

MARINE DEPARTMENT NOTICE NO. 81 OF 2010

(Marine Works)

Submarine Outfall Repair Works Off Wan Chai, Central Harbour

With effect from 17 June 2010 and for a period of approximately one month, submarine outfall repair works will be carried out within an area bounded by straight lines joining the following co-ordinates (WGS 84 Datum) from (A) to (D):-

(A)	22° 16.908'N	114° 10.142'E
(B)	22° 17.218'N	114° 10.156'E
(C)	22° 17.217'N	114° 10.185'E
(D)	22° 16.907'N	114° 10.171'E

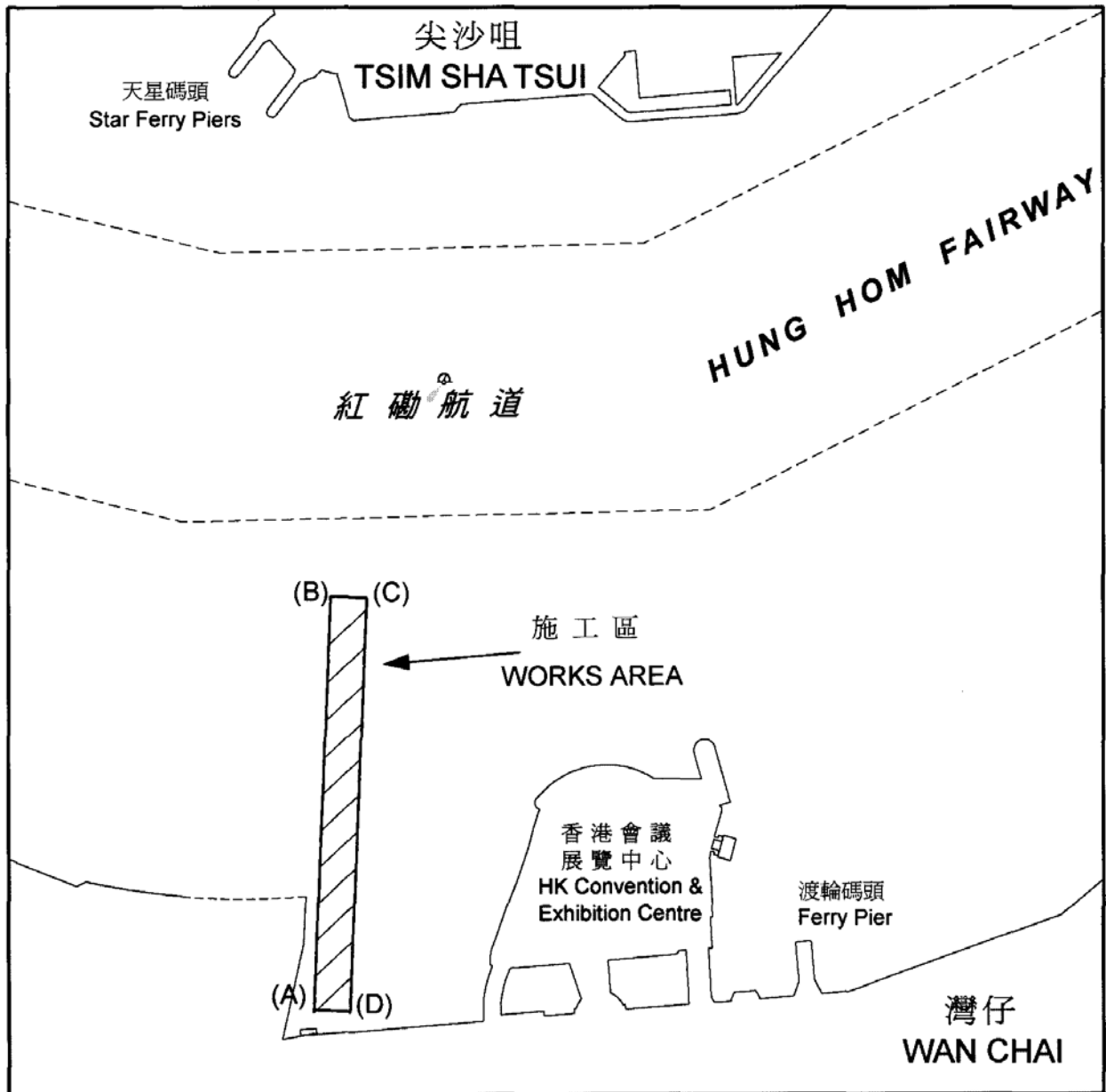
2. One crane barge will carry out the works. One tug and a guard boat will provide assistance.
3. A working area of approximately 50 metres around the barge will be established. Yellow marker buoys fitted with yellow flashing lights will be laid to mark the positions of the anchors extending from the barge.
4. The hours of work will normally be from 0800 to 1900 hours. Vessels engaged in the works will stay in the works area outside the hours of work.
5. Diving operations will be carried out from time to time during the hours of work.
6. Vessels engaged in the operations will display signals as prescribed in international and local regulations.
7. Vessels navigating in the vicinity should proceed with caution and keep clear at slow speed bearing in mind there are divers working in the area.
8. A drawing showing the works area is attached to this Notice.
