

MARINE DEPARTMENT NOTICE NO. 11 OF 2009

(Miscellaneous Information)

Yacht Races between Hong Kong and Macau

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that yacht races between Hong Kong and Macau will take place on 26 January 2009 (Monday) and 28 January 2009 (Wednesday). About 30 sailing boats are expected to participate in the races.

2. The outbound trip from Hong Kong to Macau will start at 1000 hours on 26 January 2009 in an area east of Lamma Island (approximately 1 nautical mile south of Wong Chuk Kok Light) and follow a route passing south of Lamma Island, south of Tai A Chau, thence to Macau.

3. The return trip from Macau to Hong Kong will start at 1030 hours on 28 January 2009, and then follow a route passing south of Tai A Chau and completing the race at east of Cheung Chau.

4. Masters, coxswains and persons-in-charge of vessels navigating in the vicinity should proceed with caution, giving practical consideration to those contestants. Compliance with the provisions of the International Regulations for Preventing Collisions at Sea 1972 is mandatory.

5. A drawing showing the race routes is attached to this notice.

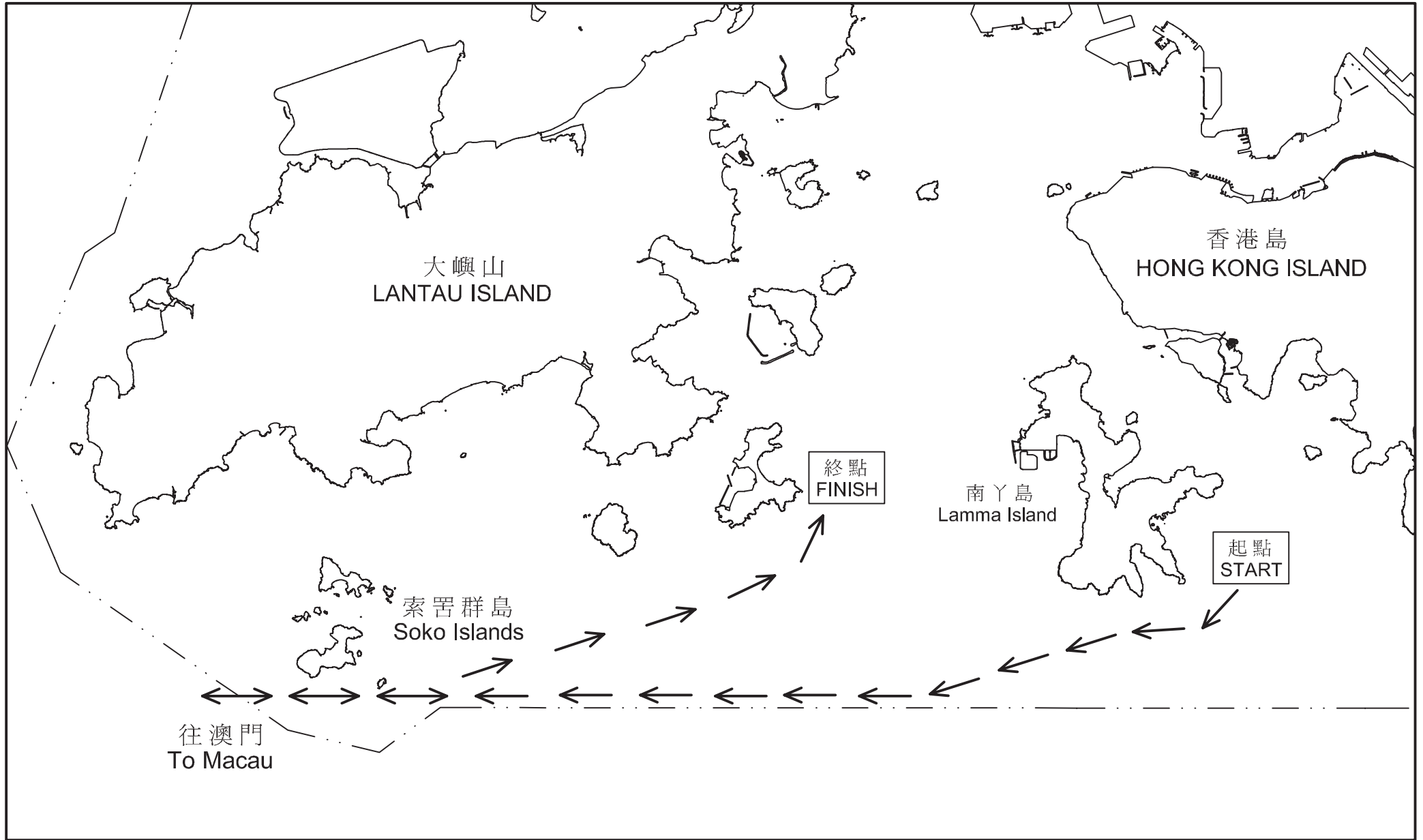
