

MARINE DEPARTMENT NOTICE NO. 103 OF 2010

(Marine Works)

Submarine Outfall Inspection Works off Cyberport

With effect from 19 July 2010 and for a period of approximately one week, submarine outfall inspection works will be carried out within an area bounded by straight lines joining the following co-ordinates (WGS 84 Datum):

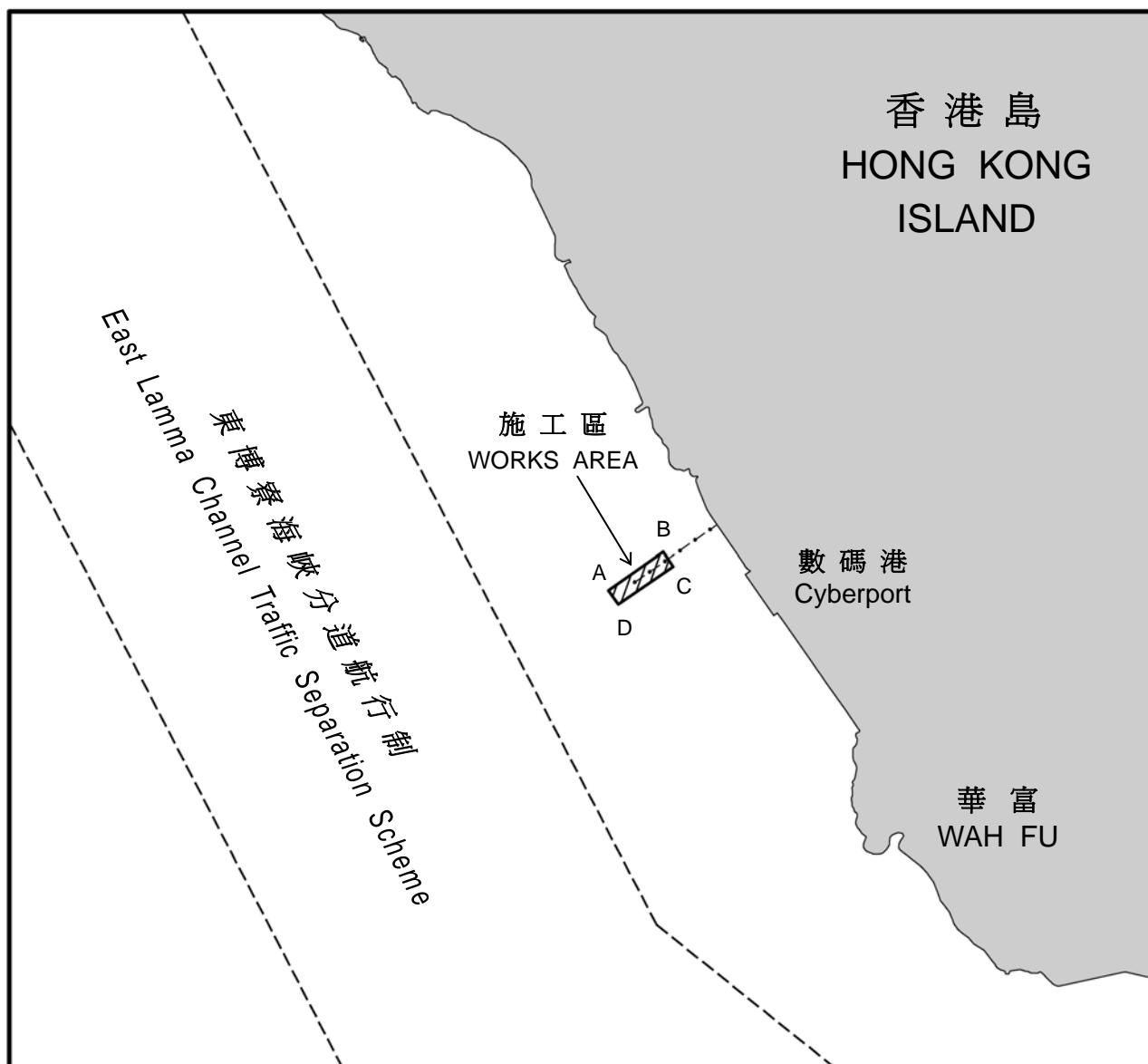
(A)	22° 15.542' N	114° 07.494' E
(B)	22° 15.603' N	114° 07.588' E
(C)	22° 15.580' N	114° 07.605' E
(D)	22° 15.520' N	114° 07.511' E

2. One work boat will carry out the works. One guard boat will provide assistance.
3. A working area of approximately 25 metres around the work boat will be established. The works will be carried out from 0800 to 1700 hours. No works will be carried out on Sunday. The vessels employed for the works will not stay in the works area outside the hours of work.
4. Diving operations will be carried out from time to time during the hours of work.
5. Vessels engaged in the works will display signals as prescribed in international and local regulations.
6. Vessels navigating in the vicinity should proceed with caution and keep clear at slow speed, bearing in mind there are divers working in the area.
7. A drawing showing the works area is attached to this Notice.
