

MARINE DEPARTMENT NOTICE NO. 101 OF 2010

(Marine Works)

Marine Piling Works in Central Harbour

With immediate effect and for a period of approximately 3 months, marine piling works will be carried out in the area bounded by straight lines joining the following co-ordinates (WGS 84 Datum) from (A) to (C) and the adjacent shoreline:

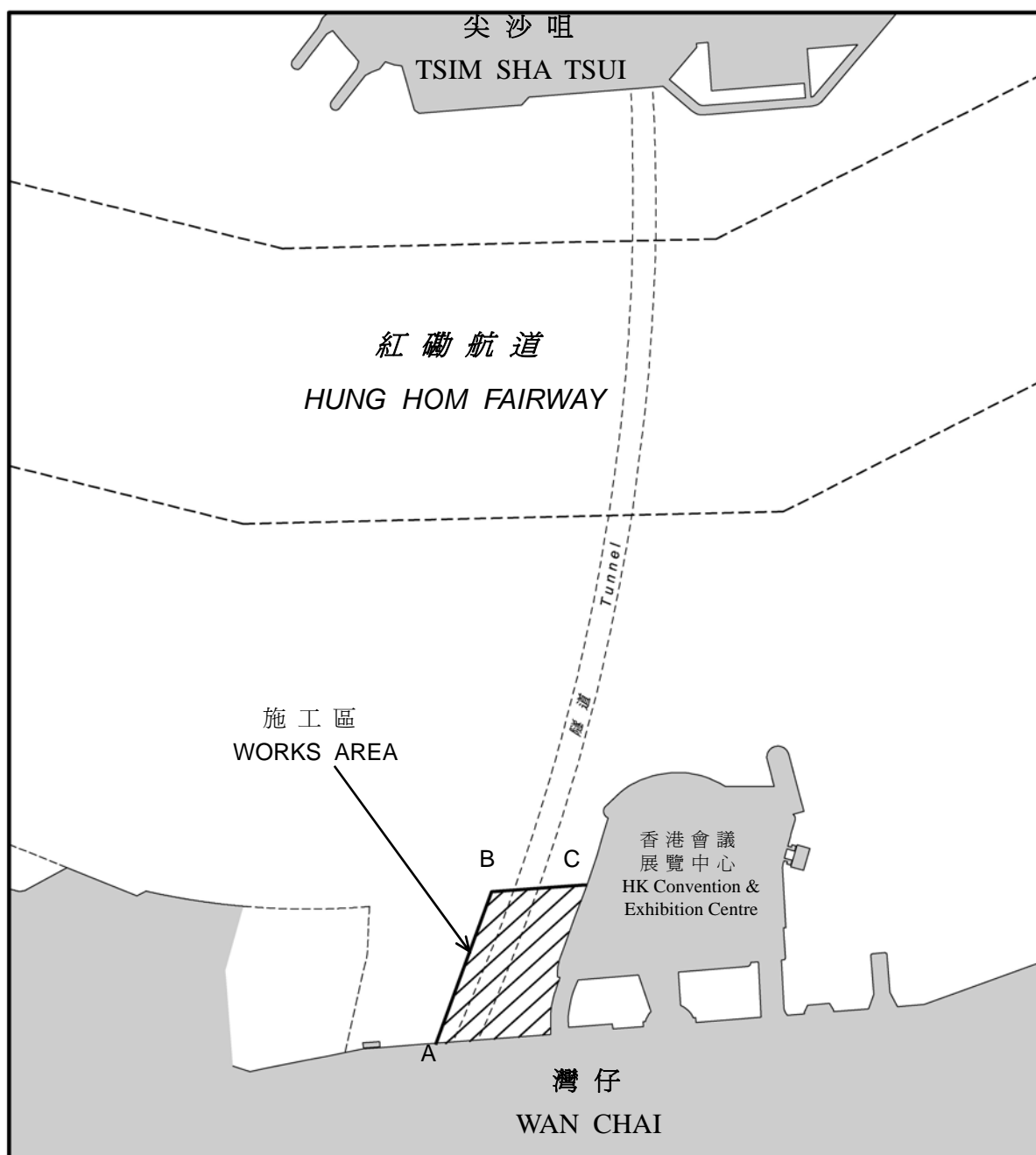
(A)	22° 16.892' N	114° 10.188' E
(B)	22° 17.004' N	114° 10.232' E
(C)	22° 17.009' N	114° 10.305' E

2. The works will be conducted by a flotilla of vessels including two derrick barges, one flat top barge, one split hopper barge, one jack-up barge and one tug. The number of vessels engaged in the works will change from time to time to suit operational requirements.
3. A working area of approximately 50 metres around each barge will be established. Yellow marker buoys fitted with yellow flashing lights will be laid to mark the positions of the anchors extending from the barges.
4. The hours of work will normally be round-the-clock. Vessels employed for the works will stay in the works area outside the hours of work.
5. Vessels engaged in the operations will display signals as prescribed in international and local regulations.
6. Vessels navigating in the vicinity should proceed with caution.
7. A drawing showing the works area is attached to this Notice.
8. This Notice supersedes Marine Department Notice No. 40 of 2010.
