

MARINE DEPARTMENT NOTICE NO. 118 OF 2010

(Marine Works)

**Reconstruction Works to Beacons
at Starling Inlet, Double Haven and Tolo Channel**

With effect from 25 August 2010 and for a period of approximately three months, reconstruction works to four beacons located at Starling Inlet, Double Haven and Tolo Channel, will be carried out. The positions (WGS 84 Datum) of the beacons are as follows:

(A)	22° 32.245' N	114° 14.154' E
(B)	22° 31.865' N	114° 17.525' E
(C)	22° 31.570' N	114° 17.309' E
(D)	22° 27.578' N	114° 17.235' E

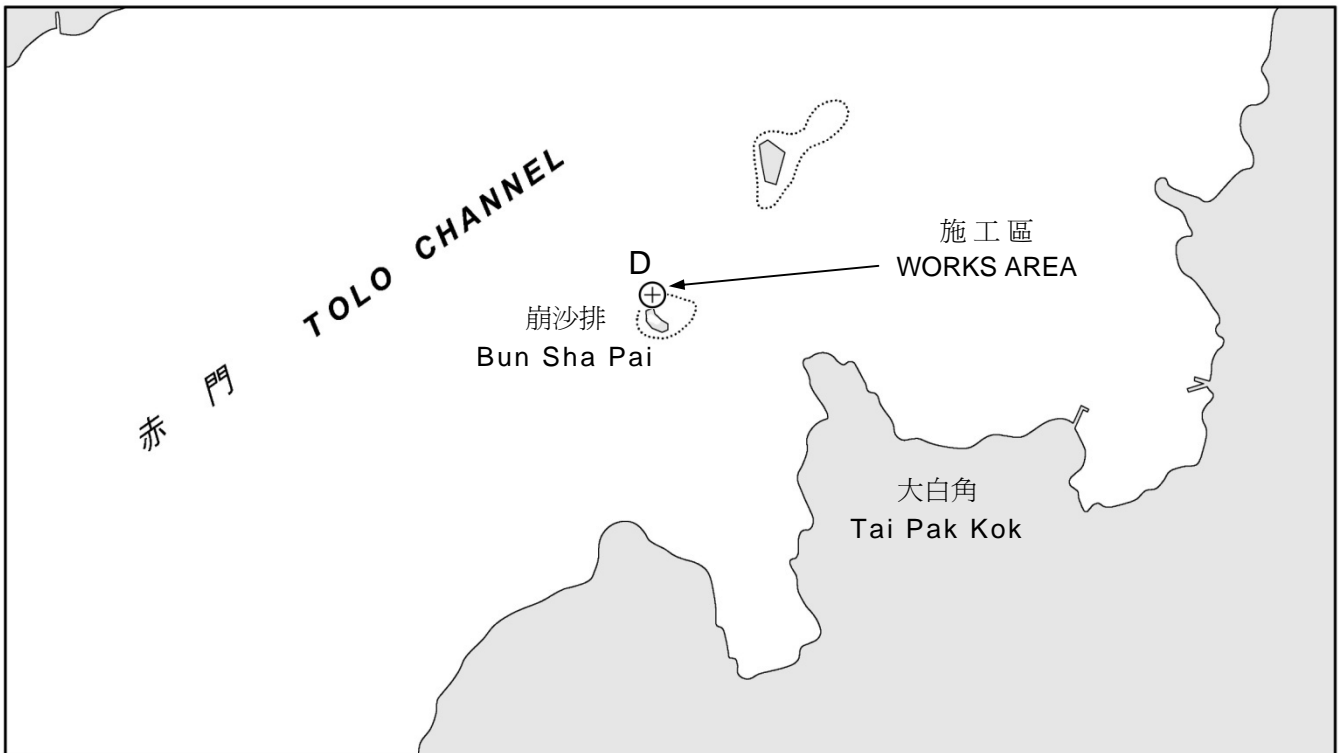
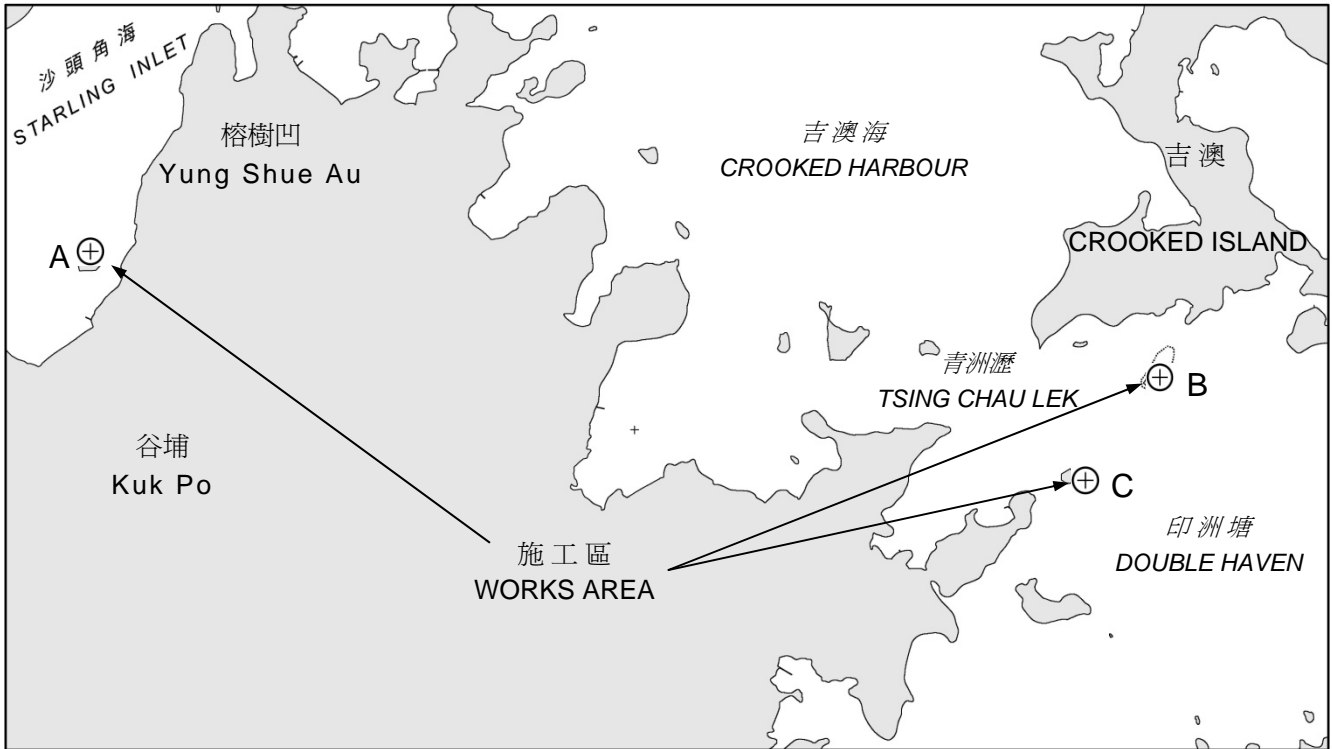
2. One derrick lighter will carry out the works. One tug and one work boat will provide assistance. The lighter will work at one beacon at a time, and will alternate amongst the four beacons to suit operational requirements.
3. A working area of approximately 30 metres around the lighter will be established. Yellow marker buoys fitted with yellow flashing lights will be laid to mark the positions of the anchors extending from the lighter.
4. A silt curtain, extending from the sea surface to the seabed, will be established around the beacon undergoing the reconstruction works. The silt curtain is a large piece of netting used to contain mud and sediments. Yellow markers fitted with yellow flashing lights will be laid to mark the extent of the silt curtain.
5. The hours of work will be from 0700 to 1900 hours. No works will be carried out on Sundays and public holidays. Outside the hours of work, the vessels employed for the works will stay close to the beacon undergoing the reconstruction works.
6. Diving operations will be carried out from time to time during the hours of work.
7. Vessels engaged in the operations will display signals as prescribed in international and local regulations.

8. Vessels navigating in the vicinity should proceed with caution and keep clear at slow speed, bearing in mind there are divers working in the area.
9. A drawing showing the works areas is attached to this Notice.
