

MARINE DEPARTMENT NOTICE NO. 179 OF 2009

(Marine Works)

Construction of Drainage Outfall at Yau Kom Tau

With effect from 2 January 2010 and for a period of approximately 42 months, drainage outfall construction works involving dredging, installation of concrete precast units and backfilling will be carried out within the area bounded by straight lines joining the following co-ordinates (WGS 84 Datum) from (A) to (D) and the adjacent shoreline:

(A)	22° 22.087'N	114° 05.741'E
(B)	22° 22.053'N	114° 05.754'E
(C)	22° 22.053'N	114° 05.675'E
(D)	22° 22.073'N	114° 05.670'E

2. The works will be carried out by one derrick barge, one split-hopper barge and a tug. The number of vessels engaged in the works will change from time to time to suit operational requirements.
3. A working area of approximately 50 metres around the derrick barge will be established. Yellow marker buoys fitted with yellow flashing lights will be laid to mark the positions of the anchors extending from the barge.
4. The hours of works will be from 0800 to 1900 hours. No works will be carried out on Sundays and public holidays. Vessels engaged in the works will stay within the works area outside the hours of work.
5. Vessels engaged in the works will display signals as prescribed in international and local regulations.

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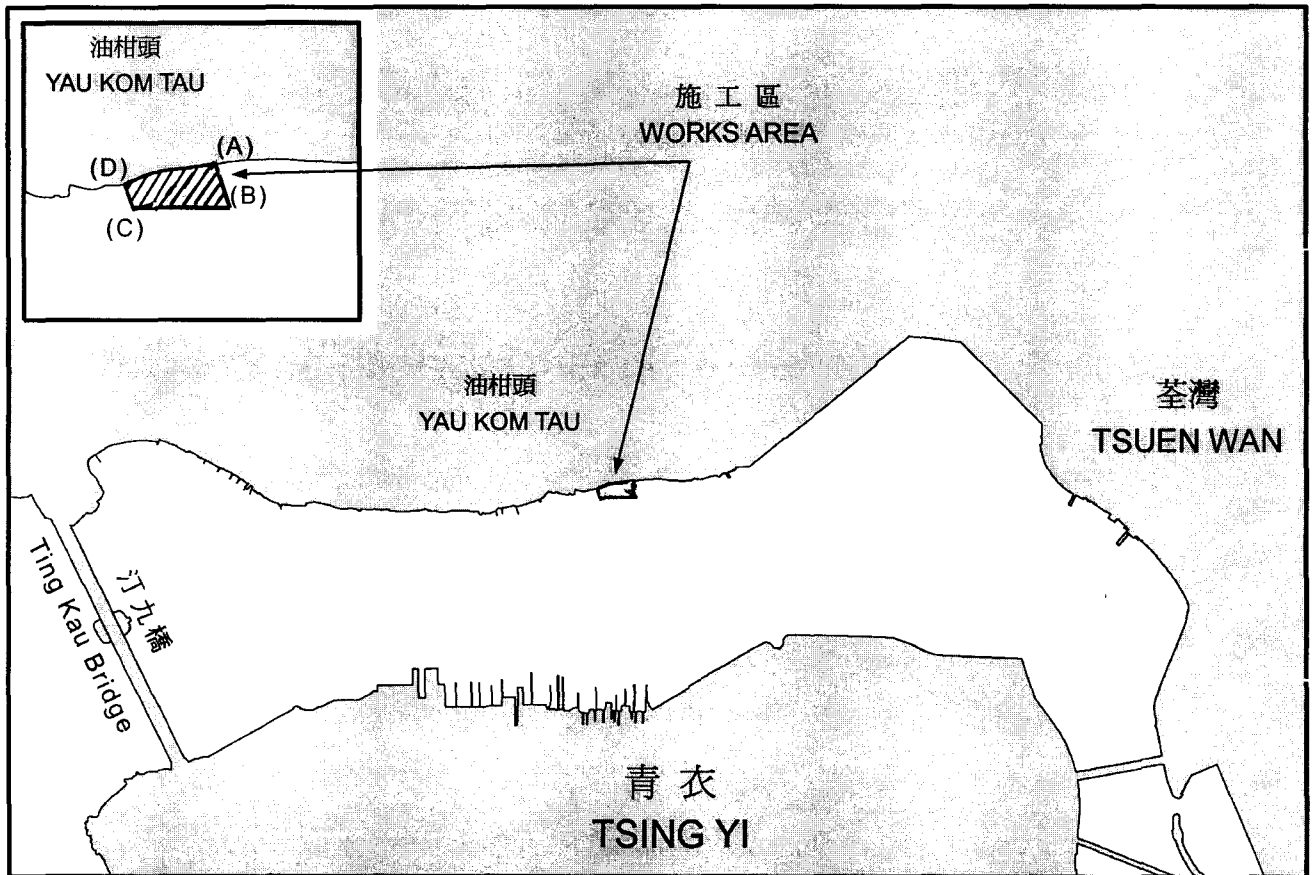
6. Diving operations will be carried out from time to time.
7. Vessels navigating in the vicinity should proceed with caution at slow speed and keep clear of the works area, bearing in mind that there are divers working in the area.
8. A drawing showing the works area is attached to this Notice.
