

## **MARINE DEPARTMENT NOTICE NO. 19 OF 2010**

(Marine Works)

### **Seawall Construction Works in Kwun Tong Typhoon Shelter and Kai Tak Nullah**

With effect from 5 February 2010 and for a period of approximately six months, seawall construction works involving delivery, unloading and installation of precast units will be carried out within the area bounded by straight lines joining the following co-ordinates (WGS 84) from (A) to (D) and the adjacent shoreline:

(A)	22° 18.891' N	114° 12.366' E
(B)	22° 18.919' N	114° 12.395' E
(C)	22° 18.584' N	114° 12.768' E
(D)	22° 18.569' N	114° 12.751' E

- Two flat top barges and one crane barge will carry out the works. One tug will provide assistance. The number of vessels engaged in the works will change from time to time to suit operational requirements.
- A working area of approximately 25 metres around each barge will be established. Yellow marker buoys fitted with yellow flashing lights will be laid to mark the positions of the anchors extending from the barges.
- The hours of work will be from 0700 to 1900 hours. No works will be carried out on Sundays and public holidays. Vessels engaged in the works will stay within the works area outside the hours of work.
- Vessels engaged in the works will display signals as prescribed in international and local regulations.
- Vessels navigating in the vicinity should proceed with caution.

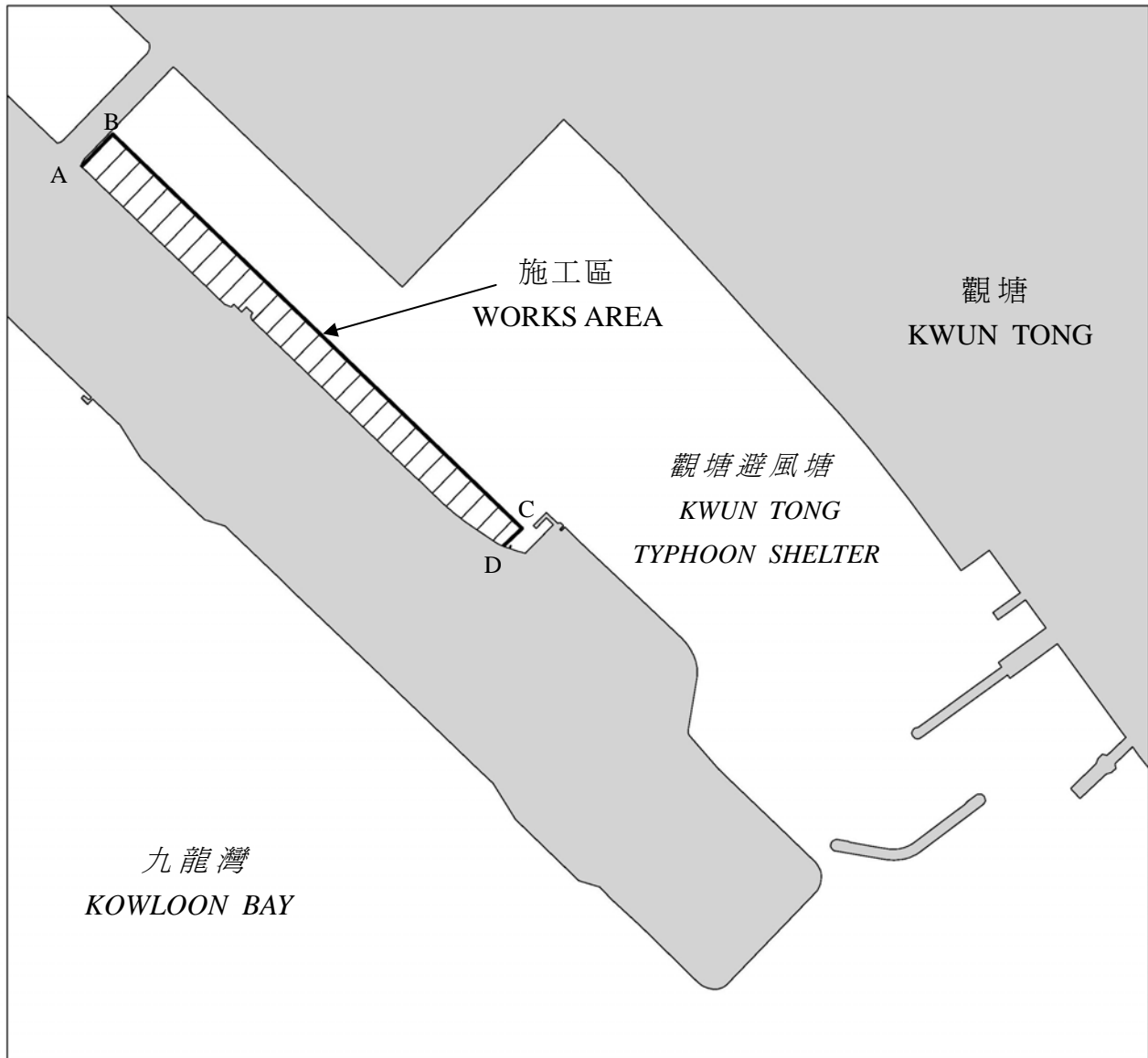
