

MARINE DEPARTMENT NOTICE NO. 36 OF 2009

(Marine Works)

Laying of Artificial Reef Units in Outer Port Shelter

With immediate effect and for a period of approximately four months, laying of artificial reef units will be carried out in Outer Port Shelter (Ngau Mei Hoi) within the following areas:

Area 1: This area is bounded by straight lines joining the following co-ordinates (WGS 84 Datum) from (A) to (D):-

(A)	22° 18.273'N	114° 21.376'E
(B)	22° 18.273'N	114° 21.493'E
(C)	22° 18.164'N	114° 21.493'E
(D)	22° 18.164'N	114° 21.376'E

Area 2: This area is bounded by straight lines joining the following co-ordinates (WGS 84 Datum) from (E) to (H):-

(E)	22° 18.086'N	114° 20.366'E
(F)	22° 17.977'N	114° 20.366'E
(G)	22° 17.977'N	114° 20.482'E
(H)	22° 18.086'N	114° 20.482'E

2. The laying operations will be carried out by one split bottom barge. One tug and one motor boat will provide assistance. The barge will work in one area at a time, and will alternate between the two works areas to suit operational requirements.

3. A working area of approximately 50 metres around the barge will be established.

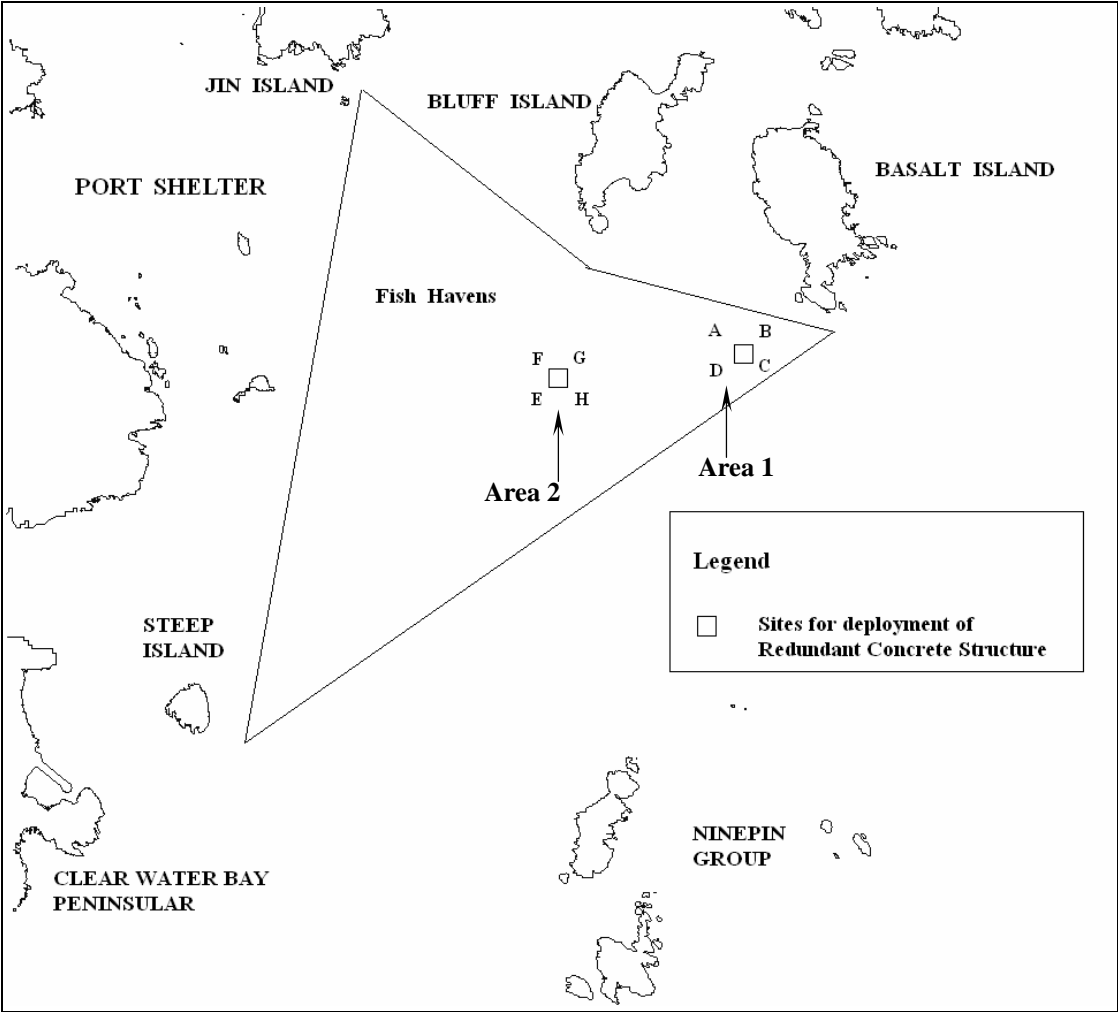
4. The hours of work will be from 0800 to 1800 hours. The working vessels will not stay in the works area outside the hours of work.

5. Vessels engaged in the operations will display signals as prescribed in international and local regulations.
6. Vessels navigating in the vicinity should proceed with caution and keep well clear at slow speed.
7. A drawing showing the works areas is attached to this Notice.
8. This Notice is an extension of Marine Department Notice No. 149 of 2008.
