

MARINE DEPARTMENT NOTICE NO. 2 OF 2010

(Marine Works)

Marine Site Investigation off Hong Kong International Airport

With immediate effect and for a period of approximately 6 months, marine site investigation works involving drilling of boreholes will be carried out within the area bounded by straight lines joining the following co-ordinates (WGS 84 Datum) from (A) to (E) and the adjacent shoreline:

(A)	22° 19.410' N	113° 56.712' E
(B)	22° 19.553' N	113° 57.888' E
(C)	22° 18.741' N	113° 57.727' E
(D)	22° 18.481' N	113° 57.525' E
(E)	22° 17.755' N	113° 56.268' E

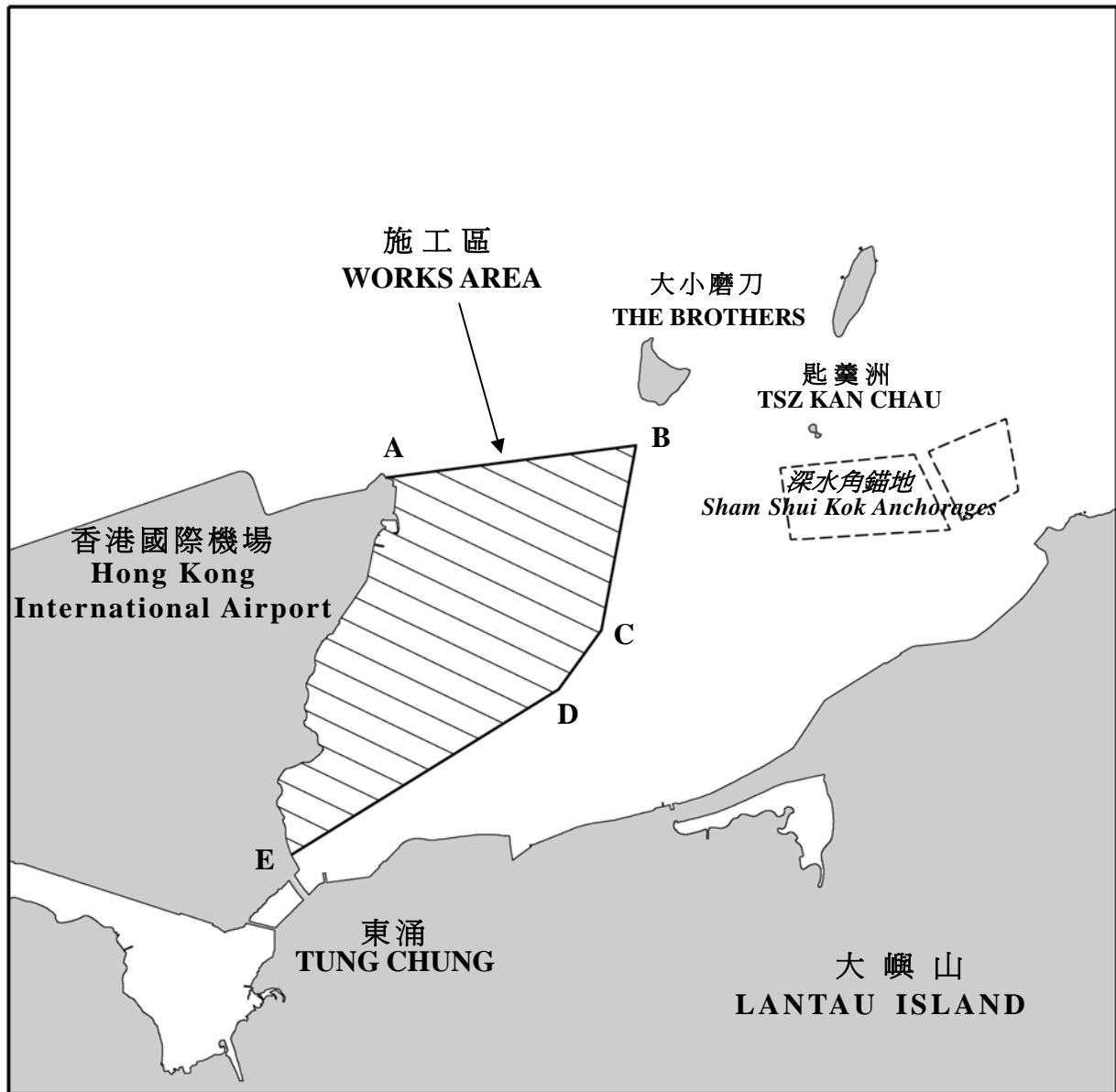
2. Four jack-up platforms and four flat top barges will carry out the works. One derrick lighter, one tug and three guard boats will provide assistance.
3. A working area of approximately 15 metres will be established around each jack-up platform. Yellow flashing lights will be installed at the four corners of the platforms to indicate the position of each platform.
4. A working area of approximately 50 metres will be established around each barge. Yellow marker buoys fitted with yellow flashing lights will be laid to mark the positions of the anchors extending from each barge.
5. The works will be carried out round-the-clock.
6. Vessels engaged in the operations will display signals as prescribed in international and local regulations.
7. Vessels navigating in the vicinity should proceed with caution.

8. A drawing showing the works area is attached to this Notice.
9. This Notice supersedes Marine Department Notice No. 162 of 2009.
