

MARINE DEPARTMENT NOTICE NO. 64 OF 2010

(Marine Works)

Submarine Cable Repair Works from Stanley Peninsula to East Lamma Channel

With immediate effect and for a period of approximately eight weeks, marine works on survey, repair, laying and burial of submarine cable will be carried out from the west of Stanley Peninsula through East Lamma Channel along a route running through the following positions (WGS 84 Datum) and thence beyond Hong Kong waters:

(A)	22° 11.919' N	114° 12.119' E
(B)	22° 11.084' N	114° 11.495' E
(C)	22° 10.498' N	114° 11.425' E
(D)	22° 09.696' N	114° 12.341' E
(E)	22° 09.069' N	114° 13.540' E
(F)	22° 08.940' N	114° 13.980' E

2. The works will be carried out by the cable ship “DURABLE” and assisted by one tug and one guard boat. The cable ship will deploy a remotely operated vehicle to conduct the cable survey and burial works. The number of vessels engaged in the works will change from time to time to suit operational requirements.

3. A working area of approximately 150 metres will be established around the cable ship. The maneuverability of the cable ship will be severely hampered.

4. The hours of work will be from 0700 to 1900 hours. No works will be carried out on Sundays and public holidays.

5. Vessels engaged in the operations will display signals as prescribed in international and local regulations.

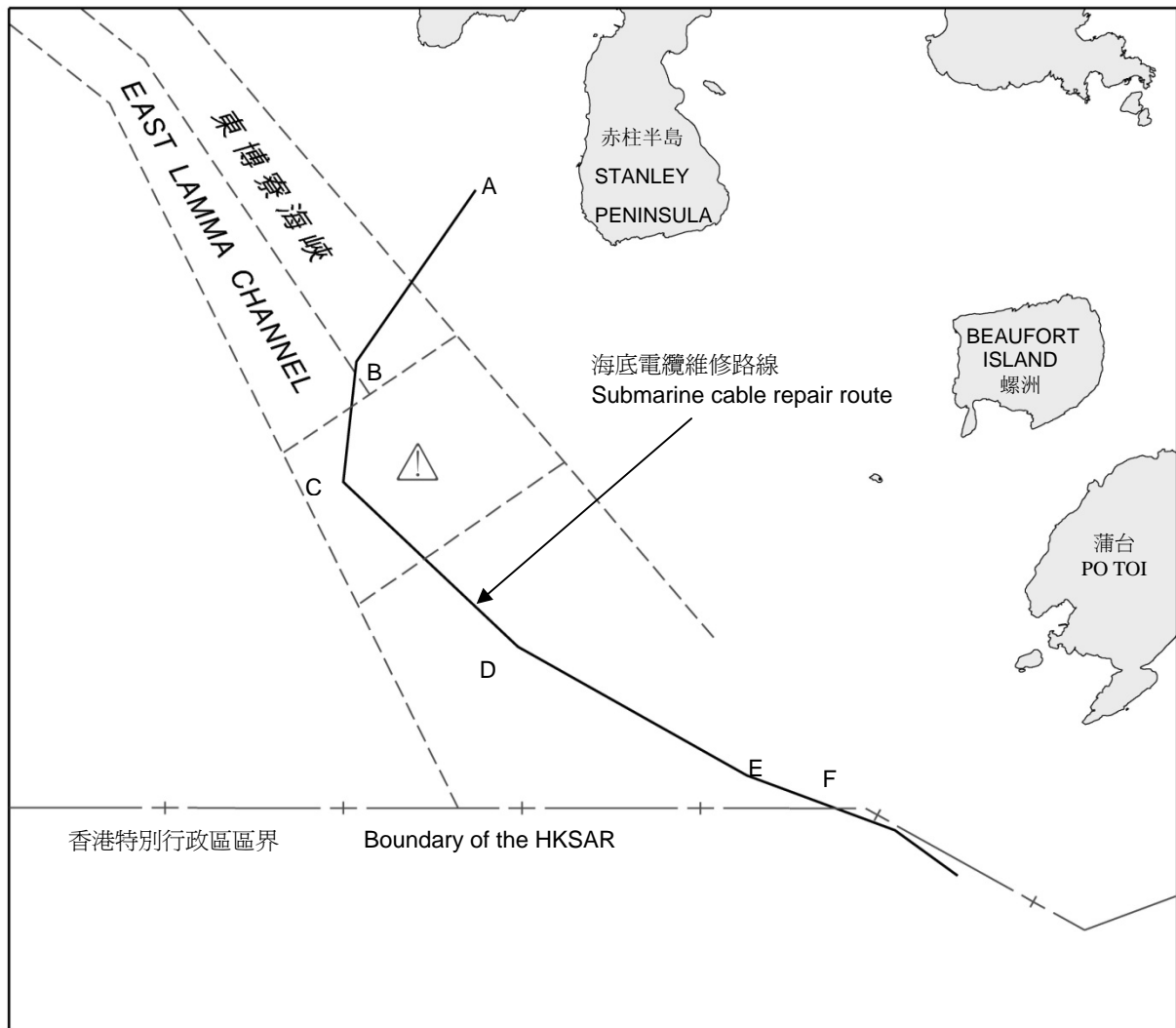
6. Vessels navigating in the vicinity should proceed with caution.
