

## **MARINE DEPARTMENT NOTICE NO. 68 OF 2009**

**(Marine Works)**

### **Repair Works to the Landing Steps at Tai Long Pai, Tathong Channel**

With immediate effect until the end of August 2009, repair works to the landing steps at Tai Long Pai will be carried out within a works area bounded by straight lines joining the following co-ordinates (WGS 84 Datum) and the adjacent shoreline:

(A)	22° 14.025'N	114° 15.934'E
(B)	22° 14.090'N	114° 15.881'E
(C)	22° 14.139'N	114° 15.951'E
(D)	22° 14.074'N	114° 16.003'E

2. The works will be carried out from two crane barges, one derrick lighter, two tugs and two motor boats. The number of vessels engaged in the works will change from time to time to suit operational requirements.

3. A working area of approximately 50 metres around each of the crane barges and the derrick lighter will be established. Yellow marker buoys fitted with yellow flashing lights will be laid to mark the positions of the anchors extending from the barges and the lighter.

4. Several silt curtains will be established within the works area. Each silt curtain is a large piece of netting, extending from the sea surface to the seabed, used to contain mud and sediments within the works area. Small floating markers, yellow in colour and fitted with yellow flashing lights, will be laid to mark the extent of the silt curtains.

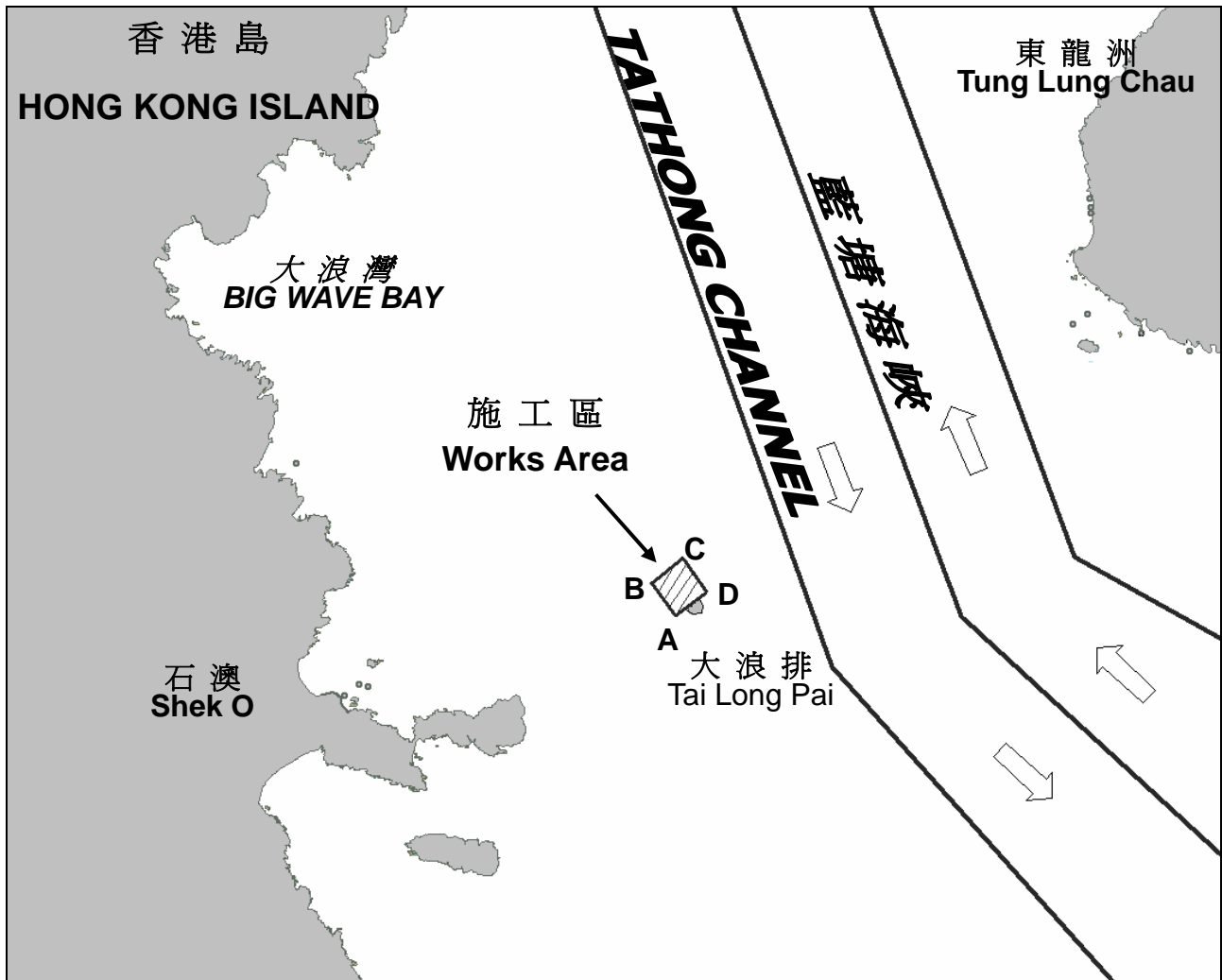
5. Diving Operations will be carried out from time to time during the hours of work.
6. The works will be carried out from 0700 to 1900 hours. No works will be carried out on Sundays and public holidays. The vessels employed in the works will stay in the works area outside the hours of work.
7. Vessels engaged in the works will display signals as prescribed in international and local regulations.
8. Vessels navigating in the vicinity should proceed with caution and keep clear at slow speed, bearing in mind there are divers working in the area.
9. A drawing showing the works area is attached to this Notice.
10. This Notice is an extension of Marine Department Notice No. 160 of 2008.
