

MARINE DEPARTMENT NOTICE NO. 7 OF 2010

(Marine Works)

Marine Site Investigation off Black Point, Urmston Road

With immediate effect and for a period of approximately two months, marine site investigation works involving drilling of boreholes will be carried out off Black Point, Urmston Road in the following areas:

Area 1: This area is bounded by straight lines joining the following co-ordinates (WGS 84 Datum) from (A) to (C) and the adjacent shoreline:

(A)	22° 25.028' N	113° 54.724' E
(B)	22° 25.164' N	113° 54.724' E
(C)	22° 25.164' N	113° 54.836' E

Area 2: This area is bounded by straight lines joining the following co-ordinates (WGS 84 Datum) from (D) to (G):

(D)	22° 25.484' N	113° 53.602' E
(E)	22° 25.402' N	113° 53.632' E
(F)	22° 25.065' N	113° 52.463' E
(G)	22° 25.146' N	113° 52.433' E

2. Two jack-up platforms will carry out the works. One tug will provide assistance.

3. A working area of approximately 25 metres around each jack-up platform will be established. Yellow flashing lights will be installed at the four corners of the platforms to indicate the positions of the platforms.

4. The hours of work will be from 0700 to 1900 hours. No works will be carried out on Sundays and public holidays. The vessels employed for the works will stay in the works area outside the hours of work.

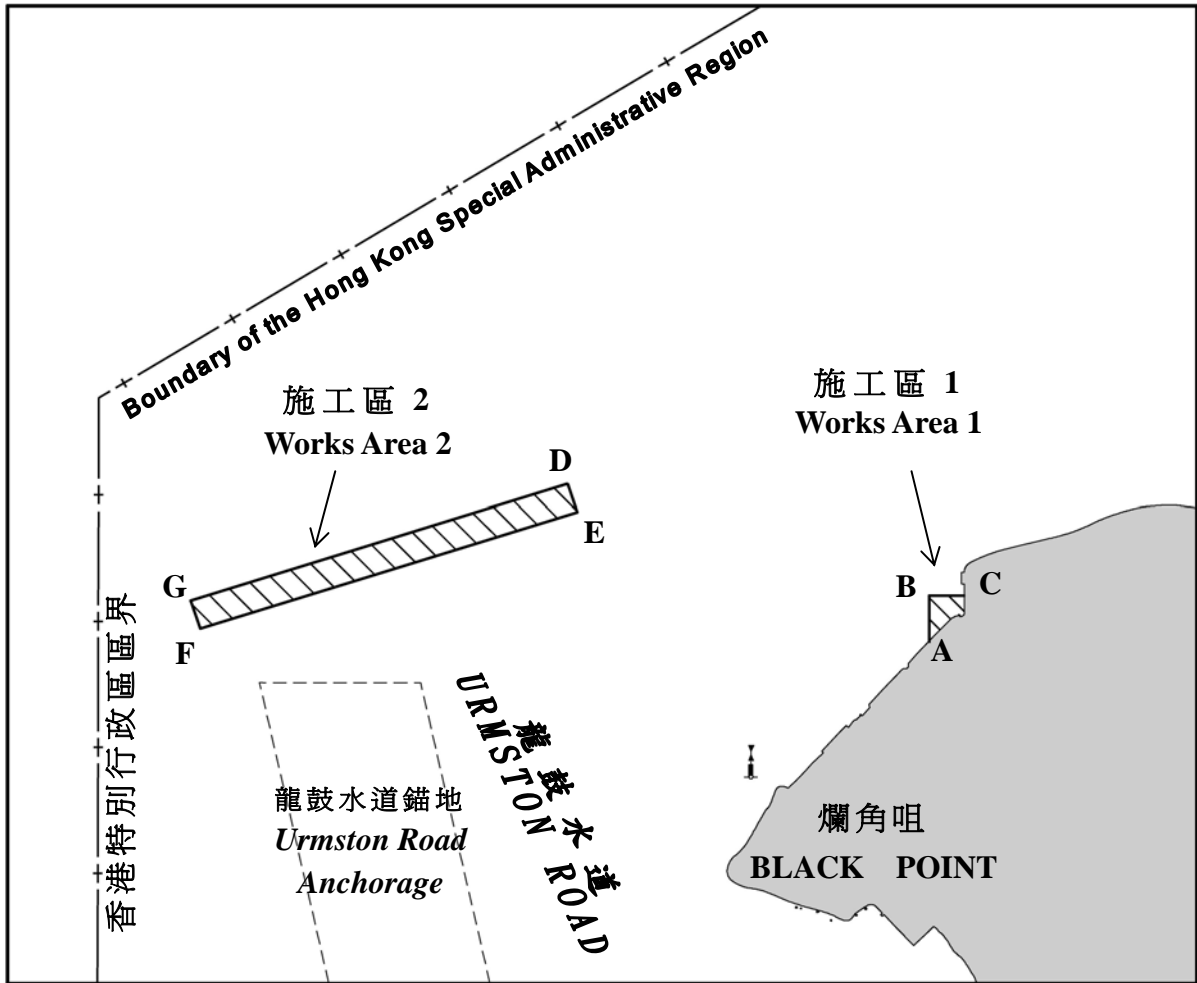
5. Vessels engaged in the operations will display signals as prescribed in international and local regulations.
6. Vessels navigating in the vicinity should proceed with caution.
