

MARINE DEPARTMENT NOTICE NO. 22 OF 2010

(Marine Works)

Marine Site Investigation in Junk Bay

With immediate effect and for a period of approximately 2 months, marine site investigation works involving drilling of boreholes will be carried out within the area bounded by straight lines joining the following co-ordinates (WGS 84 Datum) from (A) to (F) and the adjacent shoreline:

(A)	22° 17.513'N	114° 16.004'E
(B)	22° 17.476'N	114° 16.004'E
(C)	22° 17.477'N	114° 15.538'E
(D)	22° 17.643'N	114° 15.307'E
(E)	22° 18.079'N	114° 15.691'E
(F)	22° 18.020'N	114° 15.833'E

2. One flat top barge and one jack-up platform will carry out the works. One tug and one guard boat will provide assistance.
3. A working area of approximately 50 metres will be established around the flat top barge. Yellow marker buoys fitted with yellow flashing lights will be laid to mark the positions of the anchors extending from the barge.
4. A working area of approximately 25 metres will be established around the jack-up platform. Yellow flashing lights will be installed at the four corners of the platform to indicate the position of the platform.
5. The hours of work will be from 0700 to 1900 hours. No works will be carried out on Sundays and public holidays. The vessels employed for the works will stay in the works area outside the hours of work.
6. Vessels engaged in the works will display signals as prescribed in international and local regulations.
7. Vessels navigating in the vicinity should proceed with caution.

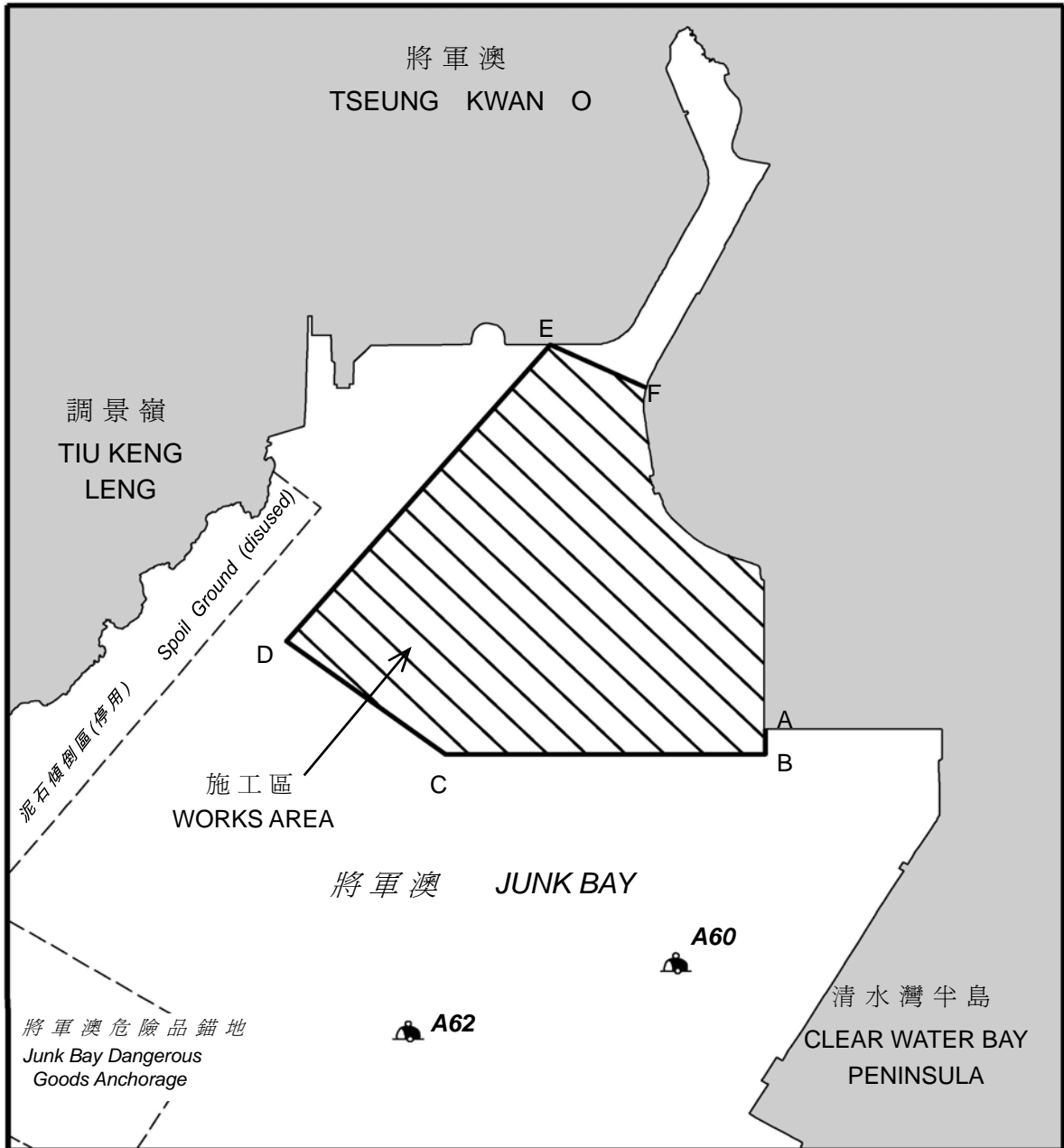
8. A drawing showing the works area is attached to this Notice.
