

MARINE DEPARTMENT NOTICE NO. 59 OF 2009

(Marine Works)

Seawall Construction Works on Middle Island

With effect from 11 May 2009 and for a period of approximately 17 months, seawall construction works will be carried out within the area bounded by straight lines joining the following co-ordinates (WGS 84 Datum) from (A) to (F) and the adjacent shoreline:

(A)	22° 14.126'N	114° 11.169'E
(B)	22° 14.148'N	114° 11.151'E
(C)	22° 14.169'N	114° 11.165'E
(D)	22° 14.173'N	114° 11.263'E
(E)	22° 14.152'N	114° 11.270'E
(F)	22° 14.155'N	114° 11.293'E

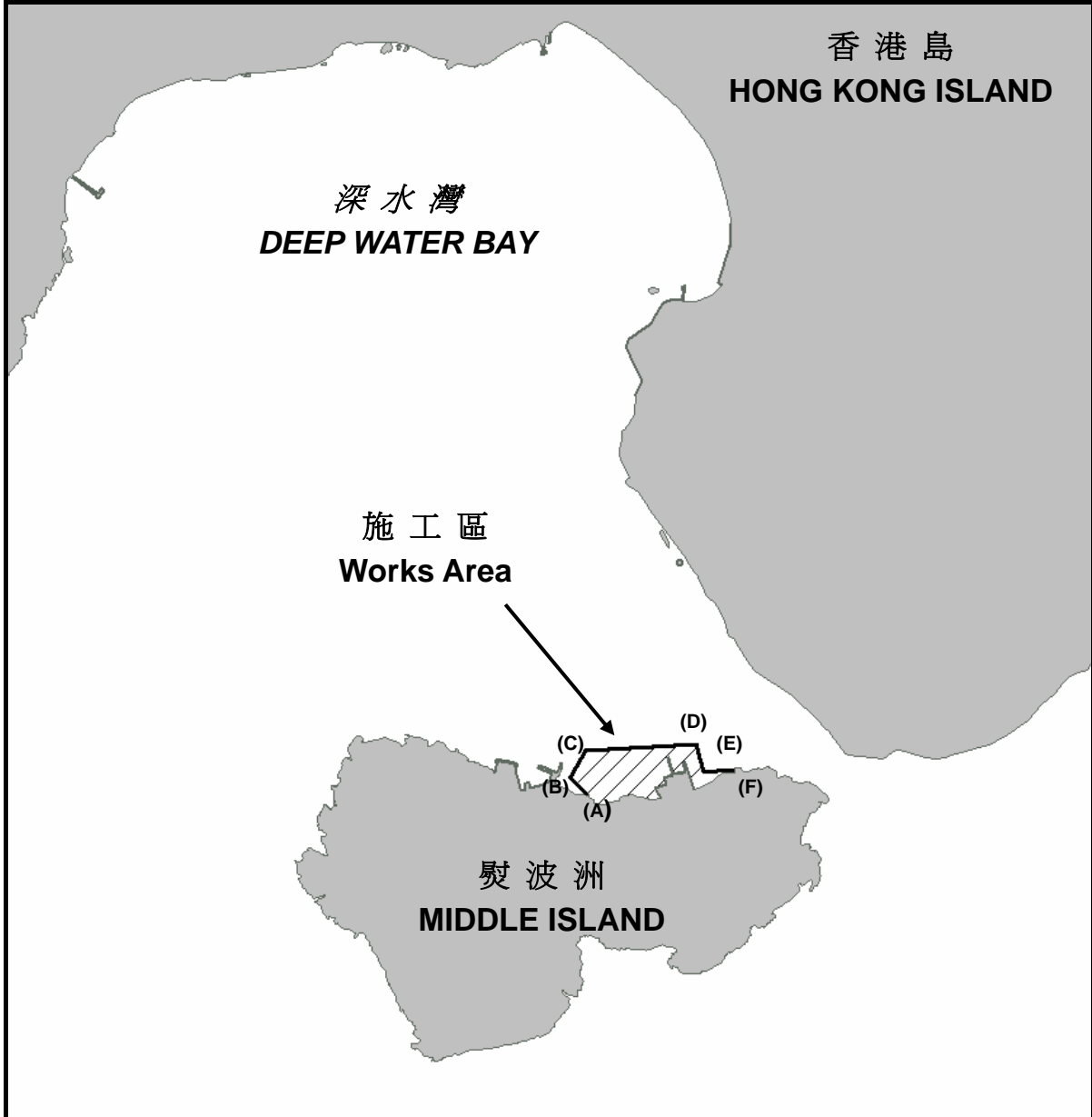
2. The works will be conducted by one hopper barge. One tug and a few motor boats will assist in the works. The number of vessels engaged in the works will change from time to time to suit operational requirements.
3. A working area of approximately 50 metres around the hopper barge will be established. Yellow marker buoys fitted with yellow flashing lights will be laid to mark the positions of the anchors extending from the barge.
4. The hours of works will be from 0800 to 1800 hours. No works will be carried out on Saturdays, Sundays and public holidays. Vessels engaged in the works will stay within the works area outside the hours of work.
5. Vessels engaged in the works will display signals as prescribed in international and local regulations.
6. Vessels navigating in the vicinity should proceed with caution.
7. A drawing showing the works area is attached to this Notice.
