

MARINE DEPARTMENT NOTICE NO. 12 OF 2010

(Marine Works)

Removal of Damaged Concrete Dolphin at Hei Ling Chau Typhoon Shelter

With effect from 3 February 2010 and for a period of approximately three weeks, removal of damaged concrete dolphin will be carried out within the area bounded by straight lines joining the following co-ordinates (WGS 84 Datum):

2. The works will be carried out by one derrick lighter. One tug and one guard boat will assist in the works from time to time.
3. A working area of approximately 15 metres around the derrick lighter will be established. Yellow marker buoys fitted with yellow flashing lights will be laid to mark the positions of the anchors extending from the derrick lighter.
4. The hours of work will be from 0800 to 1800 hours daily. The vessels employed for the works will stay in the works area outside the hours of work.
5. Vessels engaged in the works will display signals as prescribed in international and local regulations.
6. Vessels navigating in the vicinity should proceed with caution and keep clear at slow speed, bearing in mind there are divers working in the area.
7. A drawing showing the works area is attached to this Notice.

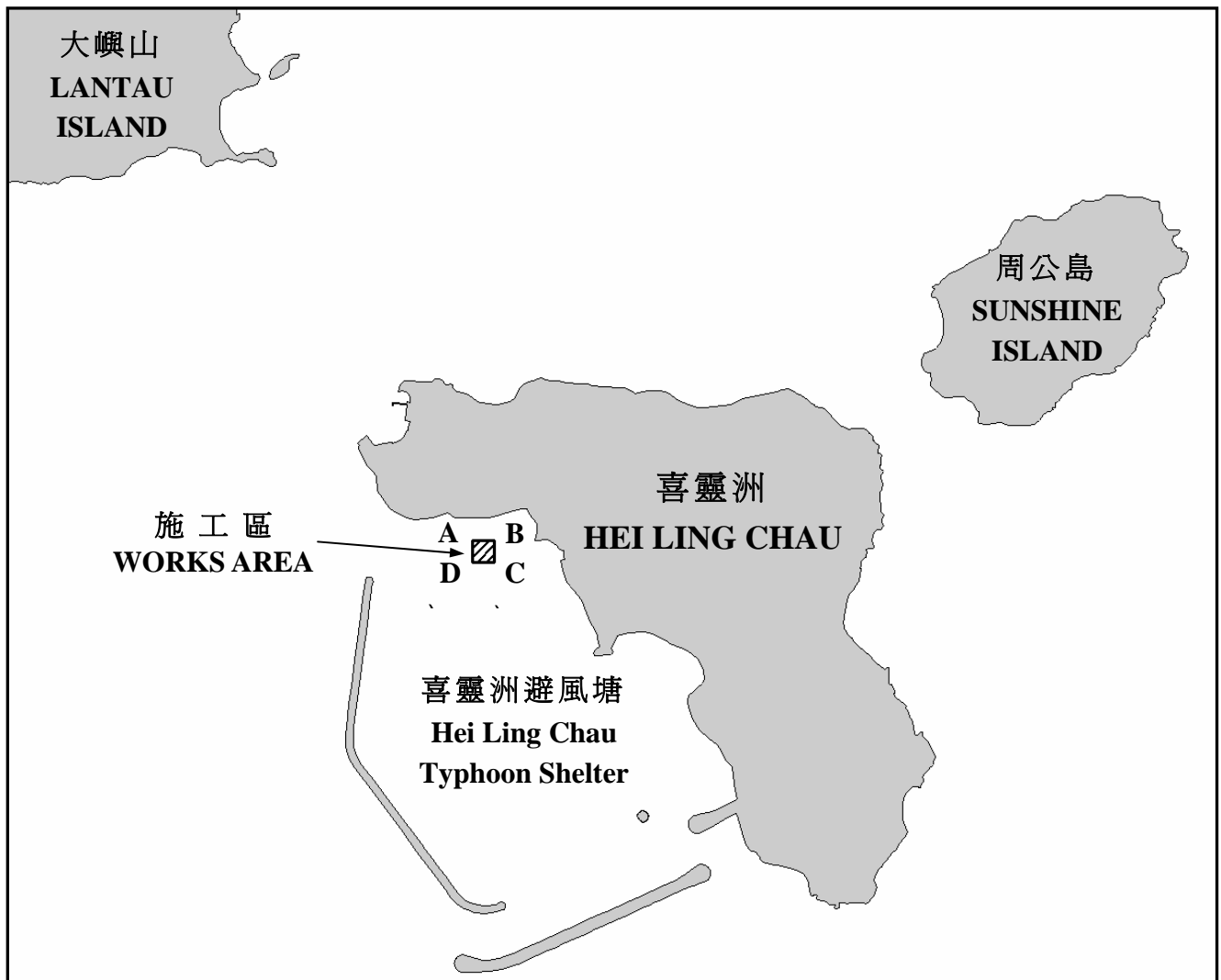
