

**MARINE DEPARTMENT NOTICE NO. 104 OF 2010**

(Marine Works)

**Seabed Sampling Survey at Tsing Chau Lek, Crooked Harbour**

With effect from 21 July 2010 and for a period of approximately two weeks, seabed sampling survey will be carried out in the area bounded by straight lines joining the following co-ordinates (WGS 84 Datum) from (A) to (D):

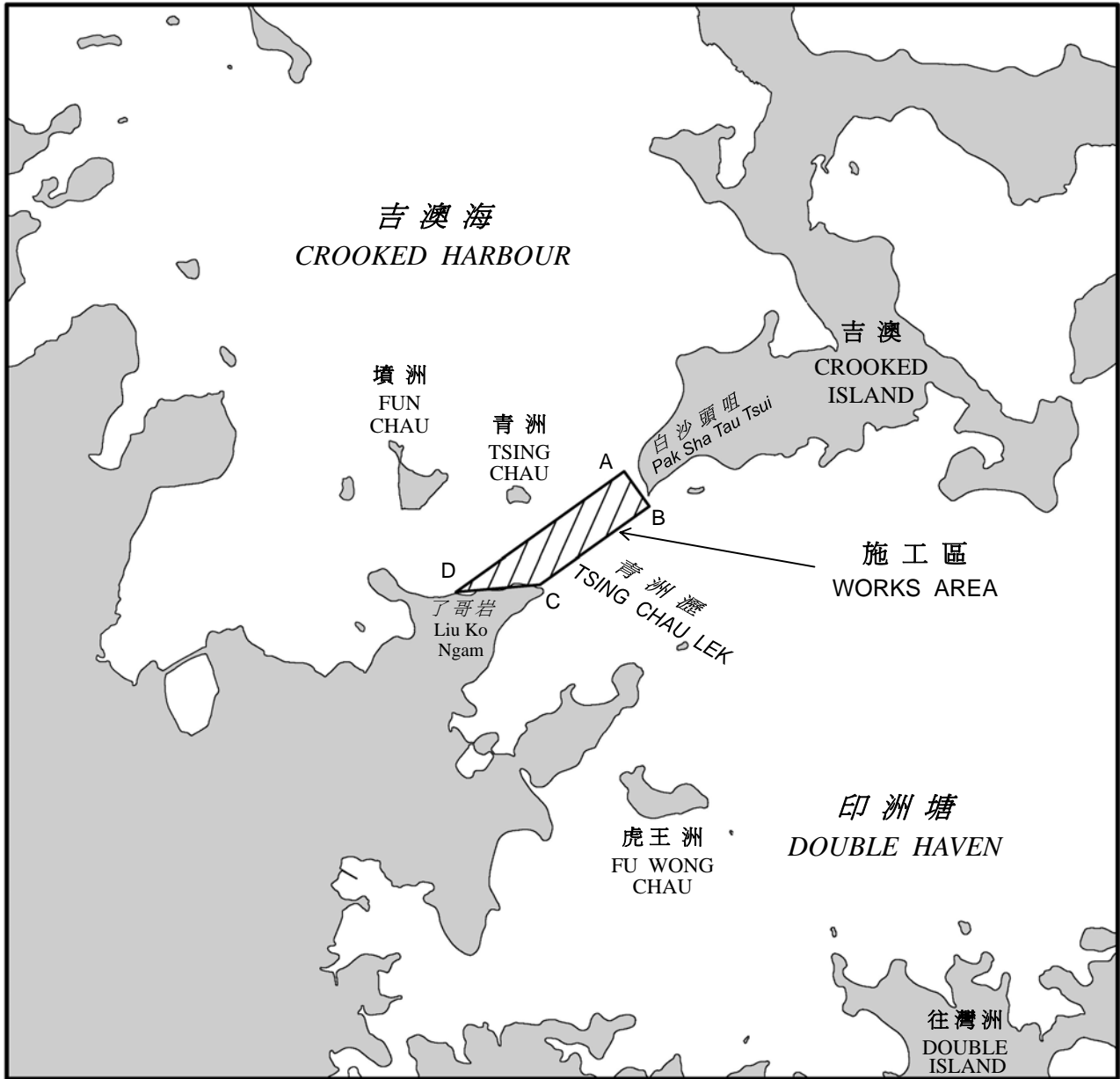
(A)	22° 32.017' N	114° 17.110' E
(B)	22° 31.929' N	114° 17.178' E
(C)	22° 31.734' N	114° 16.884' E
(D)	22° 31.716' N	114° 16.656' E

2. The works will be carried out by one survey vessel. One guard boat will provide assistance. A working area of approximately 30 metres around the survey vessel will be established. Yellow marker buoys fitted with yellow flashing lights will be laid to mark the positions of the anchors extending from the survey vessel.
3. The hours of work will be from 0800 to 1800 hours. No works will be carried out on Sundays and public holidays. Vessels employed for the works will not stay in the works area outside the hours of work.
4. Vessels engaged in the operations will display signals as prescribed in international and local regulations.
5. Vessels navigating in the vicinity should proceed with caution.
6. A drawing showing the works area is attached to this Notice.
