

MARINE DEPARTMENT NOTICE NO. 56 OF 2009

(Marine Works)

**Marine Works off Central Pier 9
and
Temporary Closure of Landing Steps Nos. 4, 5 & 6 of Central Pier 9**

With effect from 1 May 2009 and for a period of approximately two months, unloading of concrete units and construction of seawall will be carried out in an area adjacent to Central Pier 9. The area is bounded by straight lines joining the following co-ordinates (WGS 84 Datum) and the adjacent shoreline:

(A)	22° 17.166'N	114° 09.780'E
(B)	22° 17.145'N	114° 09.787'E
(C)	22° 17.137'N	114° 09.744'E

2. One derrick lighter will carry out the works. A few tugs and a motor boat will provide assistance. The number of vessels engaged in the works will change from time to time to suit operational requirements.
3. A working area of approximately 50 metres around the lighter will be established. Yellow marker buoys fitted with yellow flashing lights will be laid to mark the positions of the anchors extending from the lighter.
4. The hours of work will normally be from 0001 to 0600 hours. The vessels engaged in the works will not stay in the works area outside the hours of work.
5. No works will be carried out on Saturdays, Sundays and public holidays.
6. During the works period, Landing Steps Nos. 4, 5 and 6 of Central Pier 9 will be closed to marine traffic during the hours of works from 0001 to 0600. Vessels intending to berth at Central Pier 9 during the closure period should use Landing Steps Nos. 1, 2 and 3.

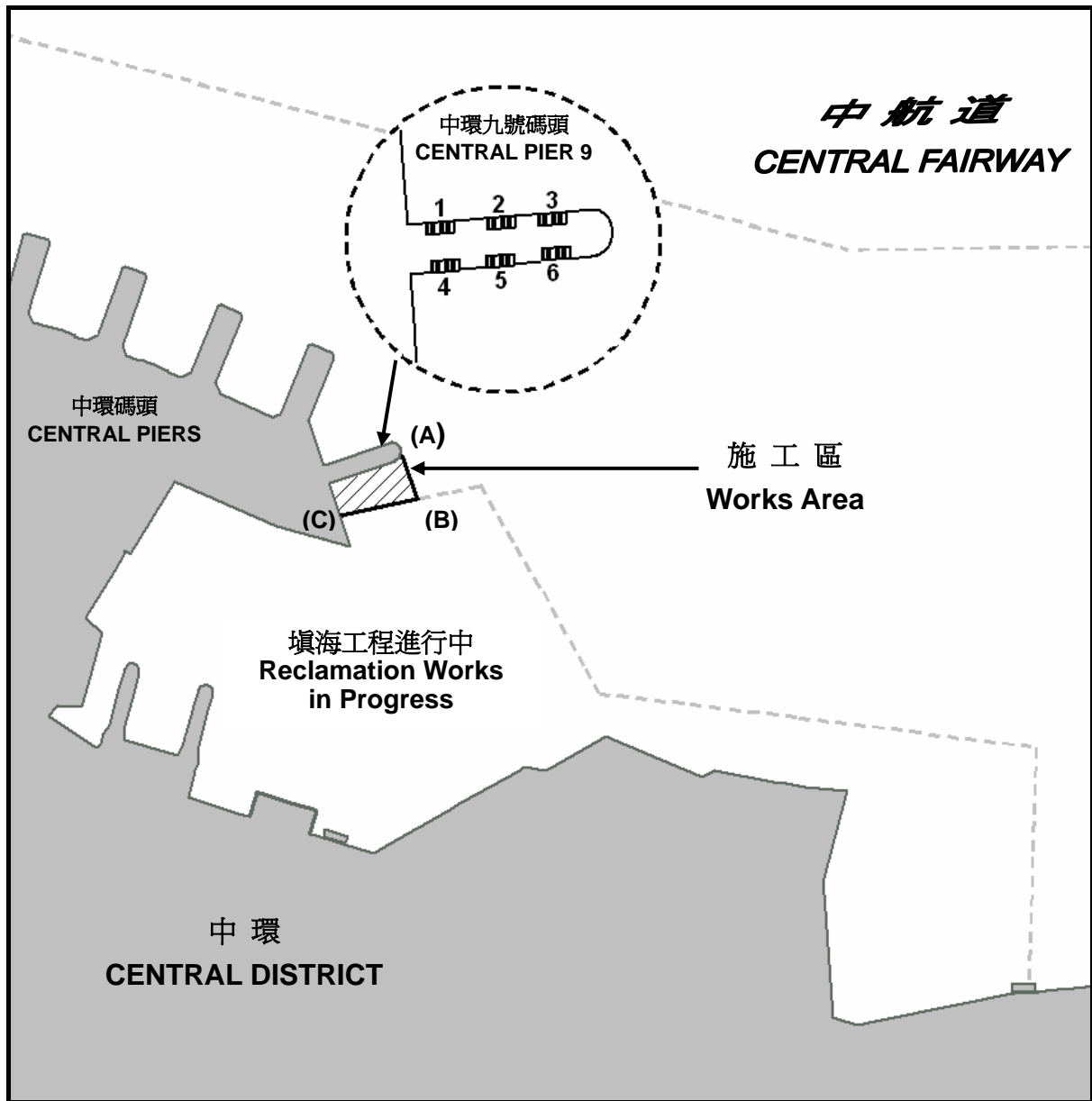
7. Vessels engaged in the works will display signals as prescribed in international and local regulations.
8. Vessels navigating in the vicinity should proceed with caution.
9. A drawing showing the works area and locations of the landing steps of Central Pier 9 is attached to this Notice.
