

MARINE DEPARTMENT NOTICE NO. 70 OF 2010

(Marine Works)

Submarine Outfall Inspection Works Off Wan Chai, Central Harbour

With effect from 24 May 2010 and for a period of approximately one week, submarine outfall inspection works will be carried out within an area bounded by straight lines joining the following co-ordinates (WGS 84 Datum) from (A) to (D):-

(A)	22° 16.908'N	114° 10.142'E
(B)	22° 17.218'N	114° 10.156'E
(C)	22° 17.217'N	114° 10.185'E
(D)	22° 16.907'N	114° 10.171'E

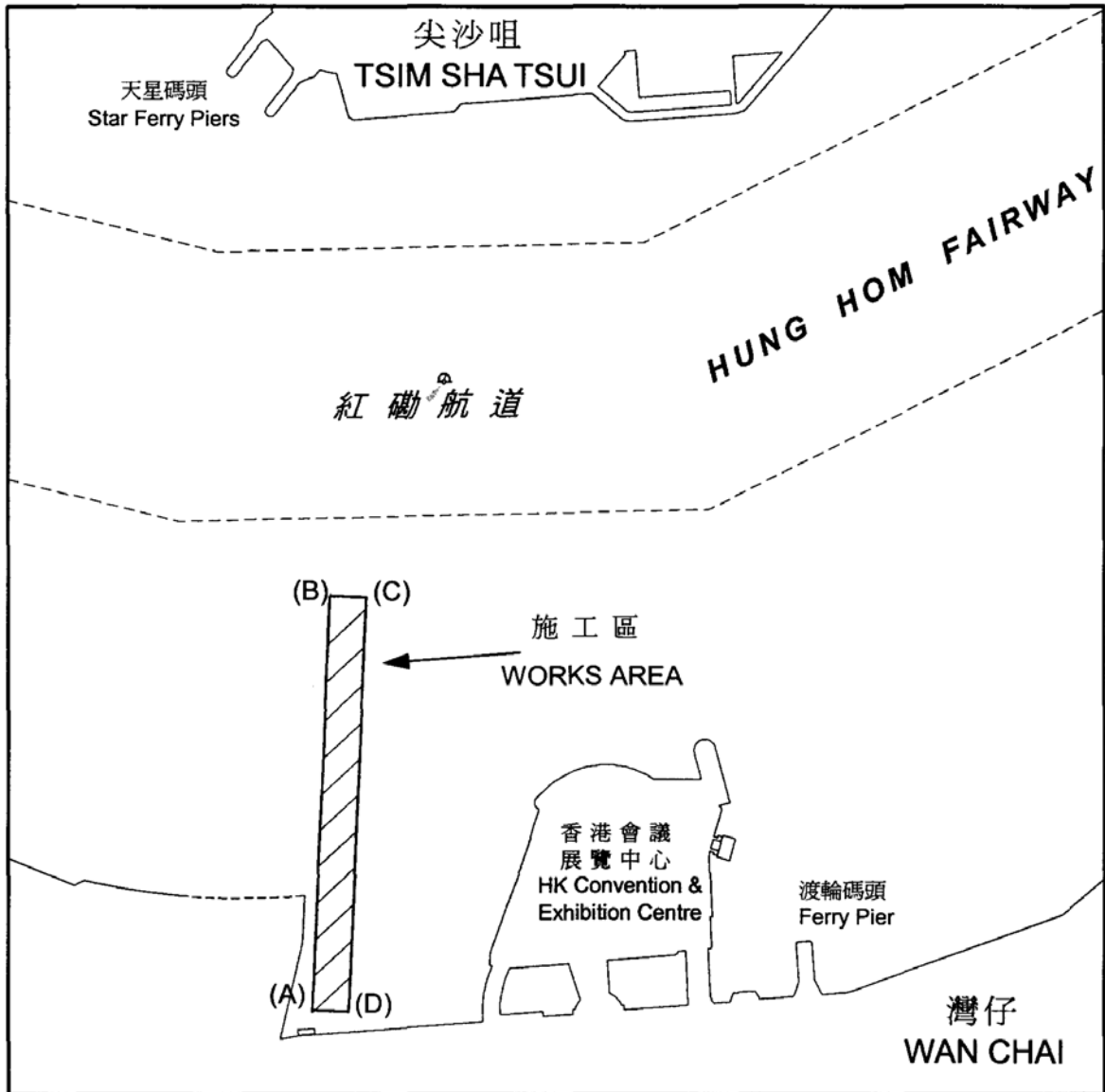
2. One motor boat will carry out the works. One guard boat will provide assistance.
3. A working area of approximately 25 metres around the motor boat will be established. One yellow marker buoy fitted with yellow flashing light will be laid to mark the position of the anchor extending from the motor boat.
4. The hours of work will normally be from 0800 to 1700 hours. The motor boat and the guard boat will not stay in the works area outside the hours of work.
5. Diving operations will be carried out from time to time during the hours of work.
6. Vessels engaged in the operations will display signals as prescribed in international and local regulations.
7. Vessels navigating in the vicinity should proceed with caution and keep clear at slow speed bearing in mind there are divers working in the area.
8. A drawing showing the works area is attached to this Notice.
