

MARINE DEPARTMENT NOTICE NO. 26 OF 2009

(Establishment, Withdrawal and Changes of Aids to Navigation,
Fairways, Anchorages & Other Port Facilities)

**Temporary withdrawal and establishment of light buoys
off Pillar Point, Urmston Road**

Notice is hereby given that notwithstanding Marine Department Notice No. 146 of 2008 has been superseded, the temporary withdrawal of the navigation light buoy “UR 2” at position 22° 21.769’ N 113° 54.820’ E will continue to be effective until further notice to facilitate the submarine pipeline laying operations across Urmston Road between Pillar Point and Sha Chau.

2. During the period when “UR2” is temporarily withdrawn, a special mark light buoy will be established to mark the 15 metres depth contour line. The particulars of the buoy are:

Type	:	Special Mark
Position (WGS 84 Datum)	:	22° 21.541’ N 113° 54.659’ E
Colour	:	Yellow
Shape	:	Pillar
Topmark	:	Yellow “X”
Colour of Light	:	Yellow
Rhythm of Light	:	Continuous quick

3. A drawing showing the positions of the above light buoys is attached to this Notice.

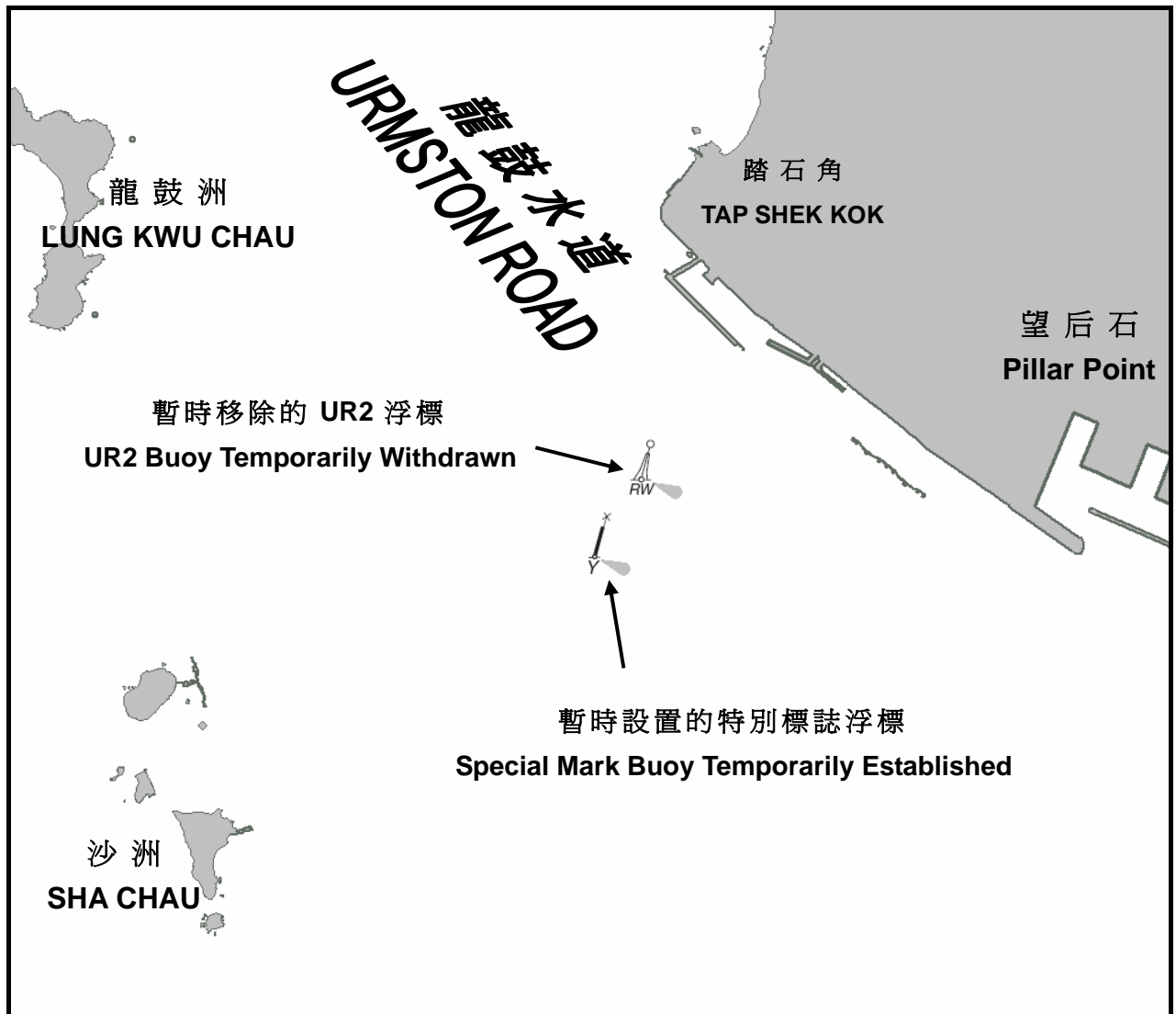
