

## **MARINE DEPARTMENT NOTICE NO. 69 OF 2009**

(Marine Works)

### **Diving Operations for Current Meters Established off Yau Kom Tau and at Western Dangerous Goods Anchorage**

With effect from 8 June 2009 and for a period of approximately six days, diving operations for inspection of the current meter established on the seabed in each of the following locations promulgated by Marine Department Notice No. 62 of 2009 will be carried out:

#### **Co-ordinates (WGS 84 Datum)**

**Location (A):** 22° 21.907'N 114° 05.440'E  
(Yau Kom Tau)

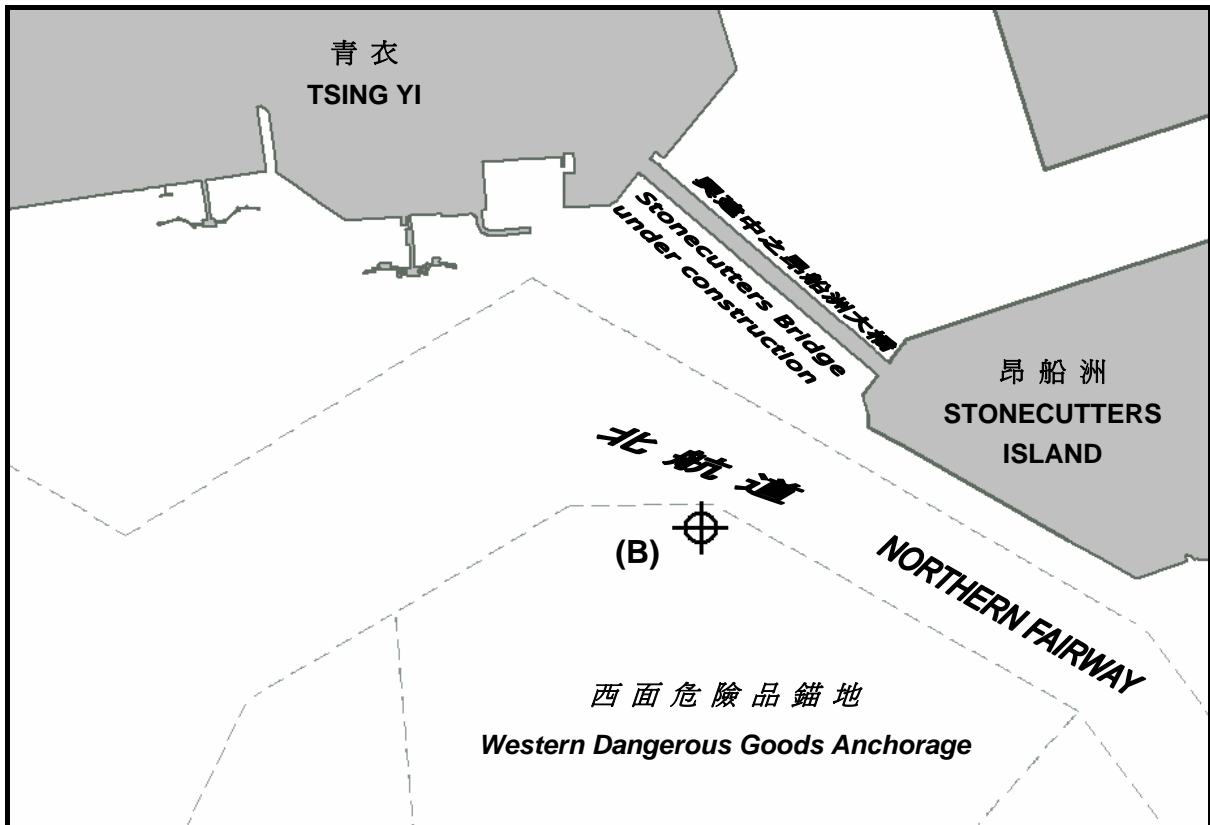
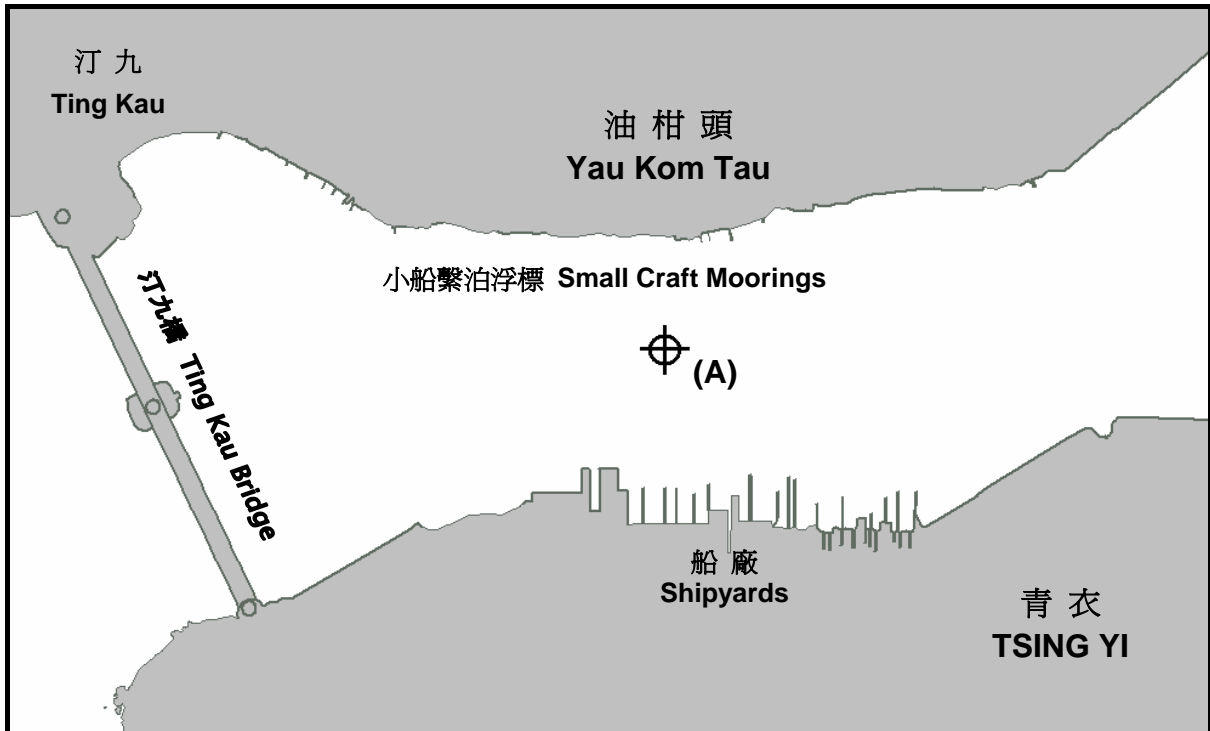
**Location (B):** 22° 19.134'N 114° 06.999'E  
(Western Dangerous Goods Anchorage)

2. The diving operations will be carried out from a derrick lighter. The lighter will work in one location at any one time. One tug and one motor boat will assist in the works.
3. A working area of approximately 50 metres around the derrick lighter will be established. Yellow marker buoys fitted with yellow flashing lights will be laid to mark the positions of the anchors extending from the lighter.
4. The diving operations will normally be carried out from 0700 to 1900 hours. Vessels engaged in the works will not stay at the above locations outside the hours of work.
5. Vessels engaged in the operations will display signals as prescribed in international and local regulations.
6. Vessels navigating in the vicinity should proceed with caution at a slow speed and keep clear of the derrick lighter, bearing in mind that there are divers working in the area.
7. A drawing showing the locations of the current meters is attached to this Notice.
