

**MARINE DEPARTMENT NOTICE NO. 100 OF 2010**

(Marine Works)

**Reclamation and Seawall Construction Works in Central Harbour**

With effect from 15 July 2010 and for a period of approximately 12 months, reclamation and seawall construction works will be carried out in the area bounded by straight lines joining the following co-ordinates (WGS 84 Datum) from (A) to (F) and the adjacent shoreline:

(A)	22° 17.095'N	114° 09.759'E
(B)	22° 17.100'N	114° 09.788'E
(C)	22° 17.045'N	114° 09.892'E
(D)	22° 17.032'N	114° 10.007'E
(E)	22° 17.016'N	114° 10.146'E
(F)	22° 16.890'N	114° 10.141'E

2. Yellow marker buoys fitted with yellow flashing lights will be laid to mark the boundary of the area at co-ordinates (B), (C), (D) and (E).
3. The works will be conducted by a flotilla of vessels including hopper barges, derrick lighters, crane barges, some tugs and small work boats. The number of vessels engaged in the works will change from time to time to suit operational requirements.
4. A working area of approximately 50 metres around each of the working barges will be established. Yellow marker buoys fitted with yellow flashing lights will be laid to mark the positions of the anchors extending from the barges.
5. The hours of works will normally be round-the-clock. Vessels engaged in the operations will display signals as prescribed in international and local regulations.
6. Vessels navigating in the vicinity should proceed with caution.
7. A drawing showing the works area is attached to this Notice.

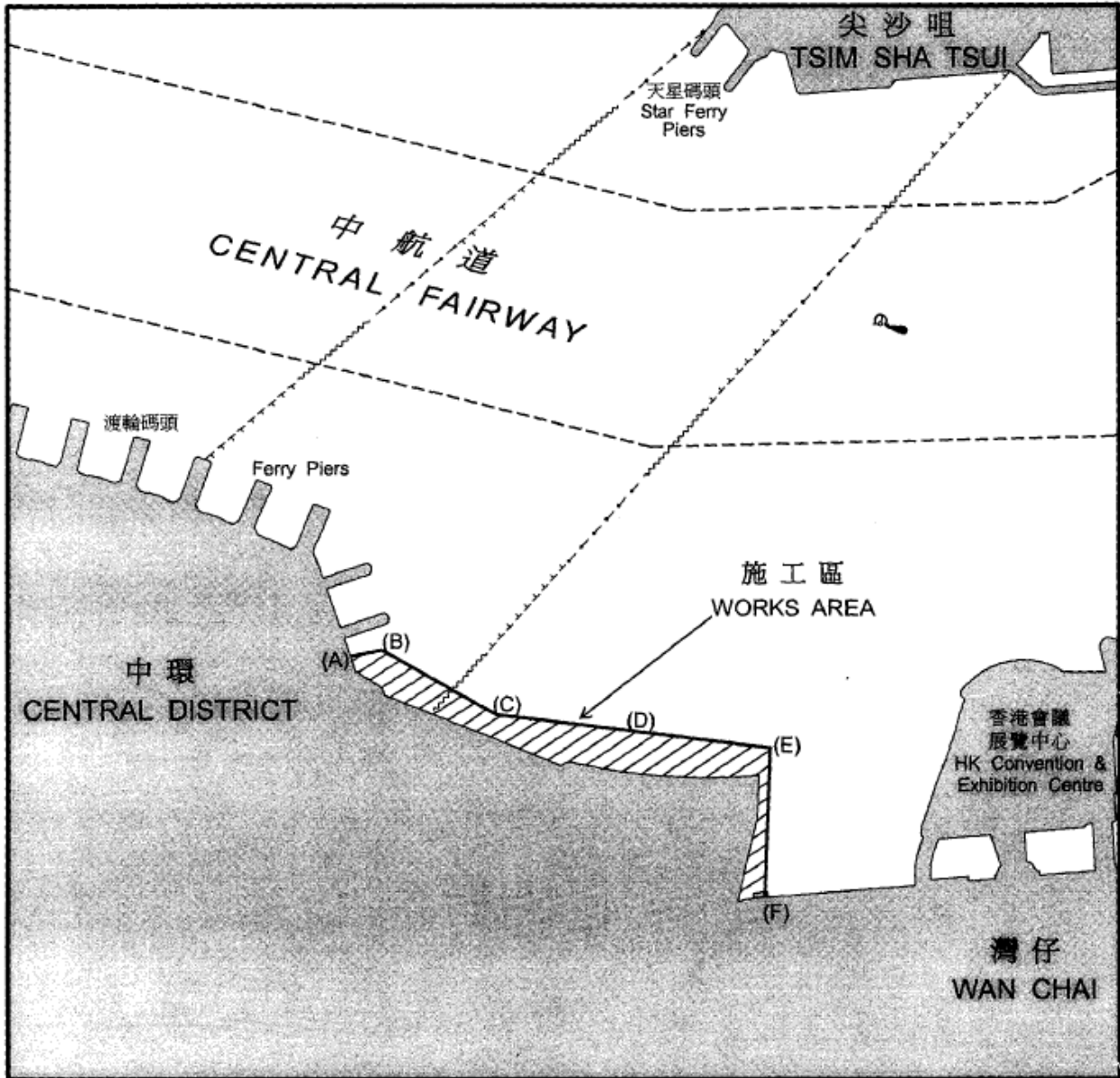
