'N	114° 10.232'E
(C)	22° 16.921'N	114° 10.197'E
(D)	22° 16.917'N	114° 10.142'E

2. One crane barge will carry out the works. She will anchor close to a lighter delivering the sewage culverts. Some tugs and a guard boat will provide assistance. The number of vessels engaged in the works will change from time to time to suit operational requirements.

3. A working area of approximately 50 metres around the crane barge will be established. Yellow marker buoys fitted with yellow flashing lights will be laid to mark the positions of the anchors extending from the crane barge and the lighter.

4. The hours of work will be from 2300 hours to 0700 hours of the following day. Vessels engaged in the works will not stay in the works area outside the hours of work.

5. Vessels engaged in the works will display signals as prescribed in international and local regulations.

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6. Vessels navigating in the vicinity should proceed with caution at a slow speed to avoid generating excessive wash to the works area.

7. A drawing showing the works area is attached to this Notice.
