

MARINE DEPARTMENT NOTICE NO. 99 OF 2010

(Marine Works)

Fender Replacement Works for Dolphins in New Yau Ma Tei Typhoon Shelter

With effect from 19 July 2010 and for a period of approximately five months, fender replacement works for six of the dolphins will be carried out in the New Yau Ma Tei Typhoon Shelter.

2. The works will be carried out by one crane barge or a derrick lighter. One tug and a motor boat will assist in the works from time to time. Only one dolphin will be occupied for the carrying out of works at a time.
3. The works will be carried out from 0800 to 1900 hours. No works will be carried out on Sundays and public holidays. Vessels engaged in the works will stay close to a dolphin outside the hours of works.
4. Diving operations will be carried out from time to time during the hours of work.
5. Vessels engaged in the works will display signals as prescribed in international and local regulations.
6. Vessels navigating in the vicinity should proceed with caution and keep clear at slow speed bearing in mind there are divers working in the area.
7. A drawing showing the locations of the dolphins involved in the works is attached to this Notice.

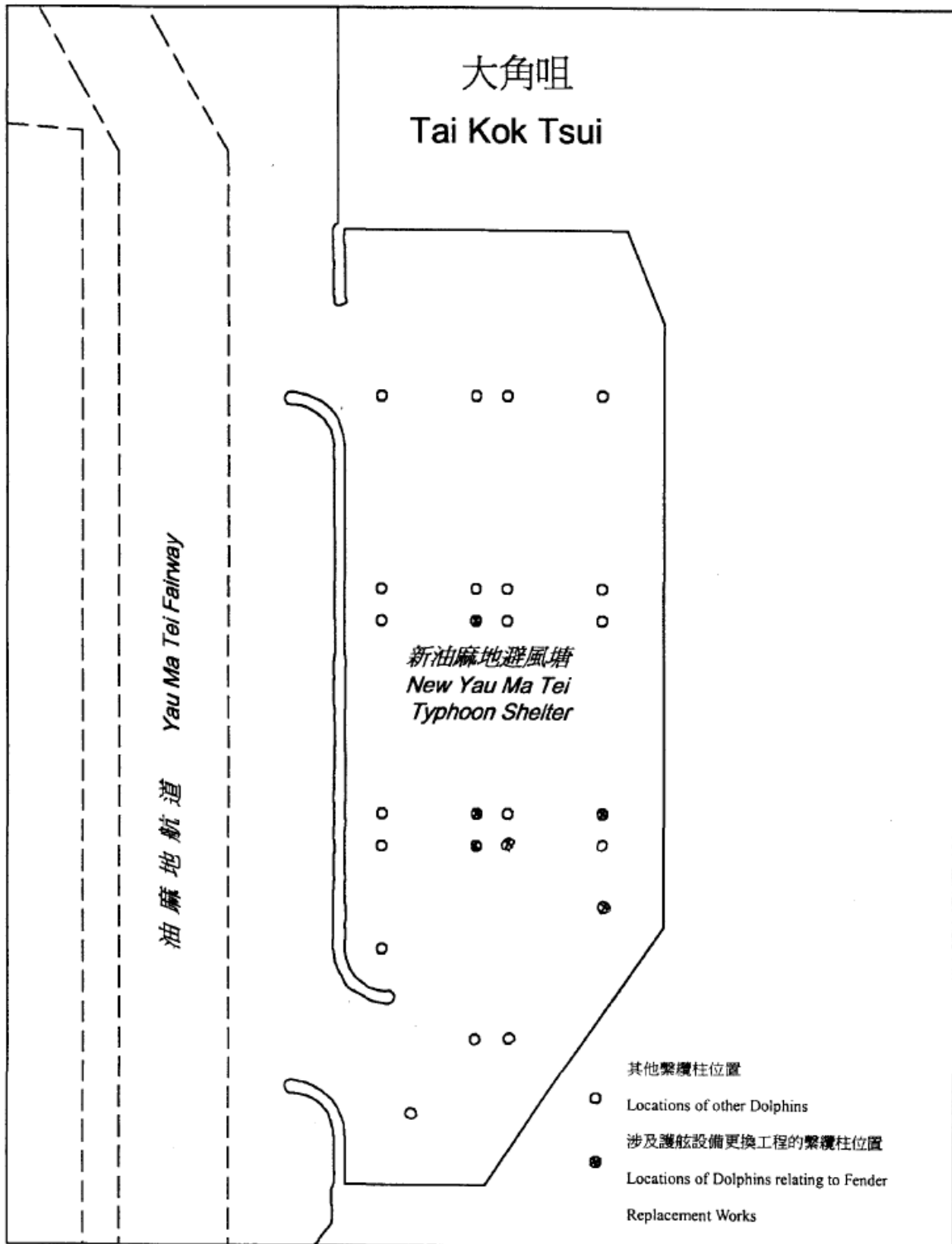
