

MARINE DEPARTMENT NOTICE NO. 22 OF 2009

(Marine Works)

Marine Site Investigation in Aberdeen Typhoon Shelter near Ap Lei Chau Bridge

With effect from 21 February 2009 and for a period of two days, marine site investigation works involving diving operations will be carried out at the following positions (WGS 84 Datum):-

(A)	22° 14.756'N	114° 09.590'E
(B)	22° 14.739'N	114° 09.610'E
(C)	22° 14.728'N	114° 09.624'E

2. One motor boat will carry out the works. One guard boat will provide assistance.
3. A working area of approximately 25 metres around the motor boat will be established. One yellow marker buoy fitted with yellow flashing light will be laid to mark the position of the anchor extending from the motor boat.
4. The hours of work will normally be from 1000 to 1700 hours. The motor boat and the guard boat will not stay in the positions outside the hours of work.
5. Diving operations will be carried out from time to time during the hours of work.
6. Vessels engaged in the operations will display signals as prescribed in international and local regulations.
7. Vessels navigating in the vicinity should keep well clear and proceed with caution at a slow speed to avoid generating excessive wash.

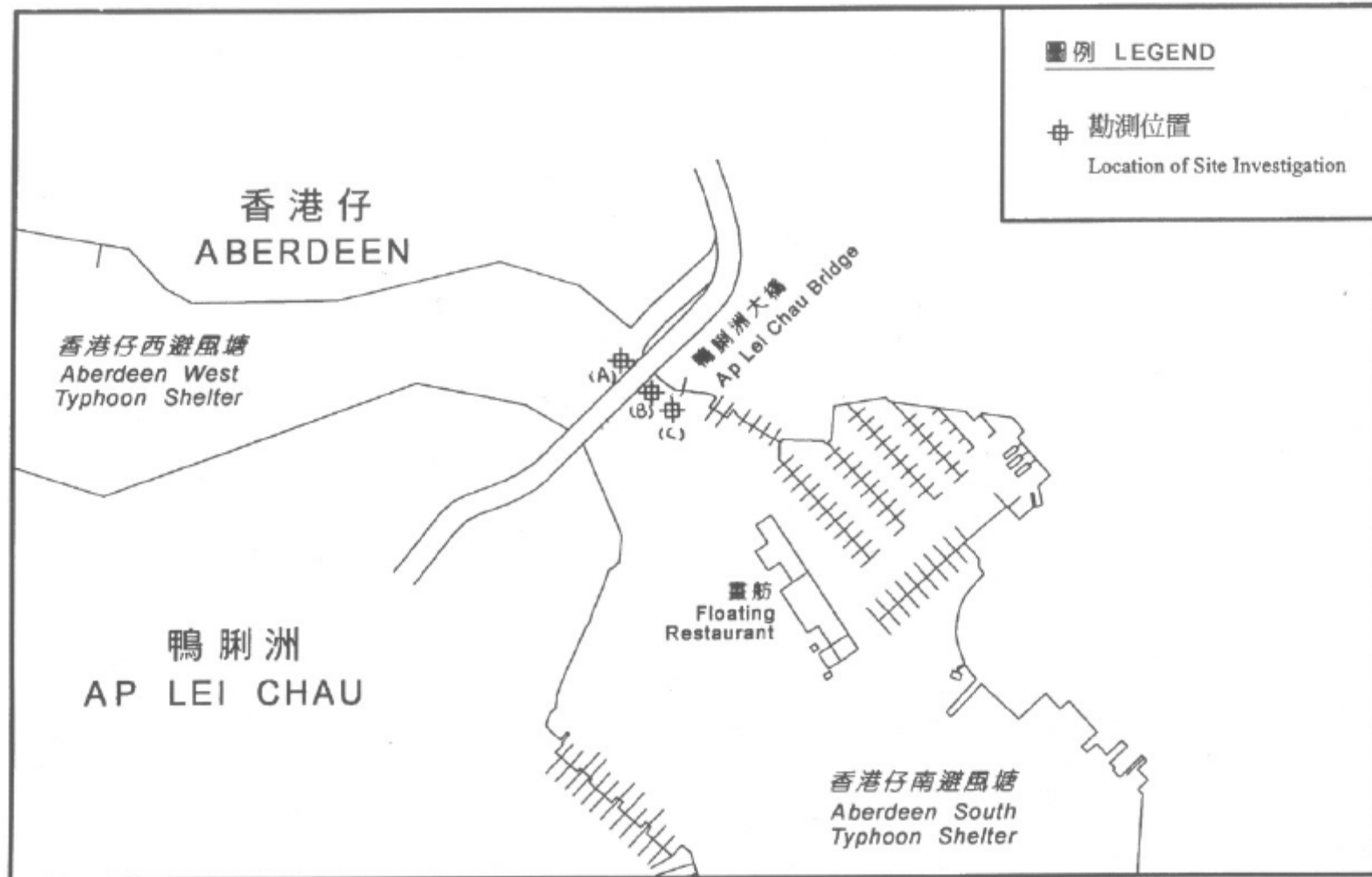
