

## **MARINE DEPARTMENT NOTICE NO. 15 OF 2010**

(Marine Works)

### **Marine Site Investigation in Kwun Tong Typhoon Shelter and Kai Tak Nullah**

With immediate effect and for a period of approximately three months, marine site investigation works involving drilling of boreholes will be carried out in Kwun Tong Typhoon Shelter and the Kai Tak Nullah in the following areas:

Area 1: This area is bounded by a straight line joining the following co-ordinates (WGS 84 Datum) from (A) to (B) and the adjacent shorelines from (B) through (C) and (D) to (A):

(A)	22° 18.789' N	114° 12.659' E
(B)	22° 18.711' N	114° 12.578' E
(C)	22° 19.216' N	114° 12.003' E
(D)	22° 19.329' N	114° 12.048' E

Area 2: This area is bounded by straight lines joining the following co-ordinates (WGS 84 Datum) from (E) to (J):

(E)	22° 18.885' N	114° 12.807' E
(F)	22° 18.530' N	114° 13.140' E
(G)	22° 18.388' N	114° 12.988' E
(H)	22° 18.549' N	114° 12.907' E
(I)	22° 18.625' N	114° 12.733' E
(J)	22° 18.790' N	114° 12.707' E

2. One jack-up platform and one flat top barge will carry out the works. One tug and two motor boats will provide assistance.

3. The jack-up platform will work in Area 1. A working area of approximately 25 metres will be established around the jack-up platform. Yellow flashing lights will be installed at the four corners of the platform to indicate the position of the platform.

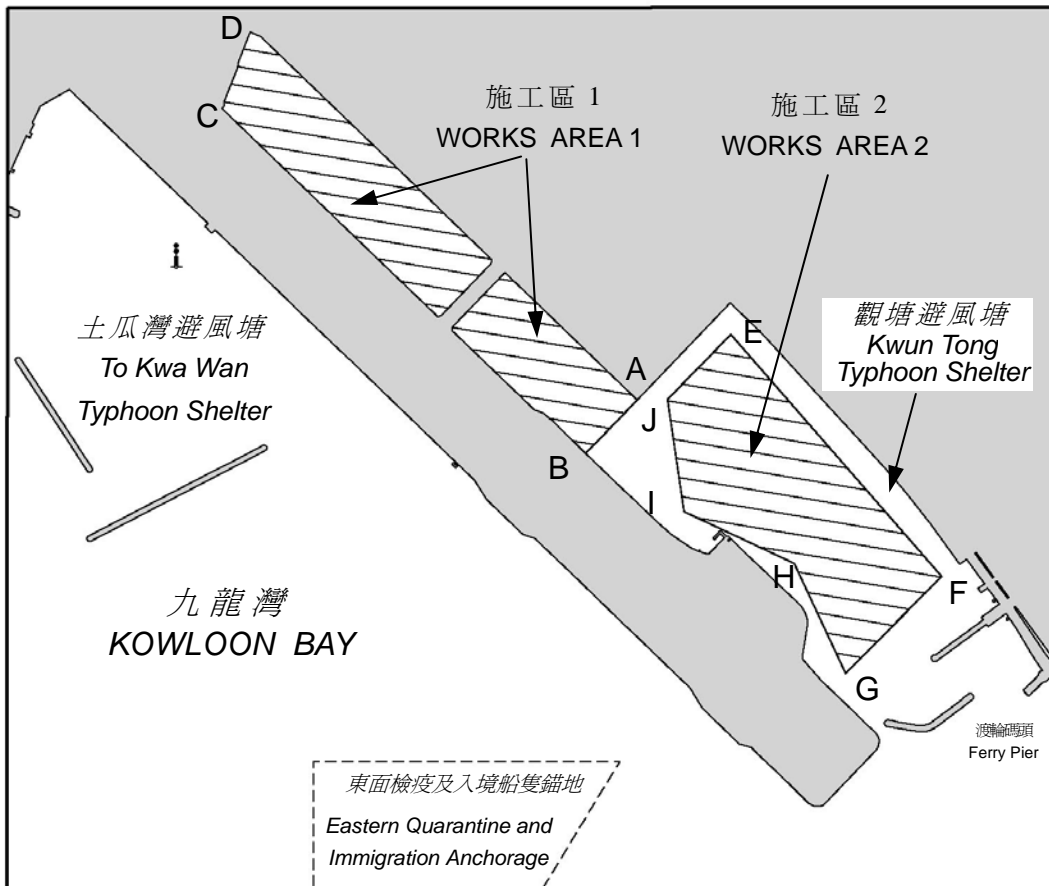
4. The flat top barge will work in Area 2. A working area of approximately 50 metres will be established around the flat top barge. Yellow marker buoys fitted with yellow flashing lights will be laid to mark the positions of the anchors extending from the barge.
5. The hours of work will be from 0700 to 1900 hours. No works will be carried out on Sundays and public holidays. The vessels employed for the works will stay in the works areas outside the hours of work.
6. Vessels engaged in the operations will display signals as prescribed in international and local regulations.
7. Vessels navigating in the vicinity should proceed with caution.
8. A drawing showing the works areas is attached to this Notice.
