

MARINE DEPARTMENT NOTICE NO. 70 OF 2009

(Marine Works)

Silt Curtain at Tai Shue Wan, South of Hong Kong Island

With immediate effect until the end of September 2009, a silt curtain will be established and laid along the following co-ordinates (WGS 84):

(A)	22°14.117'N	114°10.025'E
(B)	22°14.125'N	114°10.017'E
(C)	22°14.136'N	114°10.016'E
(D)	22°14.145'N	114°10.022'E
(E)	22°14.148'N	114°10.034'E

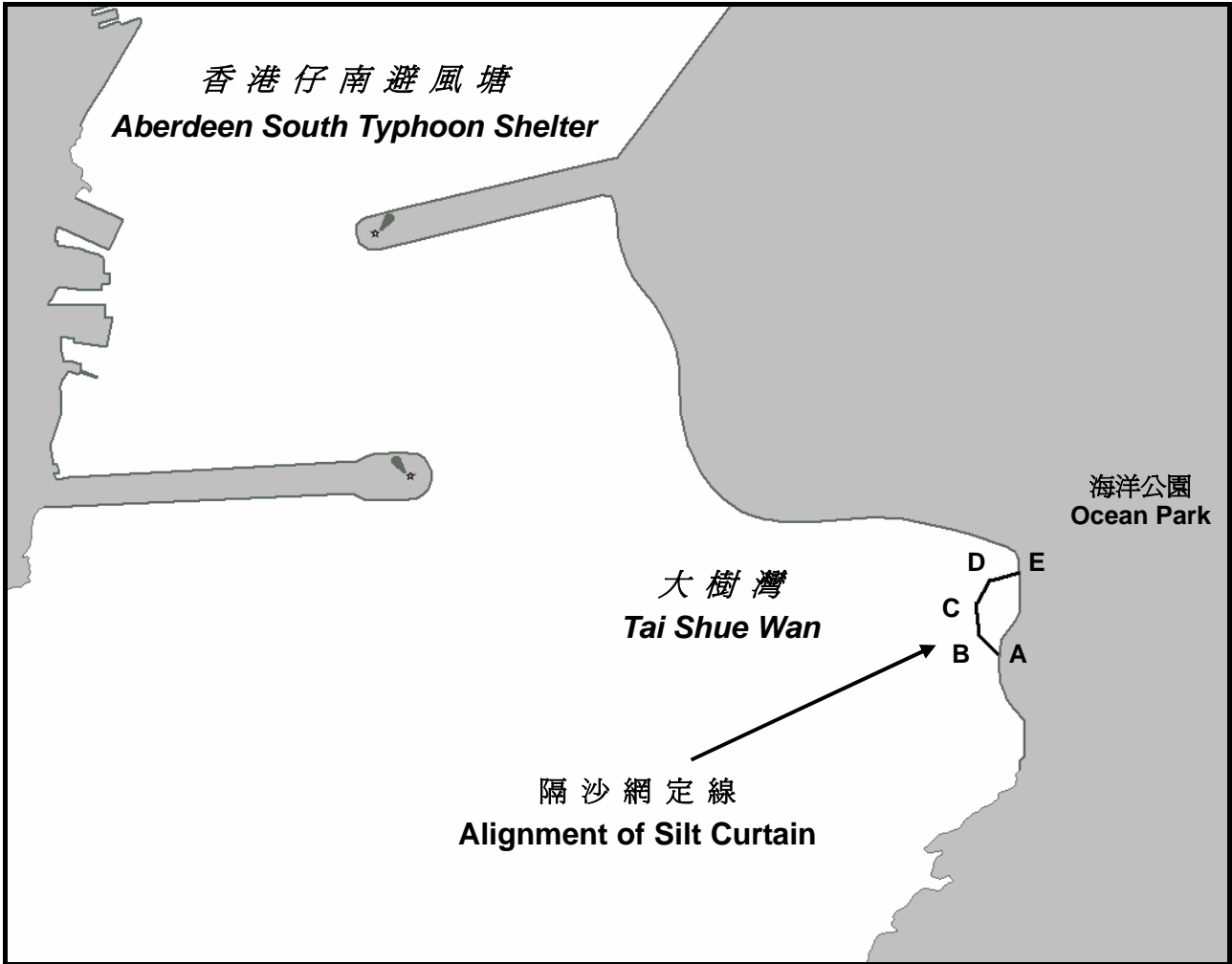
2. The silt curtain will extend vertically from the sea surface to the seabed. Yellow marker buoys fitted with yellow flashing lights will be laid along the surface of the silt curtain at a spacing of approximately 50 metres to mark the extent of the silt curtain.
3. Diving operations will be carried out from a work boat from time to time during the laying operation, inspection and maintenance works.
4. Vessels engaged in the operations will display signals as prescribed in international and local regulations.
5. Vessels navigating in the vicinity should proceed with caution and keep clear at slow speed, bearing in mind there are divers working in the area.
6. A drawing showing the alignment of the silt curtain is attached to this Notice.
7. This Notice is an extension of Marine Department Notice No. 54 of 2007.
