(Navigational & Seamanship Safety Practices)

Marine Sporting Activities For The Year 2009

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the following marine sporting activities under the auspices of various clubs and associations will take place throughout the year in areas listed below. This list is not exhaustive. Races will normally be conducted during weekends and Public Holidays unless otherwise specified.

- Yacht Races : Eastern Victoria Harbour, Junk Bay, Tathong Channel, Repulse Bay, Deep Water Bay, Tai Tam Bay, Stanley Bay, West Lamma Channel, Port Shelter, Rocky Harbour, Mirs Bay, Tolo Harbour, Plover Cove, and areas off Ninepin Group, Po Toi Island, the north and south of Lantau Island, and south of Lamma Island.
- Windsurfing Races : Tung Wan off Cheung Chau, Stanley Bay, Tai Tam Bay, Shek O Wan, Sheung Sze Mun, Inner Port Shelter, Tolo Harbour, Plover Cove, Long Harbour and Lung Kwu Tan.
- Canoe Races : Tolo Harbour, Plover Cove, Shing Mun River, Long Harbour, Port Shelter, Rocky Harbour, Repulse Bay, South Bay, Deep Water Bay, Tai Tam Bay, Stanley Bay, Castle Peak Bay and areas off Cheung Chau.
- Dragon Boat, Colour Boat & Rowing Boat Races : Cheung Chau Typhoon Shelter, Aberdeen Typhoon Shelter, Tuen Mun Typhoon Shelter, Shau Kei Wan Typhoon Shelter, Chai Wan Cargo Handling Basin, Deep Water Bay, Repulse Bay, Tai Tam Bay, Stanley Bay, Tai Tam Harbour, Yung Shue Wan, Picnic Bay, Luk Chau Wan, Inner Port Shelter, Sha Ha, Hebe Haven, Shing Mun River, Tolo Harbour, Pui O Wan, Discovery Bay, Tai O and areas off Tap Mun, Lamma Island, Po Toi Island, Peng Chau and Mui Wo.
(April – October 2009)
- Angling Competition : Inner Port Shelter, Port Shelter, Rocky Harbour, areas off north, west and east of Lamma Island, Kau Yi Chau, Lantau Island, Ma Wan, Kau Sai Chau, Tiu Chung Chau, Bluff Island, Town Island, Basalt Island, and Tung Lung Chau.
- Speed Boat & Water Ski Races : Port Shelter, areas off Peng Chau, Sha Ha, Kau Sai Chau, Tiu Chung Chau, and Tai Tau Chau.
- Swimming Races : Repulse Bay, Deep Water Bay, South Bay, Plover Cove, Tsam Chuk Wan, and area off Approach Beach, Cafeteria Beach, Golden Beach, St. Stephen's Beach, Stanley Main Beach and Kwun Cham Wan.

2. Masters, coxswains and persons-in-charge of all vessels navigating in these areas should proceed with caution at all times giving practical consideration to the contestants.

3. Compliance with the provisions of the International Regulations for Preventing Collisions at Sea, 1972 is mandatory.
