

MARINE DEPARTMENT NOTICE NO. 117 OF 2010

(Marine Works)

Unloading of Precast Units off North Point

With immediate effect and for a period of approximately two months, unloading of precast units from a semi-submersible barge will be carried out from time to time within the area bounded by straight lines joining the following co-ordinates (WGS 84 Datum) from (A) to (D):

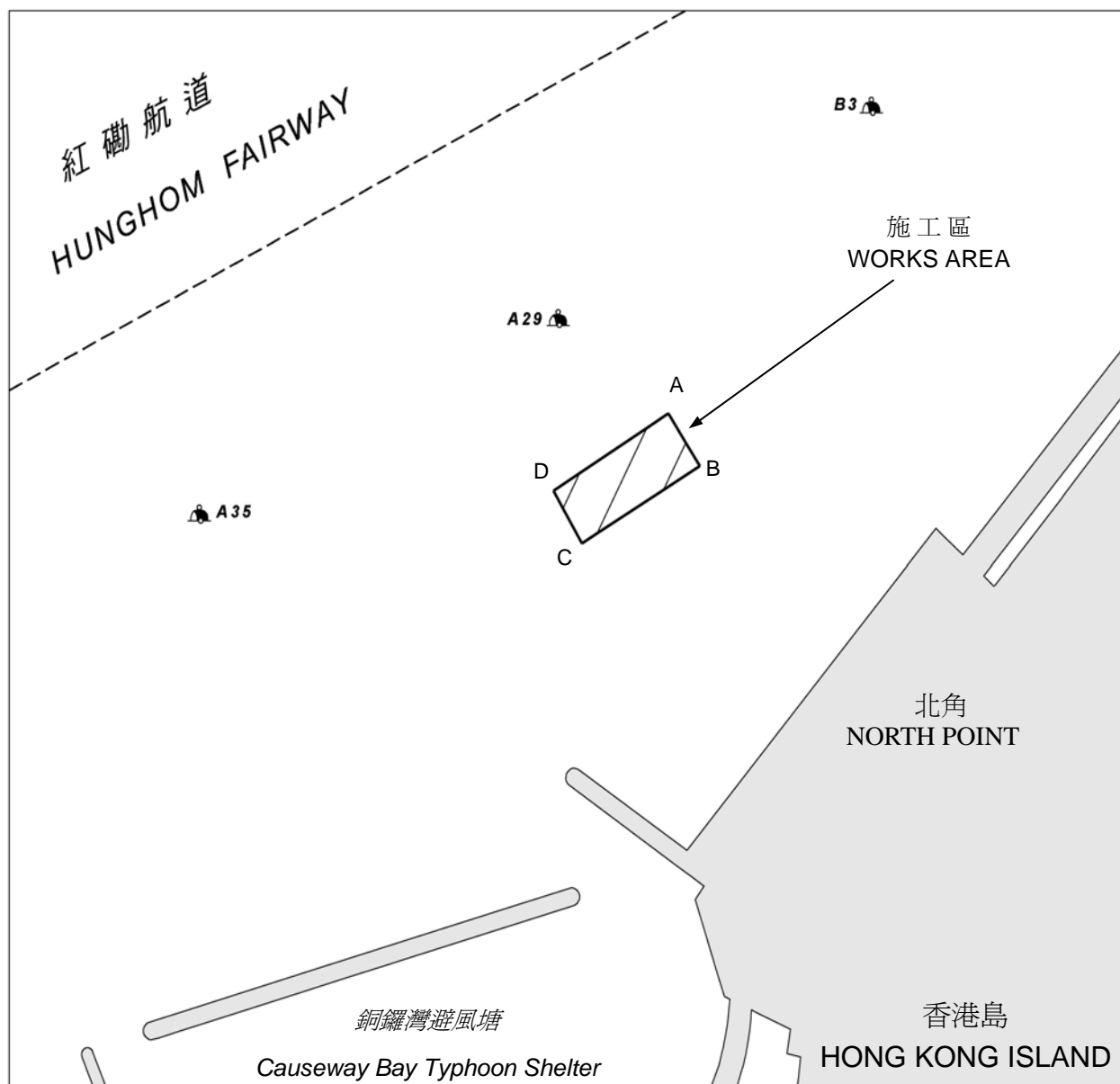
(A)	22° 17.432'N	114° 11.238'E
(B)	22° 17.473'N	114° 11.311'E
(C)	22° 17.445'N	114° 11.331'E
(D)	22° 17.404'N	114° 11.256'E

2. The works will be carried out from a flotilla of vessels including one semi-submersible barge, two derrick barges, five tugs, one work boat and some guard boats. The number of vessels engaged in the works will change from time to time to suit operational requirements.
3. A working area of approximately 50 metres around each working vessel will be established. Yellow marker buoys fitted with yellow flashing lights will be laid to mark the positions of the anchors extending from the working barges.
4. The hours of work will be from 0700 to 1900 hours. No works will be carried out on Sundays and public holidays. The vessels employed for the works will stay in the works area outside the hours of work.
5. Vessels engaged in the operations will display signals as prescribed in international and local regulations.
6. Vessels navigating in the vicinity should proceed with caution.
7. A drawing showing the works area is attached to this Notice.
8. This Notice supersedes Marine Department Notice No. 89 of 2010.
