

MARINE DEPARTMENT NOTICE NO. 27 OF 2010

(Marine Works)

Marine Site Investigation in Causeway Bay Typhoon Shelter

With immediate effect and for a period of approximately two months, marine site investigation works involving drilling of boreholes will be carried out in Causeway Bay Typhoon Shelter in the following areas:

Area 1: This area is bounded by straight lines joining the following co-ordinates (WGS 84 Datum) from (A) to (C):

(A)	22° 17.139' N	114° 10.983' E
(B)	22° 17.211' N	114° 11.259' E
(C)	22° 17.083' N	114° 11.117' E

Area 2: This area is bounded by straight lines joining the following co-ordinates (WGS 84 Datum) from (D) to (G):

(D)	22° 17.097' N	114° 11.006' E
(E)	22° 17.097' N	114° 11.050' E
(F)	22° 17.076' N	114° 11.050' E
(G)	22° 17.076' N	114° 11.006' E

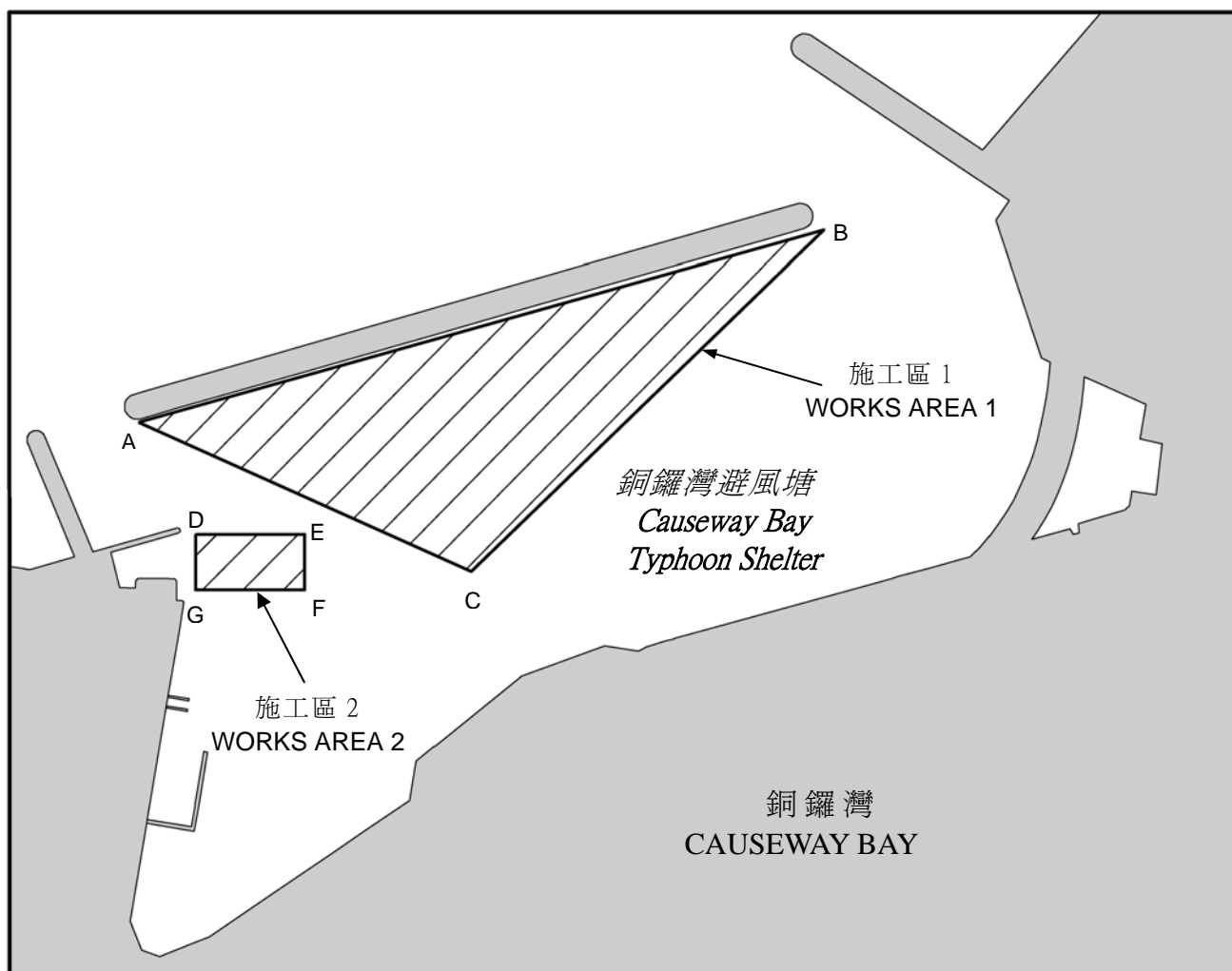
2. One jack-up barge will carry out the works. One tug and two motor boats will provide assistance.
3. A working area of approximately 20 metres around the jack-up barge will be established. Yellow flashing lights will be installed at the four corners of the jack-up barge to indicate the position of the barge.
4. The hours of work will be from 0700 to 1900 hours. No works will be carried out on Sundays and public holidays. The vessels employed for the works will stay in the works areas outside the hours of work.
5. Vessels engaged in the operations will display signals as prescribed in international and local regulations.

6. Vessels navigating in the vicinity should proceed with caution.
7. A drawing showing the works areas is attached to this Notice.
