

MARINE DEPARTMENT NOTICE NO. 29 OF 2009

(Marine Works)

Marine Site Investigation in Adamasta Channel

With immediate effect and for a period of approximately 7 weeks, marine site investigation works involving drilling of boreholes will be carried out at the following positions (WGS 84 Datum):

(A)	22° 13.483'N	114° 01.028'E
(B)	22° 13.455'N	114° 01.067'E
(C)	22° 13.299'N	114° 01.232'E
(D)	22° 13.146'N	114° 01.385'E
(E)	22° 13.116'N	114° 01.430'E
(F)	22° 13.108'N	114° 01.465'E

2. Two jack-up platforms will carry out the works at any two of the above positions. During the works period, the platforms may be towed across the Adamasta Channel while shifting from one works position to another. One tug will assist in the works from time to time.

3. A working area of approximately 25 metres will be established around each of the platforms. Yellow flashing lights, one at each corner of the platforms, will be established to indicate the position of the platforms.

4. The hours of work will be from 0700 to 1900 hours. No works will be carried out on Sundays and public holidays. The platforms will stay at any two of the above positions outside the hours of work.

5. The platforms and the tug will display signals as prescribed in international and local regulations.

6. Vessels navigating in the vicinity should proceed with caution and keep a wide berth.

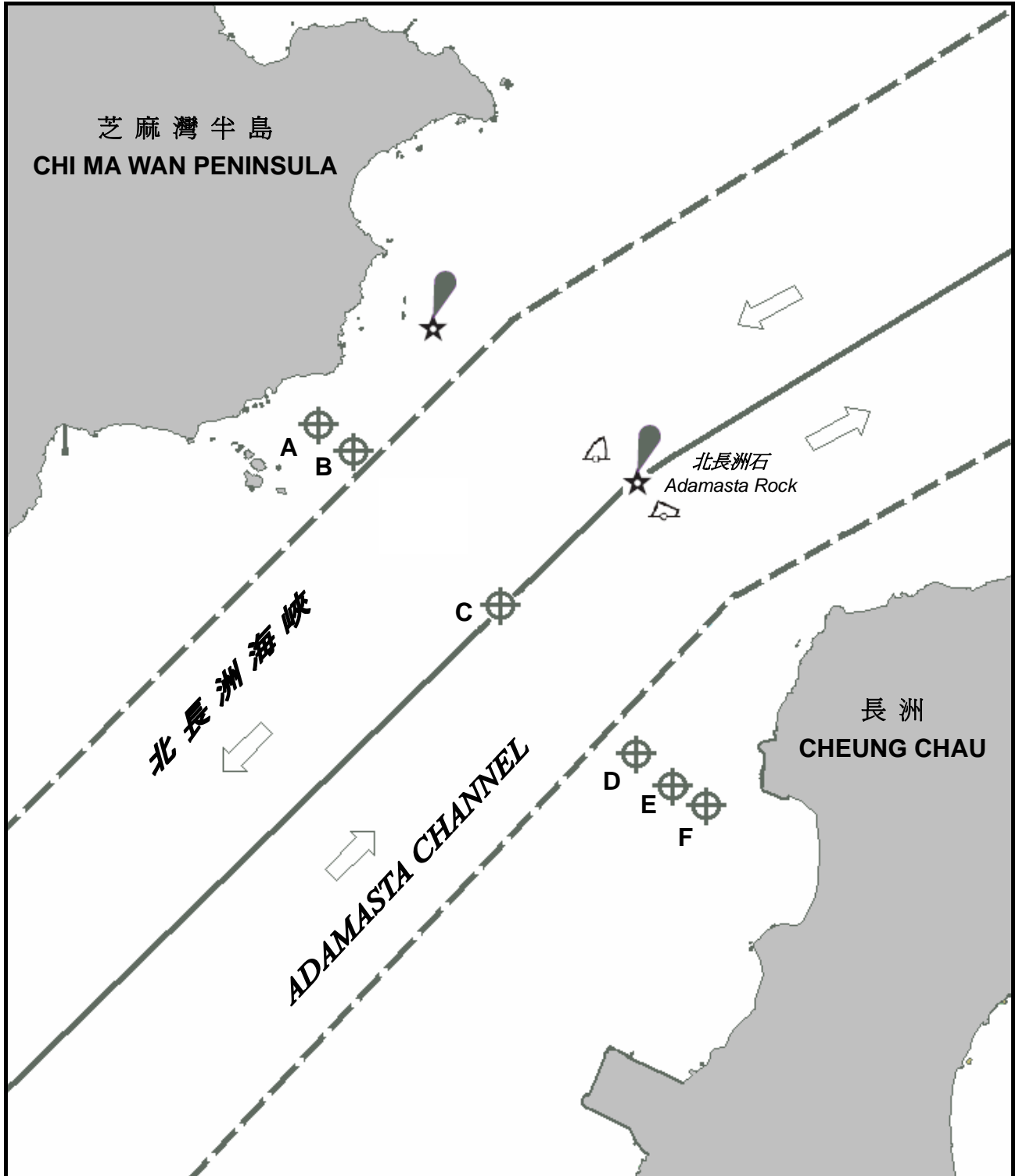
7. A drawing showing the positions of the boreholes is attached to this Notice.
