

MARINE DEPARTMENT NOTICE NO. 19 OF 2009

(Marine Works)

Dredging Operations in Tuen Mun River Channel, Tuen Mun

With immediate effect and for a period of approximately 22 weeks, dredging operations will be carried out in an area in the Tuen Mun River Channel. This is the entrance section of the Channel. The section is bounded by a straight line joining position (A) and (B), and a straight line joining position (C) and (D). The co-ordinates (WGS 84 Datum) of the positions are as follows:

(A)	22° 22.898'N	113° 58.013'E
(B)	22° 22.903'N	113° 58.069'E
(C)	22° 22.716'N	113° 58.169'E
(D)	22° 22.687'N	113° 58.101'E

2. Three derrick lighters will carry out the dredging work. A tug and a split hopper barge will provide assistance. The number of vessels engaged in the works will change from time to time to suit operational requirements.
3. A working area of approximately 15 metres will be established around each lighter. Yellow marker buoys fitted with yellow flashing lights will be laid to mark the positions of the anchors extending from the lighters.
4. The works will be carried out from 0700 to 1900 hours. No works will be carried out on Sundays and public holidays. Outside the hours of work, the vessels engaged in the works will stay close to the shore between (A) and (D).
5. Vessels engaged in the operations will display signals as prescribed in international and local regulations.
6. Vessels navigating in the vicinity should proceed with caution.
7. A drawing showing the works area is attached to this Notice.

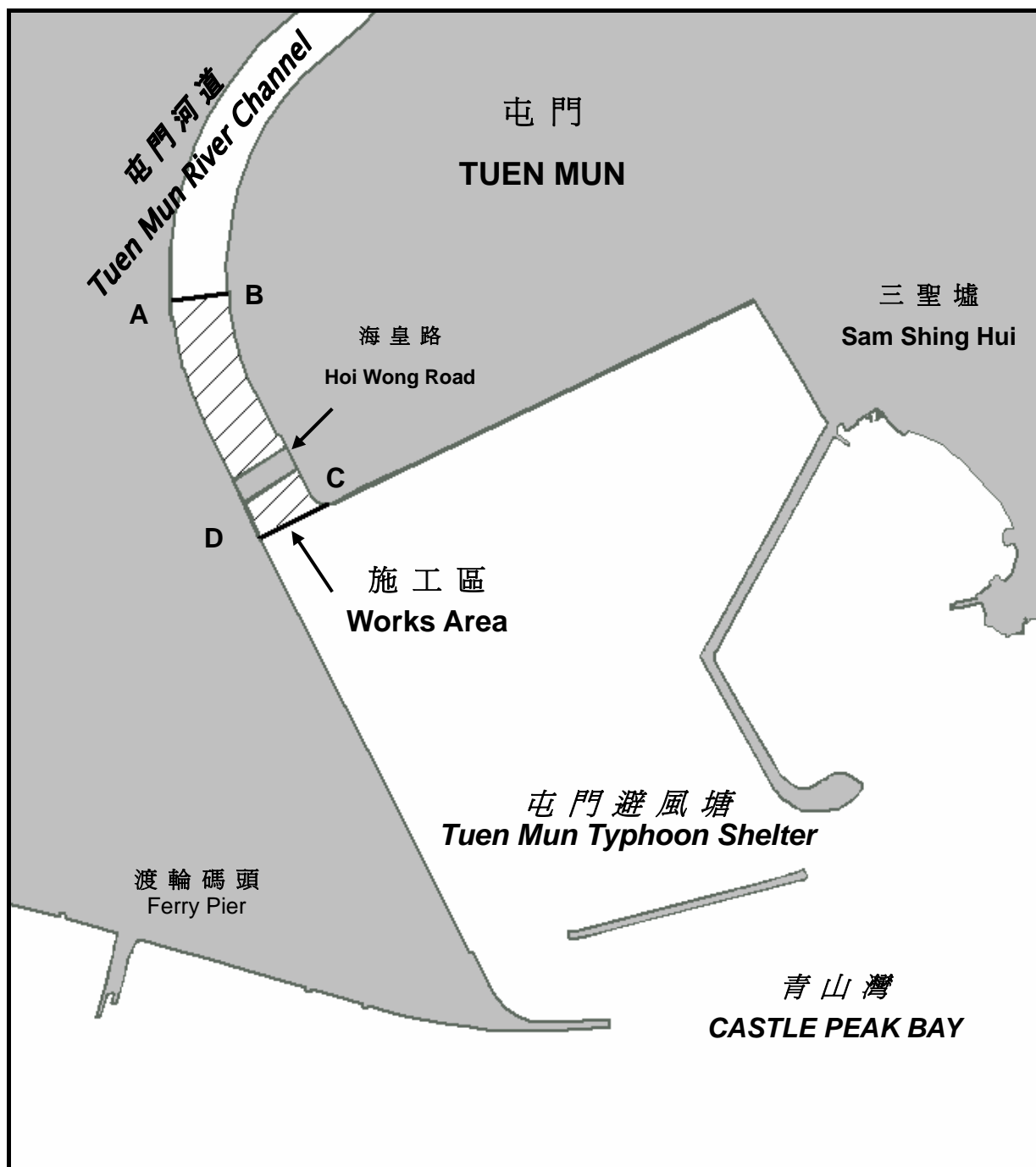
