

MARINE DEPARTMENT NOTICE NO. 75 OF 2009

(Marine Works)

Marine Site Investigation in Causeway Bay Typhoon Shelter

With immediate effect and for a period of approximately two months, marine site investigation works involving drilling of boreholes will be carried out in Causeway Bay Typhoon Shelter within a works area bounded by straight lines joining the following co-ordinates (WGS 84 Datum):

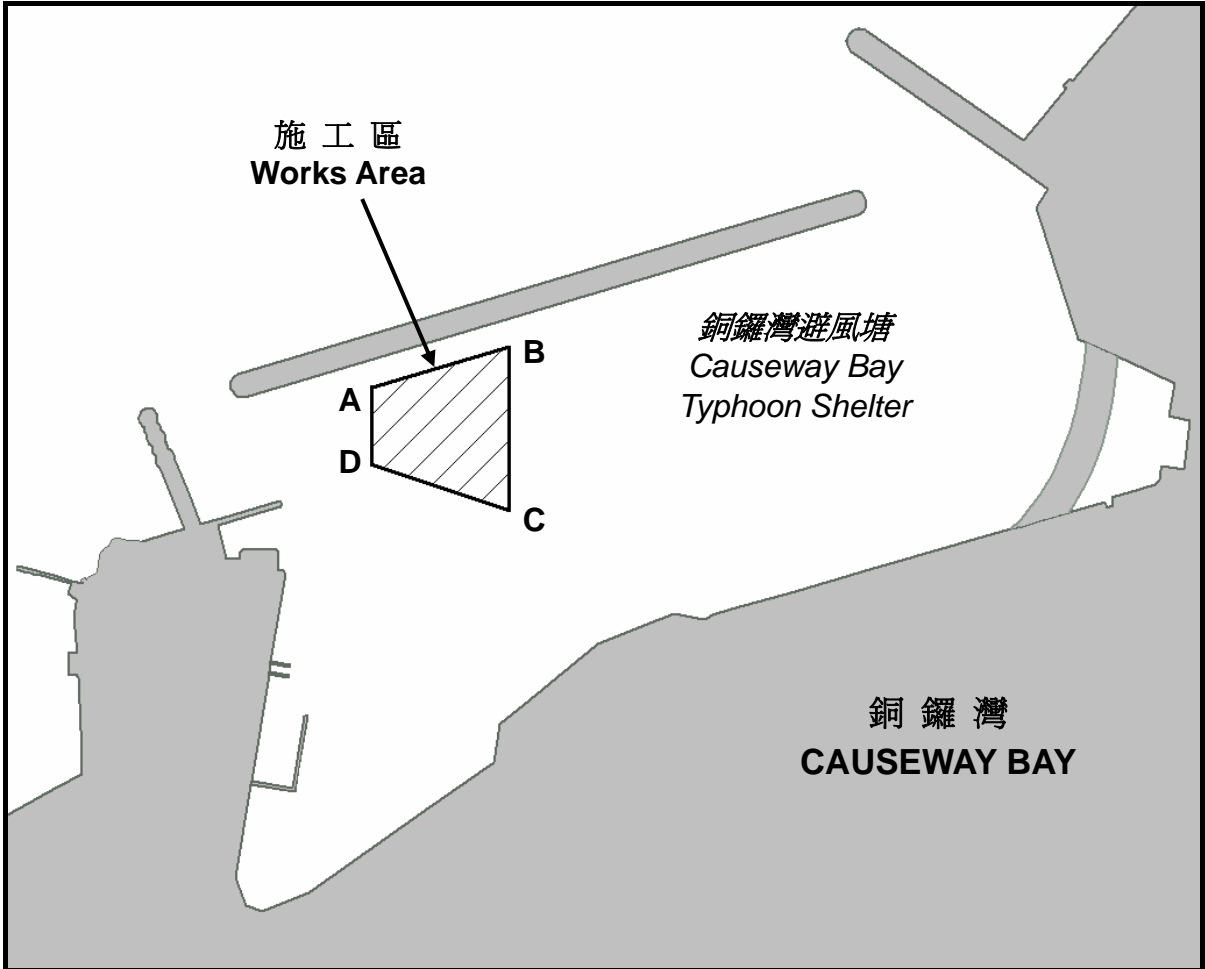
- (A) 22° 17.144'N 114° 11.039'E
- (B) 22° 17.160'N 114° 11.099'E
- (C) 22° 17.096'N 114° 11.099'E
- (D) 22° 17.114'N 114° 11.039'E

2. One jack-up platform will carry out the works. One tug will assist in the works from time to time.
3. A working area of approximately 15 metres will be established around the jack-up platform. Yellow flashing lights, one at each corner of the platform, will be established to indicate the position of the platform.
4. The works will be carried out from 0700 to 1900 hours. No works will be carried out on Sundays and public holidays. The platform and the tug will stay in the works area outside the hours of work.
5. Vessels engaged in the works will display signals as prescribed in international and local regulations.
6. Vessels navigating in the vicinity should proceed with caution.
7. A drawing showing the works area is attached to this Notice.
