

MARINE DEPARTMENT NOTICE NO. 73 OF 2009

(Marine Works)

Maintenance Works to a Pier in Tai Long Wan, Lantau Island

With immediate effect and for a period of approximately 12 weeks, maintenance works to a pier in Tai Long Wan will be carried out within a works area bounded by straight lines joining the following co-ordinates (WGS 84 Datum) and the adjacent shoreline: -

(A)	22° 13.005'N	114° 00.011'E
(B)	22° 12.966'N	113° 59.981'E
(C)	22° 12.997'N	113° 59.932'E
(D)	22° 13.037'N	113° 59.962'E

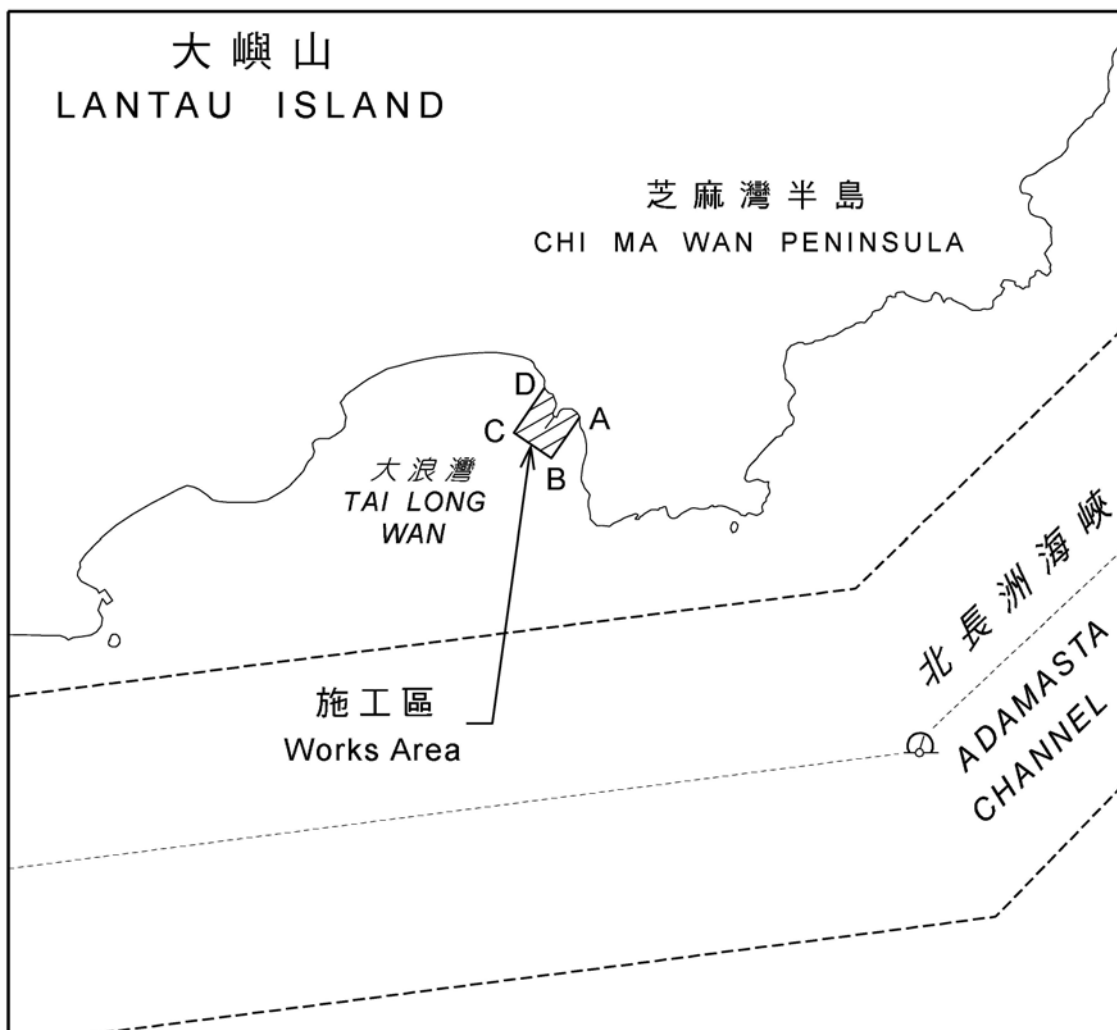
2. The works will be carried out by two derrick lighters, one crane barge, one flat top barge, two tugs and one motor boat. The number of vessels engaged in the works will change from time to time to suit operational requirements.
3. A working area of approximately 30 metres around each of the derrick lighters and the crane barge will be established. Yellow marker buoys fitted with yellow flashing lights will be laid to mark the positions of the anchors extending from the lighters and the crane barge.
4. Several silt curtains will be established around the pier. Each silt curtain is a large piece of netting, extending vertically from the sea surface to the seabed, for containing mud and sediments. Small floating markers, yellow in colour and fitted with yellow flashing lights, will be laid to mark the extent of the silt curtains.
5. The hours of work will be from 0700 to 1900 hours. No works will be carried out on Sundays and Public holidays. Vessels engaged in the works will stay in the works area outside the hours of work.
6. Diving operations will be carried out from time to time during the hours of work.

7. Vessels engaged in the operations will display signals as prescribed in international and local regulations.
8. Vessels navigating in the vicinity should proceed with caution and keep clear at slow speed, bearing in mind there are divers working in the area.
9. A drawing showing the works area is attached to this Notice.
10. This is an extension of Marine Department Notice No. 134 of 2008.
