

MARINE DEPARTMENT NOTICE NO. 106 OF 2010

(Miscellaneous Information)

Hong Kong International Dragon Boat Races

The 2010 Hong Kong International Dragon Boat Races will take place off the East Tsim Sha Tsui waterfront on 23, 24 and 25 July 2010 from 0900 hours to 1800 hours.

2. Mooring buoys marking the southern limit of the race area will be laid approximately 280 meters from the waterfront on 22 July 2010 and a pontoon will be moored to the landing steps at East Tsim Sha Tsui waterfront. They will remain in place until approximately 26 July 2010. Owners and coxswains of vessels are advised to use other landing steps in the vicinity.

3. Throughout the event, lighters, ferries and launches will make fast to the mooring buoys to enclose the race area. Other than participating craft, no vessel will be permitted to enter the race area.

4. Vessels navigating in the vicinity should proceed with caution.

5. A drawing showing the race area is attached to this Notice.

6. In the event of inclement weather, the races may be postponed to the fallback dates between 30 July and 1 August 2010. Mooring buoys marking the race area and the pontoon will be put in place from 29 July to 2 August 2010 in East Tsim Sha Tsui waters.

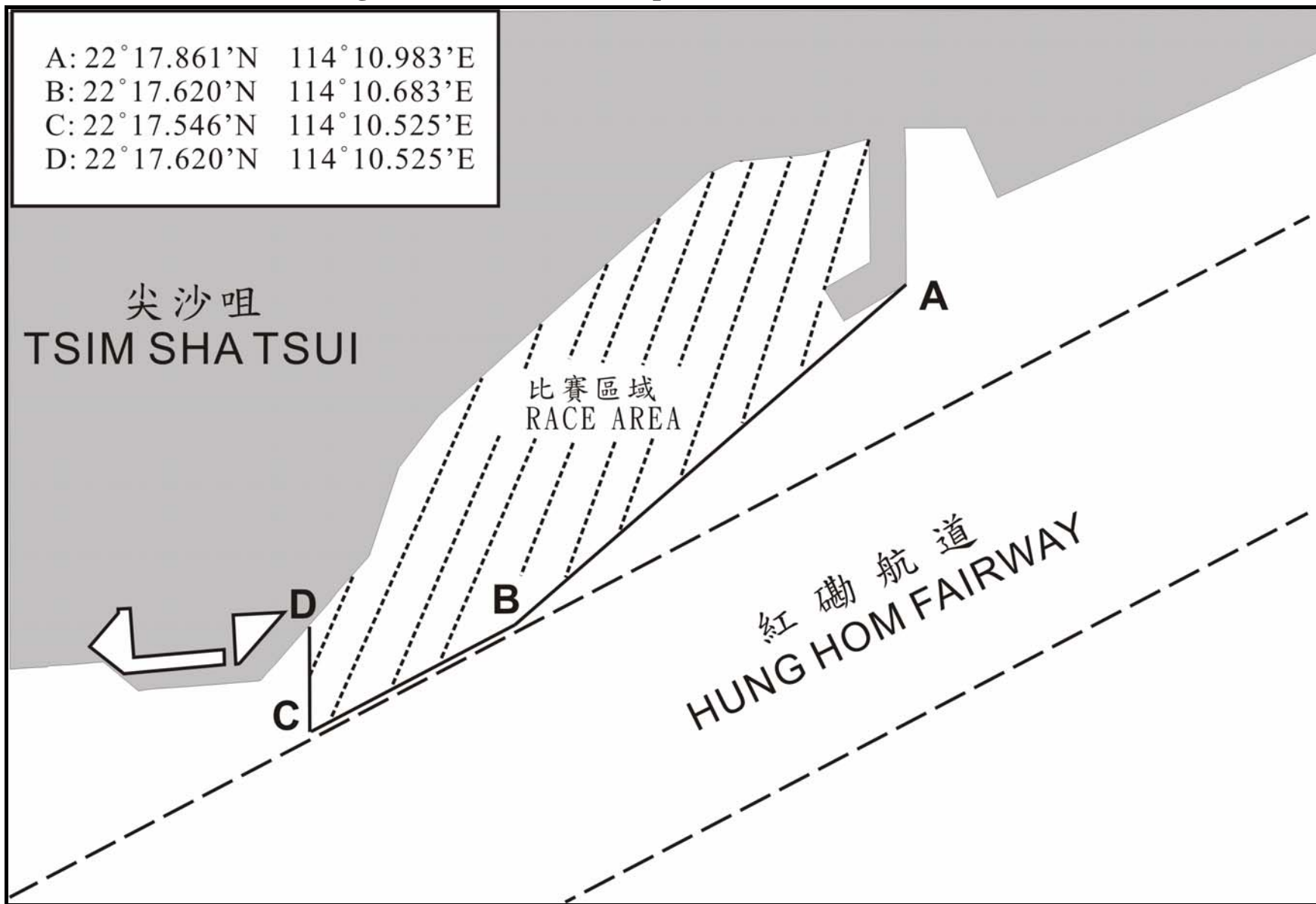
