

MARINE DEPARTMENT NOTICE NO. 20 OF 2009

(Marine Works)

Construction of Two Piers to the East of Hong Kong International Airport

With immediate effect and for a period of approximately 7 months, construction of two piers will be carried out within the area bounded by straight lines joining the following co-ordinates (WGS 84 Datum) and the adjacent shoreline:

(A)	22° 19.109' N	113° 56.652' E
(B)	22° 19.098' N	113° 56.710' E
(C)	22° 19.031' N	113° 56.700' E
(D)	22° 19.042' N	113° 56.637' E

- Two derrick lighters will carry out the works. One barge and three tugs will assist in the works from time to time.
- A working area of approximately 50 metres around each derrick lighter will be established. Yellow marker buoys fitted with yellow flashing lights will be laid to mark the positions of the anchors extending from each derrick lighter.
- The works will be carried out round-the-clock.
- Vessels engaged in the works will display signals as prescribed in international and local regulations.
- Vessels navigating in the vicinity should proceed with caution.
- A drawing showing the works area is attached to this Notice.

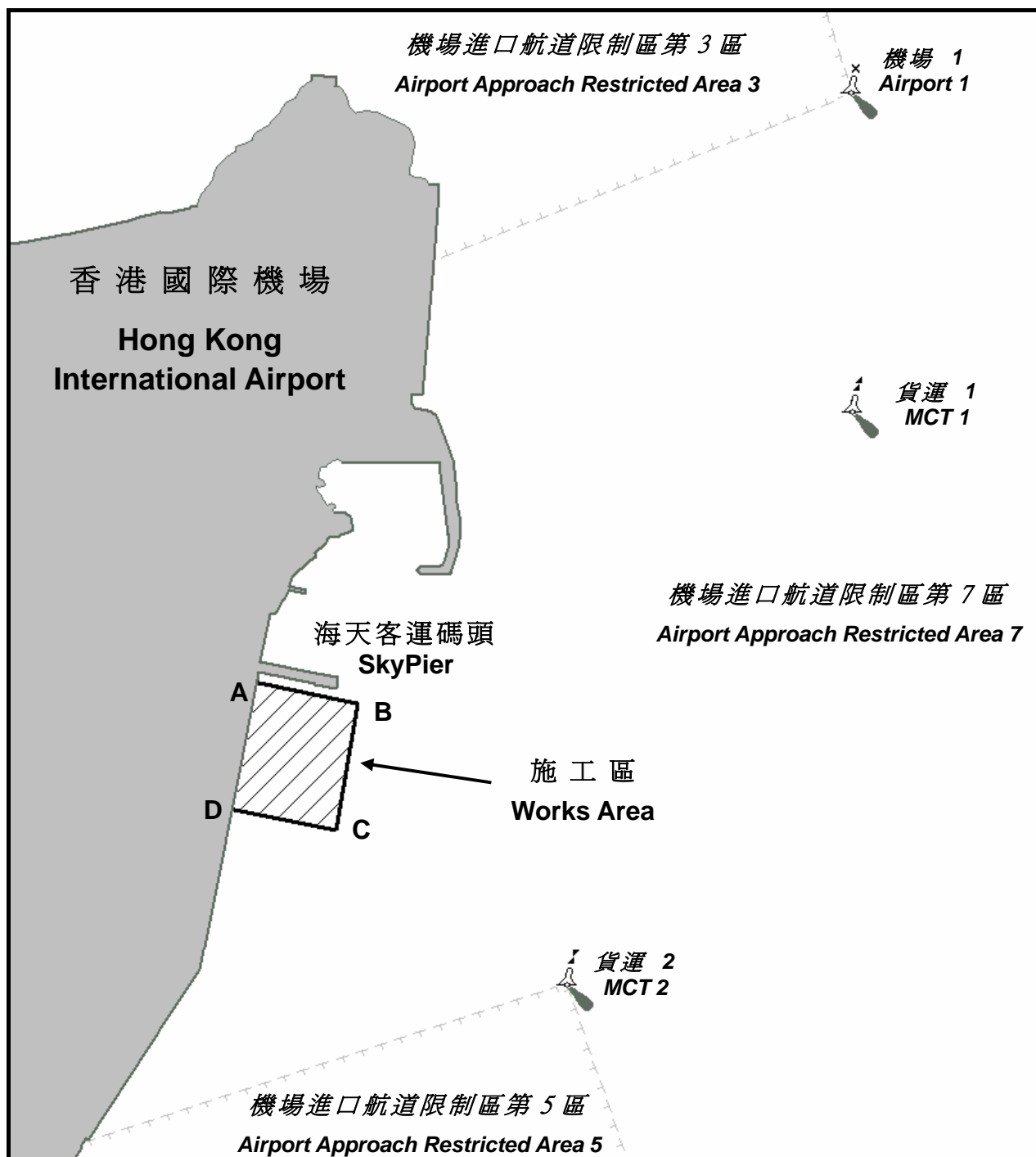
