

MARINE DEPARTMENT NOTICE NO. 26 OF 2010

(Miscellaneous Information)

Yacht Races between Hong Kong and Macau

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that yacht races between Hong Kong and Macau will take place on 14 February 2010 (Sunday) and 16 February 2010 (Tuesday). About 35 sailing boats are expected to participate in the races.

2. The outbound trip from Hong Kong to Macau will start at 1000 hours on 14 February 2010 in an area east of Lamma Island (approximately one nautical mile south of Wong Chuk Kok Light) and follow a route passing south of Lamma Island, south of Tai A Chau, thence to Macau.
3. The return trip from Macau to Hong Kong will start at 1030 hours on 16 February 2010, follow a route passing south of Tai A Chau and to complete the race at a position east of Cheung Chau.
4. Masters, coxswains and persons-in-charge of vessels navigating in the vicinity of the race routes should proceed with caution, giving practical consideration to the contestants. Compliance with the provisions of the International Regulations for Preventing Collisions at Sea 1972 is mandatory.
5. A drawing showing the race routes is attached to this notice.

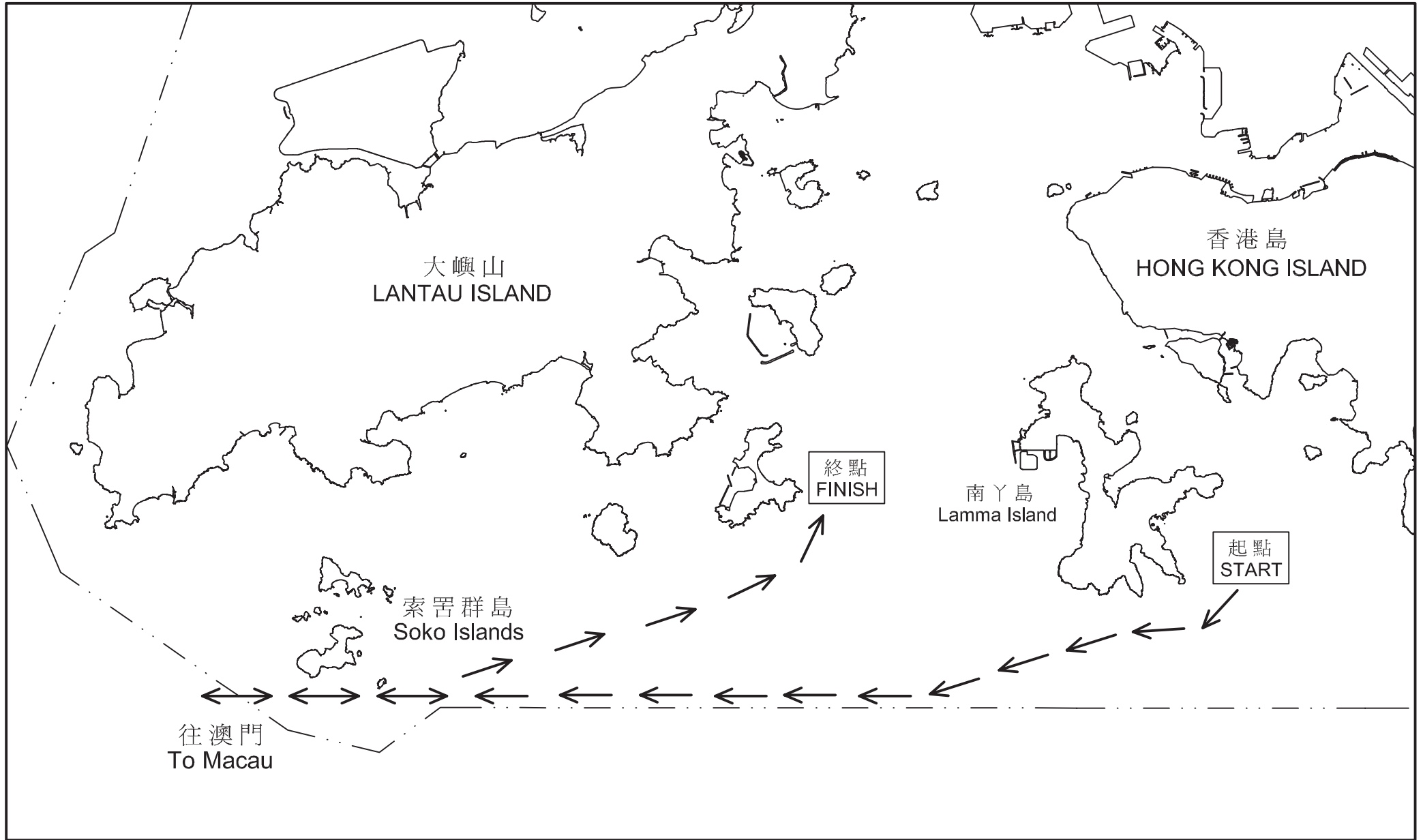
